PLAYOFF BOUND

The Omaha Storm Chasers won the International League 1st Half title with a 49-24 record and 3.5-game lead on second-place Syracuse to end the half, the best Minor League team in the 1st half of the 2024 season.

- Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series, a best-of-three series that will be played at Werner Park from September 24 to 26.
- This September will mark Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.
- The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

IN GOOD STANDINGS

While the standings reset for the start of the 2nd half on June 25, Omaha's enters today's game 28 games over .500 with a 64-36 record (.640 winning percentage).
 64 wins are tied for the most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, tied with the Sugar Land Space Cowboys, Houston's Triple-A affiliate.
 Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .640 winning percentage overall this year is the 2nd-best the Minors, just behind the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (62-33 / .653), Milwaukee's High-A team.
 The Storm Chasers have still been 1st or 2nd in the Minors in wins every day since May 25 ... Omaha previously held sole possession of the best winning percentage in full-season Minor League Baseball for 30 days, June 5 to July 5.
 Omaha is currently on pace for 94 wins ... the franchise record is 86 wins from the Omaha Royals in 1990 ... the best winning percentage in Triple-A Omaha history was .607 (85-55) in the inaugural 1969 season.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

62 of Omaha's 100 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 23 of 36 losses in 2024, with 12 of 36 losses by just one run (36%).
 Close games have been a struggle for Omaha in recent weeks, with the bullpen converting just 10 of its last 19 save opportunities, since June 5 (52%).
 Omaha is 19-12 in 1-run games this season, which ranks as tied for the 88th-most 1-run wins of any Minor League team ... two teams have 21 1-run wins this year.
 As a team, Omaha's 30 saves are the 6th-most of any Minor League team, 2nd-most in Triple-A and the top mark in the league ... **Evan Sisk** has recorded the team's last four saves, but 7 different Storm Chasers arms have 2 or more saves this year.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT (IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 564 to 454 this season, a +110 run differential.
 A +510 run differential this year ranks as both the best mark in the International League and tops at the Triple-A level, ahead of Tacoma (+102).
 Omaha is 7th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Modesto Nuts lead the Minors at +167 (629 to 462).

JULY, JULY!

A trio of Omaha hitters are in their best stretches of this season in the month of July.
 In 19 games this month, outfielder **Tyler Gentry** is hitting .426 (29-for-68) with a 1.176 OPS this month and leads the team in hits and total bases (46).
 Over 11 July games, catcher **Brian O'Keefe** has thrived despite limited playing time, hitting .412 (14-for-34) in July, with a 1.336 OPS ... he is 2nd on the team this month in HR (4), 3rd in RBI (11) ... O'Keefe is on a career-best 21-game on-base streak too.
CJ Alexander's 20 total bases lead the team in last week's series at CHS Field ... he went 9-for-22 (.409) with 5 doubles and 2 homers, paired with 5 RBI and 4 walks.

DAZZLING DEFENSE

Omaha's defense has had its ups and downs this season, but the team is on one of its best stretches in the field this season.
 Over Omaha's last 44 games (since June 5), a .986 fielding percentage (21 errors in 1,531 total chances) is the BEST in Minor League Baseball over that span.
 Overall this year, a .981 fielding percentage is tied 7th in the league, tied 9th in Triple-A and tied 11th of the 120 full-season Minor League teams.
 The Storm Chasers have not made an error in 15 of the team's last 26 games ... Omaha went 7 straight games without making an error, March 31 to April 7, also with a stretch 6 straight errorless games from June 29 to July 4.

COMEBACK KIDS

Omaha has 36 come-from-behind wins this season, meaning over half (57%) of this year's wins have been games where the Chasers trailed at some point.
 Omaha has trailed for three innings or more in 14 of the 35 comeback wins, with 6 victories where the club had to overcome multiple deficits ... the team has 9 wins in games where they trailed after the 6th inning.
 The Storm Chasers have come back from down as many as 5 runs to win and have overcome a 3+ run deficit to win on 10 occasions.
