

R-Phils.

Tonight, Reading is back on the road to begin a six-game series with the Hartford Yard Goats, running Tuesday-Sunday. It is the second series of the season between the teams and Reading's first repeat opponent. Hartford took 4/6 from the R-Phils in the first series at FirstEnergy Stadium from April 11-16. Hartford comes to Reading again from June 13-18 and the series finishes in Hartford from August 1-6.

Looking back

Last week, Reading dropped three-of-five games to the Altoona Curve, with the Fightin Phils winning the bookend games. Reading won Tuesday, then dropped three straight before finishing the series with a win Saturday. Both Friday's and Sunday's games were rained out. Friday was made up as part of a doubleheader Saturday and Sunday's game will not be made up. Mick Abel shined for the Fightin Phils on Saturday, tossing six inings, giving up just one run on two hits, while striking out six Curve hitters.

Reading Rehabs

Last week, two members of the Philadelphia Phillies made rehab appearneces with the Fightin Phils. Nick Nelson started on Wednesday against Altoona, throwing three innings of one run ball. Then, Ranger Suarez tossed two shutout innings on Thursday against the Curve. Nelson is scheduled to start twice for Reading this week, on Tuesday and Sunday. He previously made two rehab starts for Single-A Clearwater.

Wonderful Wilson

Ethan Wilson's torrid return from the injured list continued Saturday night. He collected two RBI, both on sacrifice flies to center. That came after back-to-back games with home runs off the top of the new event center and then a double off the event center the next day as well. Wilson had a four-game hit streak, and seven-game on-base streak snapped; the latter dated back to opening weekend, before Wilson went on the injured list.

Around the Organization

The big club, Philadelphia Phillies opened up a series at the Dodgers last night with a 13-4 loss. Most notably, Bryce Harper is slated to come off the injured list after undergoing Tommy John surgery in November. Harper will return just 160 days after surgery, which would be the fastest a player has returned from Tommy John surgery in MLB history. Elsewhere, Lehigh Valley stays on the road for six at Syracuse this week after splitting at Jacksonville last week. Jersey Shore opens up a series at Hickory after having their last three games at home against Brooklyn rained out. Finally, Clearwater opens up a series at home against Lakeland, after sweeping St. Lucie last week.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 2, 1970: At Reading, Greg Luzinski hits his first Double-A home run, a blast that reportedly lands five feet shy of the brick wall in left field, an estimated 500 feet from home plate. Reading beats Manchester, 7-3, in a game that is called in the 6th inning due to rain.

Nice to See you Again

This is the second time in just four weeks that Reading and Hartford match up. Hartford enters tonight with an 11-8 record on the season. Last week, Hartford took four-of-five games on the road at New Hampshire, including four-straight win to finish the series. Tuesday's game was suspended and finished Wednesday, while Sunday's game was cancelled, like the R-Phils. After this week, Hartford hits the road for seven games in six days at Binghamton, which includes a doubleheader on May 10, where Hartofrd will be home for one of the games, due to a postponement on April 23 in Hartford.

Goat on the Bump

Righty Nick Garcia is slated to pitch tonight for Hartford. Garcia is making his fourth start and is 0-1 with a 10.00 ERA. In nine innings, he has allowed 16 hits and seven walks to eight strikeouts. At New Hampshire last Tuesday, Garcia allowed six hits and three runs in just three innings. Garcia pitched at Reading on April 12, allowing two runs on six hits in four innings, while striking out two and walking two as well.
