FRES-NOTES

BRITO BRINGS IT: Roldy Brito has opened the San Jose series swinging one of Fresno's hot-test bats, going 5-for-9 with a double, four runs scored and two stolen bases through the first two games. That continues a strong start overall for the 19-year-old, who is hitting .324 with a .384 OBP, .537 slugging percentage and .921 OPS. Brito leads Fresno with 29 runs scored, ranks second on the club with 35 hits and has driven in 29 runs while adding 14 extra-base hits.

RENZULLO ROLLING: Carlos Renzullo has made an immediate impact since joining Fresno, going 7-for-16 over his first four games with two doubles, a homer, seven RBI and a 1.194 OPS. The switch-hitting outfielder has already produced two multi-hit games and has added length to a Grizzlies lineup that continues to find offense throughout the order. Renzullo has also been productive in the San Jose series, going 4-for-8 with two doubles, three RBI and a .556 on-base percentage.

SIXTH SENSE: The Grizzlies have committed six errors through the first two games of the series in San Jose, pushing their season total to 42. Fresno has still managed to split the first two games, but the defensive miscues have helped extend innings against a Giants lineup that leads the California League in average, on-base percentage, slugging and OPS. Cleaning up the defensive side will be key as Fresno continues a six-game series against the North Division leaders.

POWERED BY TRAFFIC: Fresno continues to create pressure with traffic on the bases, drawing 155 walks through 29 games while posting a .365 team on-base percentage. The Grizzlies have scored 204 runs, second in the California League behind San Jose, and have paired patience with power by hitting 34 homers. That balance has kept Fresno in the top half of the league offensively despite a lineup that has shuffled in several new pieces early in the season.
