**TODAY'S GAME:** The Fayetteville Woodpeckers (Single-A, Houston Astros) try to shake off last night's loss and get back into the win column against the Lynchburg Hillcats (Single-A, Cleveland Guardians). After the Woodpeckers grabbed a 7-0 shutout victory on Opening Day, the Hillcats have rattled off four straight victories in this head-to-head series, each by two runs or less. Once again, last night, the Woodpeckers grabbed a lead, this time by three runs, but Lynchburg rallied back to earn another victory. Tonight, the Woodpeckers look to RHP Raimy Rodriguez on the mound while LHP Rafe Schlesinger does the honors for the Hillcats.

**ABOUT THE HILLCATS:** The Lynchburg Hillcats, founded in 1894, begin their 132nd season of operation in 2025. Having joined the Carolina League in 1966, they are the oldest team in the league. Jordan Smith returns to manage the club for his third season having led the team to winning records in each of his first two years in Lynchburg. The Hillcats most recently won their eighth Carolina League title in 2017, the most of any current franchise, and sit in a tie for second with the defunct Kinston Indians for second in league history. However, they have not won a championship since the league re-classified to Single-A. Before joining the Guardians organization in 2015, they held previous affiliations with the St. Louis Cardinals (1943-1955), Chicago White Sox (1963-1969), Minnesota Twins (1970-1974), Texas Rangers (1975), New York Mets (1976-87), Boston Red Sox (1988-1994), Pittsburgh Pirates (1995-2009), and Cincinnati Reds (2010).

**(SOMEWHAT) FAMILIAR FOES:** This past offseason, the Carolina League experienced significant changes that saw the league re-shuffle ahead of the 2025 campaign. In May 2024, the Down East Wood Ducks announced their relocation to Spartanburg, S.C. and re-brand as the Hub City Spartanburgers, and shortly thereafter, in July, the Texas Rangers swapped them with the Hickory Crawdads, sending them to the High-A South Atlantic League while the Crawdads took their place in the Carolina League. Upon their entry to the league, the Crawdads were placed in the South Division, and the Woodpeckers took Down East's spot in the North Division, grouping them with the Nationals, Lynchburg Hillcats (Single-A Cleveland Guardians), Carolina Mudcats (Single-A Milwaukee Brewers), Delmarva Shorebirds (Single-A, Baltimore Orioles), and Salem Red Sox (Single-A, Boston Red Sox).

**ON THE ROAD TO H-TOWN:** The Woodpeckers current roster features three players listed in the top 30 of the Houston Prospect Rankings according to MLB.com. Cole Hertzler is the highest ranked of the trio at No. 27 overall (No. 13 pitcher), Jancel Villarroel is the lone position player in the group at No. 29 overall (No. 2 catcher), and Bryce Mayer rounds out the list at No. 30 overall (No. 15 pitcher).

**THE NEW MAN IN THE DUGOUT:** The Woodpeckers feature a brand new coaching staff from top to bottom in 2025. With former manager Ricky Rivera earning a promotion to Double-A to lead the Corpus Christi Hooks, Carlos Lugo takes over for his first season in full-season baseball. However, Lugo is no stranger to the Houston Astros organization. This season marks his 12th with the club having started as a catching specialist in the Dominican Summer League in 2014. Most recently, he spent four seasons managing in the Florida Complex League, the first of which with Rivera, helping develop some of the Astros' youngest professional players. As he gets his first taste of Single-A, he teams up with three members of his staff from last year in Palm Beach including James Wiseman (Pitching Coach), Kyle Brennan (Hitting Coach), and Alfredo Granier (Development Coach).

**THE 'PECKERS CAN PITCH:** Through the first 16 games of the season, the Woodpeckers have established themselves as one of the top teams on the mound in the Carolina League. While they enter this series leading the league in both strikeouts (151) and ERA (3.12), they have also allowed the fewest earned runs (44) and home runs (4) while giving up the second fewest hits (91). Cole Hertzler has emerged as the ace of the staff, placing fourth in the league in ERA (0.66) and strikeouts (19), fifth in innings pitched (13.2), and tied for 12th in WHIP (1.17).

**LATE LEADS DONT LAST:** The Woodpeckers have had trouble over the first two weeks of the season hanging on to late leads at home. The club has a 7-4 record when leading after seven innings, and if every game in last week's series against Fredericksburg consisted of seven-inning games, Fayetteville would have gone 5-1. They also lost consecutive games at home on Opening Weekend in which they led during the final three innings.

**THIS DAY IN WOODPECKERS HISTORY:** April 24, 2019 - The Woodpeckers rattled off six runs in the first four innings, including three in the fourth, to outpace the Frederick Keys 7-4. Four of the team's 11 hits were doubles, and three players, including former Major Leaguer Seth Beer, notched two hits. Another former Major Leaguer in Yohan Ramirez tossed a 3.2-inning start while current Astro Shawn Dubin worked three relief innings.

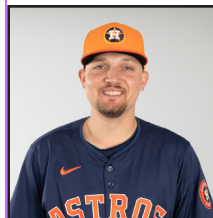
