### FRISCO FALLS VIA WALK-OFF ERROR ON SATURDAY:

**Chris Seise** racked up a season-high four hits with a home run, but the Wichita Wind Surge walked off the Frisco RoughRiders in a 7-6 finish at Riverfront Stadium on Saturday. Seise tied his career high with four hits, hitting lead off for the first time this season. He went 4-for-5 on the day with a solo homer, a double and two RBIs. Seise led off three innings, going 3-for-3 in those at bats, plus an RBI single in the sixth. Wichita (11-15, 39-55) tied the game in the seventh on Junior Severino's second homer of the day and 10th against Frisco (14-12, 45-49) this year in 10 games. The Wind Surge scored the walk-off run in the ninth without a hit. **John Matthews** (2-2) took the loss, pitching a scoreless eighth inning but allowing the winning run in the ninth. He hit two batters and committed a throwing error on a sacrifice bunt, allowing the game-ending run to score. Aaron Rozek (2-3) secured the win in relief, allowing one hit over three scoreless innings. **Dane Acker** completed three hitless innings in his start for Frisco, allowing just one unearned run. He struck out five, all in a row, including the three batters he faced in the second inning. **Josh Hatcher** led off the second inning with a solo home run and Seise did the same in the third. Hatcher had two hits on the day and now has 27 RBIs in 23 games with the Riders. The Riders started the first five innings with leadoff hits, including those two homers and Seise's double in the fifth that led to a big inning. With two outs, Zavala picked up an RBI walk for the second straight game to tie the score at 5-5, and Kellen Strahm came through with a go-ahead double for two more runs. Frisco put an additional run on the board in the sixth when **Jax Biggers** doubled and scored on Seise's single.

### ACUÑA MATATA TO THE METS:

The Rangers and the Mets made a major trade on Saturday evening, being reported as completed during the sixth inning of that evening's Riders game, when the Mets sent three-time Cy Young winner and eight-time All-Star **Max Scherzer** to Texas in exchange for RoughRiders shortstop **Luisangel Acuña**. Acuña exits the Rangers franchise hitting .315/.377/.453/830 with a team-high 25 doubles, 114 hits, 68 runs scored and 42 stolen bases. The Rangers No. 3 prospect and instrumental part of Frisco's 2022 Texas League Championship team had been with the Rangers organization since 2019, playing in each of the last two seasons with the RoughRiders.

### OFFENSE, OFFENSE AND SOME MORE OFFENSE:

The RoughRiders set multiple season highs in their 19-10 win over the Wind Surge on Wednesday. Their 19 runs, 19 hits and six home runs were all season bests while it was also the longest game of the season at three hours and 31 minutes. In the ninth inning, Frisco went back-to-back-to-back for the first time this season (**Trevor Hauver**, **Josh Hatcher** and **Scott Kapers**). Over their last five games, Frisco has hit .318/.390/.544/.934 with 16 doubles, two triples, eight home runs, 10 steals and 19 walks while averaging 9.2 runs per game.

### GENTLEMEN, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have struggled on the starting pitching side of things this season. This year, Frisco has a 6.23 starting pitcher ERA which is the highest in recorded franchise history (dating back to 2005) and last in the Texas League. They have used 17 different starting pitchers, more than the 14 they used all season in 2022 and just under the 19 they used the whole year in 2021. Frisco has not had a start of more than 5.1 innings since June 10th, when **Ryan Garcia** went seven innings. Over those 39 games since June 11th, the Riders' starters' ERA is 7.58 (116ER/137.2IP) while the bullpen has a 4.62 ERA (103ER/200.2IP). Over the 39 games, the Riders have the third-best offense in the league by OPS (.787), second-best in runs per game (6.0) and have hit 39 home runs (5th in the Texas League).

### HATCH IS THE RIGHT MATCH:

Since coming to Frisco in June from High-A Hickory, **Josh Hatcher** has been a run-producing machine. In his 23 games, he has driven in 27 runs and in July, Hatcher is hitting .318/.360/.545/.905 with five homers and 23 RBIs in 17 games.

### WELCOME BACK, CARTER:

**Evan Carter** has been fantastic since returning from the Injured List on June 21st against Springfield. Over his last 31 games since his return, he has 10 multi-hit games, batting .303 (37-for-122)/.403/.549/.952 with five doubles, two triples, seven home runs, 25 RBIs and 26 runs scored.

### THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

**Thomas Saggese** has been incredible for the RoughRiders on offense. Over his last 42 games, he is hitting .355/.432/.633/1.065 with 11 home runs and 43 RBIs. The California native is currently fifth in the league in batting average (.314), second in RBIs (78), first in hits (115), fourth in doubles (22), second in runs (67) and first in total bases (188).

### AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

**Thomas Saggese** has been fantastic on first pitches this season, first in the Texas League (min. 11 at-bats) with a .563 average (18-for-32) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.463 OPS on the first pitch, which is first in the league as well.

### ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks**, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

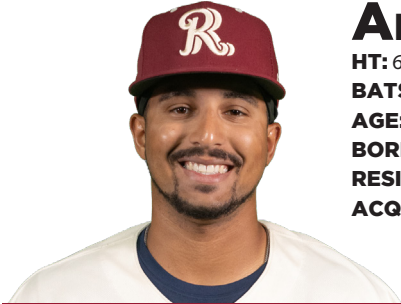
