It took one pitch for Delmarva to take

day night with a 5-1 on the road against the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers. It took one pitch for Delmarva to take the lead as **Stiven Acevedo** hit his sixth homer of the season over the wall in left to make it 1-0. After Kannapolis tied the game in the bottom half of the first, Acevedo helped put Delmarva back in front as he scored **Luis Gonzalez** with a sacrifice fly to make it a 2-1 game. It would remain 2-1 deep into the game thanks to excellent pitching by starting pitcher **Moises Chace** who went four innings, allowing just one unearned run. He was followed by **Luis De Leon** in the first and the southpaw impressed again by going five innings, striking out eight and retiring 15 of the 16 batters he faced. The offense would provide some insurance runs late with **Samuel Basallo** doubling home a run in the eight, followed by a pair of wild pitches scoring two in the ninth, leading Delmarva to a 5-1 win.

TODAY'S OPPONENT: Wyatt Cheney gets the start in Wednesday's matinee match-up against Kannapolis, his mound opponent will be left-hander **Shane Murphy**. The southpaw from Chandler Gilbert Community College will be making his 15th start of the season and his 2nd against Delmarva. The 14th round pick from last season made his debut this season against the Shorebirds on April 12 and took the loss allowing 3 runs (all unearned) on 5 hits while striking out 5 in a 12-2 win for Delmarva.

BACK LIKE HE NEVER LEFT: Trendon Craig has had an instant impact for the for the Shorebirds since rejoining the team on June 9 after two months on the IL. In 27 games since returning, Craig is slashing .326/.436/.505 with 12 extra-base hits, 13 RBI, and 15 stolen bases. Craig has reached base safely in 31 of 33 games with the Shorebirds and has multiple hits in 12 of his 32 games with Delmarva. His 16-game on-base streak that was snapped on June 23 is the longest by a Shorebirds hitter this season.

BLAZING BASALLO: Samuel Basallo is currently in one of his hottest stretches this season. Since June 18, Basallo is batting .353 with 7 home runs and 18 RBI. During his current run, he was named the Carolina League Player of the Week for June 20-25 versus Augusta, featuring a game where he went yard twice, his second multi-homer game of his career. He also hit the first grand slam of the season for the Shorebirds on July 2, help-ing Delmarva edge Lynchburg 4-1. Basallo had a season-long 14-game on base streak snapped on July 22 and is currently ranked as the No. 95 overall prospect by MLB Pipeline, and No. 59 by Baseball America.

HEY STIVEN: Stiven Acevedo has come out of the All-Star break hot as he's reached base in all nine games he's played in since the break. He has especially thrived batting in the leadoff spot in his last eight starts as he has four multi-hit games while scoring six runs, and stealing three bases in that short span. His run at the top included a leadoff home run on the first pitch versus Kannapolis on July 25.

HEATING UP AT THE HOT CORNER: Third basemen **Anderson De Los Santos** has begun find his stride at the plate. After picking up a walk-off hit in extra innings against Augusta on June 24, De Los Santos is batting .270 in his last 20 games with 9 extra base hits and 14 RBI. The 19 year old is batting .302 during the month of July with 5 multi-hit games and has three 4 RBI games this season.

TWO TEAMS LOOKING FOR A BOUNCE-BACK: The Delmarva Shorebirds and Kannapolis Cannon Ballers match up for their second series of the season starting on Tuesday and both clubs are looking for better success this week after each team went 1-5 last week. Delmarva's lone win came on Wednesday in game two against Charleston and Kannapolis salvaged the finale in Zebulon to avoid a sweep against the Carolina Mudcats. Kannapolis won the first series against the Shorebirds at Perdue Stadium from April 11-16 by winning the final four games of the series.

TODAY'S STARTER: Wyatt Cheney takes the mound on Wednesday afternoon in game two against the Cannon Ballers, making his 9th start of the season.

LAST OUTING (7/21 vs CSC): Cheney last pitched on Friday against the Charleston RiverDogs as a reliever, allowing 3 runs (2 earned) on 3 hits in an 8-4 loss. Cheney walked 3 with 1 strikeout.

vs. KANNAPOLIS: This will be the third time this season Cheney will pitch against the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers. Cheney got the call as the starter on opening night at Perdue Stadium and went three innings in the game, allowing 2 runs on 2 hits. He pitched against them again in relief on April 16 and took the loss as a reliever as he gave up 2 runs on 6 hits in a narrow, 5-4 defeat.

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS: The right-hander appeared in just two games for the Shorebirds after being drafted out of McClennan Community College in Texas. His first outing was a full inning against the Pirates in the FCL where he dealt a full inning with two strikeouts as he retired the side in order. He faced just two batters in his only Delmarva appearance where he faced two batters, allowing a hit and a walk. Appeared in 16 games at McClennan in 2022, making 15 starts where he struck out 122 in 81.2 innings to earn a 10-3 record and an ERA of 3.20. Struck out 11 batters or more in three starts including a career-high 13 versus Hill College on March 19.

FELIPE ROJAS ALOU JR.

MANAGER



Felipe returns to the Shorebirds for his second season as manager and his 16th in the Orioles organization. Previously, he served as the Director of the Orioles' Dominican Republic Academy. He was a 40th round pick by the Kansas City Royals in the 1998 amateur draft, he played in the minor leagues for the Royals from 1998 to 2001, and in the short-lived Canadian Baseball League in 2003. His father, Felipe, played in the Majors for 15+ years before managing the Expos ('92-'01) and Giants ('03-'06). Alou's brother, Luis Rojas, was the manager of the Mets and is currently on the Yankees coaching staff. This will be Felipe's 16th season in the Orioles organization.

PITCHING COACH



Bleday enters his first season as the Shorebirds Pitching Coach in 2023 after spending last season as a O's Pitching Coach in the Florida Complex League. Bleday played his college days as a Left-handed Pitcher for the University of Pennsylvania before being drafted in the 27th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the Houston Astros. Before coaching, Bunselmeyer played independent ball for the three season in the Frontier League as a utility player after playing college baseball for Saint Louis University.

FUNDAMENTALS COACH



Daniel Fajardo Is back in Delmarva for his second season as the Shorebirds Fundamentals Coach. After playing eight seasons in the Orioles minor league system and parts of two with the Shorebirds, Fajardo made his professional coaching debut with the 'Birds in 2022 bringing a wealth of knowledge from his time as a catcher. A 2019 Shorebirds Mid-Season All-Star, Fajardo was a Shorebirds fan-favorite hitting for a career .251 average with 124 RBI and 106 Runs Scored.
