GAME INFORMATION

TUCCI MANE: LHP Jonathan Santucci, the Mets' No. 14 prospect (MLB Pipeline), is slated to make his seventh Double-A start tonight. Santucci is coming off a dominant start last Friday against New Hampshire, when he recorded a pro career-high 11 strikeouts and did not allow an earned run over 5.1 innings, while issuing three hits and one walk. He retired 12-straight hitters at one point. The 22-year-old has allowed two earned runs or fewer in five of his first six Double-A starts and has 40 strikeouts in 29.2 innings. He was drafted in the 2nd round in 2024 out of Duke. WINNING: The Rumble Ponies are 76-38 overall and are 38 games above .500. Binghamton has the best winning percentage (.667) in Double-A (1st to 70-win mark) and the 3rd-best in Minor League Baseball (3rd to 70 wins), behind Pittsburgh's High-A Greensboro (.696) and Detroit's High-A West Michigan (.696). Binghamton is on-pace for 90 wins, which would surpass the franchise record for wins in a single season (86 - 2013). Binghamton won the Northeast Division First-Half title, and clinched a spot in the postseason with a 45-22 (.672) record.

FLASH GORDON: RHP R.J. Gordon, the Mets' No. 25 prospect (MLB Pipeline), spun 6.1 no-hit frames on Wednesday and finished with 7 strikeouts in 7.0 scoreless frames, while allowing 2 H and 2 BB in the win at Portland. Gordon is 4-0 with a 3.29 ERA over his first seven Double-A outings. The 23-year-old has allowed 2 ER or fewer in 5 of his outings with Double-A Binghamton. Gordon is Binghamton's only pitcher this season to go 7.0 IP multiple times and he's done it three times. LAST GAME: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies beat the Portland Sea Dogs. 4-1, at Delta Dental Park at Hadlock Field on Wednesday. RHP R.J. Gordon (W, 7 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 7 K) threw 6.1 no-hit innings and finished with seven scoreless frames in the win, DH Jacob Reimer (1-for-2, HR, 2 RBI, R, BB, HBP) blasted his seventh home run. LF A.J. Ewing doubled twice and drove in a run. CF Nick Morabito had a multi-hit game and hit an RBI single. RHP TJ Shook recorded his fifth save. REIMER REASON: INF Jacob Reimer, the Mets' No. 6 prospect (MLB Pipeline), homered again on Wednesday, which marked his 3rd home run over his last 7 games. He is riding a 4-game hit streak and has recorded four multi-hit games over his last seven contests. Over his last seven games, Reimer is hitting .520 (13-for-25) with a .586 OBP, .920 SLG, 1.506 OPS, 3 HR, 7 RBI, 6 R. Reimer has risen has batting average from .200 to .253 and OPS from .662 to .801 over that span. He had a monster final five games against New Hampshire last series and was named the New York Mets Minor League Player of the Week. The 21-year-old went hitless (0-for-13) over 4-straight games leading into this stretch. Reimer is ranked as MLB Pipeline's No. 3 overall third baseman prospect. EWING IT ALL: OF A.J. Ewing, the Mets' No. 7 prospect (MLB Pipeline), has reached base safely in seven of his first eight Double-A games, with 9 H, 2 RBI, 5 R, and 3 SB. Ewing hit two doubles on Wednesday, which marked his first doubles and third multi-hit game at Double-A. The 21-year-old has 61 stolen bases in 104 games across three levels, which ranks 7th in Minor League Baseball. Ewing is hitting .303 with an .826 OPS across Single-A St. Lucie, High-A Brooklyn, and Binghamton this year. Ewing was drafted by the Mets in the 4th round in 2023 out of Springboro HS (OH). MDRABITD MAGIC: OF Nick Morabito, the Mets' No. 16 prospect (MLB Pipeline), recorded his 27th multi-hit game on Wednesday. He also recorded an RBI single, which marked his 50th RBI of the season. Morabito has career highs in HR (6), RBI (50), and 2B (25) this season. Morabito has 16 hits in his first 17 games, since being activated off the 7-day injured list on July 29. The 22-year-old ranks among Double-A with 37 SB (4th) and 25 2B (T-6th). The 22-year-old ranks among the

SUPER SUERD: C/1B/LF **Chris Suero**, the Mets' No. 15 prospect (MLB Pipeline), is riding a 19-game on base streak, which marks the longest for any Binghamton hitter this season. The 21-year-old has 19 H, 6 XBH, 12 RBI, 13 R, and 23 BB over his first 22 games at the Double-A level. Suero grew up in the Bronx and attended All Hallows High School, before moving to the Dominican Republic to pursue baseball at 15-years-old.

KEVIN ON EARTH: C Kevin Parada is riding an 9-game on-base streak (11-for-32, .344 AVG, 1 HR, 3 RBI, 3 R, 3 2B, 4 XBH, 5 BB). The 24-year-old is hitting .325 (13-for-40) with 1 HR, 5 RBI, 4 2B, 6 BB in 12 games in August. He recorded his first 3-hit game on May 16 and since then has produced a .303 AVG (5th in AA), .522 SLG (7th in AA), .894 OPS (8th in AA), 8 HR, 39 RBI over a 58-game span.

LAST START: Santucci recorded a career-high 11 strikeouts over 5.1 innings and allowed no earned runs (one unearned run) on 3 hits and one walk against New Hampshire on Friday at Mirabito Stadium....Santucci retired 12-straight batters at one point and struck out 3-straight batters two separate times.
2025 SEASON: Recorded a career-high 11 strikeouts over 5.1 innings and did not allow an earned run on three hits and one walk vs. New Hampshire on August 15...Promoted to Double-A Binghamton on Monday July 7...Made 15 appearances and 13 starts for High-A Brooklyn and went 5-4 with a 3.46 ERA and 75 strikeouts in 67.2 innings...Recorded a career-high nine strikeouts over six scoreless innings against High-A Hudson Valley on July 5 in final High-A start...Ranked among the South Atlantic League with a 3.46 ERA (9th) and 75 strikeouts (10th) at the time of his promotion...Went 5-0 with a 1.35 ERA and 54 strikeouts in 46.2 innings over his final nine appearances with High-A Brooklyn...Began first professional season with High-A Brooklyn.

CAREER NOTES: Currently ranks as the New York Mets' No. 14 prospect and No. 6 pitching prospect (MLB Pipeline)...Pitched one scoreless inning for the Mets in the 2025 Spring Breakout game...Was invited to the USA Baseball Collegiate National Team Camp in Cary, North Carolina, over the summer of 2022, after his freshman season at Duke...Was a two-way player for his first 2 years at Duke.

BACKGROUND: Originally drafted by the New York Mets in the second round (46th overall) of the 2024 MLB Draft out of Duke University...Made 40 appearances and 27 starts in his three-year career at Duke and went 10-6 with a 3.86 ERA and 198 strikeouts (13.9 K/9) in 128.1 innings...Grew up in Leominster, Massachusetts and attended Phillips Academy in Andover, Mass. for high school...Tabbed the No. 2 recruit out of Massachusetts and the 64th overall player in the class of 2022...Father Steven played baseball at Assumption University from 1991-93 and was a 19th-round pick by the St. Louis Cardinals in 1993, who played four seasons as an outfielder in the minor leagues and reached Double-A Arkansas in 1996.

HOMETOWN: St. Amant, La. -Reid Brignac is now the second-longest tenured manager in Binghamton history, behind Pedro Lopez (2012-16). -In 2024, Brignac led a Rumble Ponies team that at one point won 10-conesecutive games, which marked the franchise's longest winning streak since 2006. Brignac also oversaw Eastern League Pitcher of the Year and Mets Minor League Pitcher of the Year Brandon Sproat's dominant stint at Double-A. Brignac helped the Mets' MLB staff after the MiLB season.

-In 2023, Brignac led Binghamton to the postseason for the first time since 2017, going 39-27 in the second-half and 17-5 in the final 22 games. Binghamton swept the Somerset Patriots in the Eastern League Division Series to advance to the Eastern League Championship Series for the first time since 2014, before falling to the Erie SeaWolves.

-In 2022, he led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies, tying a franchise record (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, José Butto, Nate Fisher, Bryce Montes de Oca). -Brignac enjoyed a long and successful playing career, spending parts of nine years in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was initially drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft, out of St. Amant High School in Louisiana.
