GAME INFORMATION

EASTERN LEAGUE AWARDS: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies swept the Eastern League Weekly awards for the second-straight week, with **RHP Jonah Tong** (EL Pitcher of the Week) and **OF Nick Morabito** (EL Player of the Week) taking the honors from May 12-18. Tong has won the award in back-to-back weeks and 1B/OF Ryan Clifford won EL Player of the Week prior to Morabito. Tong (W, 6.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 8 K, 94 pitches) was dominant against Hartford on Saturday, in his first start since tossing 6.2 perfect innings with 13 strikeouts in a combined perfect game against Reading. It marked Tong's third time winning EL Pitcher of the Week in his career. Morabito had his best series of the season in Hartford last week (7 G, .462 AVG, 12-for-26, 1.248 OPS, HR, 3 RBI, 6 R, 5 XBH, 6 SB) and won EL Player of the Week for the first time.

LAST GAME: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies defeated the Richmond Flying Squirrels, 4-1, on Tuesday in the series opener at Mirabito Stadium. OF Alex Ramírez crushed a walk-off three-run home run in the bottom of the ninth, which marked his first home run of the season and Binghamton's third walk-off and second walk-off home run this season. RHP Jack Wenninger (5.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 5 K) tossed 5+ innings for the seventh time in eight starts. Binghamton's bullpen was dominant in four scoreless innings: RHP Joshua Cornielly (1.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 1 K), RHP Anthony Nunez (1.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 3 K), and RHP Carlos Guzman (W, 2.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 3 K).

GUTS. GLORY. RAM.: OF Alex Ramírez hit a walk-off three-run home run to win Tuesday's game against Richmond in the series opener. It marked Ramírez's first home run of the season and Binghamton's second walk-off homer this year (William Lugo vs. REA on May 7. Ramírez is riding a four-game hit streak, hitting .429 (6-for-14) with a 1.252 OPS, 1 HR, 3 RBI, 3 R, 2 2B, 3 XBH, 1 BB, and 4 SB in that span. Ramírez doubled his season-RBI total from three to six with the three-run homer. The 22-year-old ranks tied for the fourth-most stolen bases (13) in the Eastern League.

FEELING 22: OF Nick Morabito, the Mets No. 17 prospect (MLB Pipeline), has been red-hot since he turned 22 years old on May 7, hitting .327 (16-for-49) with a .879 OPS, 1 HR, 4 RBI, 11 R, 6 XBH, and 8 SB in 13 games. Morabito is currently riding a 10-game hitting streak, hitting .405 (15-for-37) with a 1.072 OPS, HR, 4 RBI, 8 R, 5 2B, 6 XBH, and 8 SB in that span. He was named the Eastern League Player of the Week for his efforts in Hartford last week (7 G, .462 AVG, 12-for-26, 1.248 OPS, HR, 3 RBI, 6 R, 5 XBH, 6 SB). Morabito finished the series with back-to-back 3-hit games and 3-straight multi-hit games. Morabito currently ranks among the EL with 25 R (T-4th), 15 SB (T-2nd), and 10 2B (T-4th). He is in his first AA season and was the 2024 Mets MiLB POY.

FIGHTER JETT: SS/CF Jett Williams, the Mets No. 1 prospect and MLB's No. 51 overall prospect (MLB Pipeline), has reached base in 31 of his 34 games and has recorded a hit in 27 of his 34 game this season. The 2022 first-round pick had a strong series at Hartford last week (7 G, .320 AVG, 8-for-25, 2 HR, 5 RBI, 5 R, 2 2B, 6 BB, 1 SB). Williams is riding a 7-game hit streak and 10-game on-base streak, hitting .360 with a 1.187 OPS, 2 HR, 5 RBI, 5 R, 5 XBH, 5 BB, and 2 SB over the hit streak. Since April 15 at Reading, Williams has reached base in 26 of 27 games. The 21-year-old ranks among the EL with a .388 OBP (5th), .905 OPS (6th), .517 SLG (9th), 11 2B (5th), and 17 XBH (T-3rd most), a .292 AVG (T-10th), and 21 R (T-11th).

BUILT CLIFFORD TOUGH: 1B/OF Ryan Clifford, the Mets No. 4 prospect (MLB Pipeline), is riding a 4-game hit streak with 3 multi-hit games in that span. Over the last four games, Clifford is hitting .500 (7-for-14) with a 1.468 OPS, 1 HR, 6 RBI, 4 R, 2 2B, and 4 BB. His BAbip in the last four games is .750. In 17 games in May, Clifford is hitting .305 with a .938 OPS, 4 HR, 16 RBI, 9 R, 7 XBH, and 7 BB. In May, Clifford is tied for the Eastern League-lead with 16 RBI and ranks second with 4 HR. Clifford is tied for the third-most HR (7) and fourth-most RBI (25) in the EL this season. The 21-year-old was the EL Player of the Week last homestand (May 7-11 v. REA - .474 AVG, 3 HR, 9 RBI).

LAST START: Pintaro recorded eight strikeouts over 4.2 scoreless innings and allowed just three hits and one walk on Thursday at Dunkin' Park against Hartford...Pintaro struck out five batters over the first two innings...Faced no more than four batters in any inning in the game.

-Reid Brignac is now the second-longest tenured manager in Binghamton history, behind Pedro Lopez (2012-16).
-In 2024, Brignac led a Rumble Ponies team that at one point won 10-conesecutive games, which marked the franchise's longest winning streak since 2006. Brignac also oversaw Eastern League Pitcher of the Year and Mets Minor League Pitcher of the Year Brandon Sproat's dominant stint at Double-A. Brignac helped the Mets' MLB staff after the MiLB season.
