ZAVALA HOMERS IN LOSS TO WICHITA:

The Frisco RoughRiders were clipped by the Wichita Wind Surge 6-4 on Sunday afternoon from Equity Bank Park. Wichita (15-12, 52-44) jumped on top in the bottom of the first when Andrew Cossetti swatted a three-run home run to take a 3-0 lead. Frisco (9-17, 47-48) then answered in the top of the second on Aaron Zavala's lead-off homer, trimming the lead to 3-1. In the bottom of the second, Kyler Fedko lifted a sacrifice fly, padding the Wind Surge lead to 4-1. Cossetti then bashed his second long ball of the game in the bottom of the sixth, stretching the lead to 5-1. The RoughRiders pulled closer in the top of the seventh when Ian Moller blooped a two-run single and scored on a wild pitch, shaving the lead to 5-4. In the top of the eighth, Kala'i Rosario hit a solo homer to lift Wichita in front 6-4. Wind Surge reliever Cole Percival worked a scoreless ninth to earn the save. Wichita reliever John Stankiewicz (2-4) received the win, working two shutout innings. Frisco starter **Ben Anderson** (4-5) took the loss, yiedling four runs over five frames.

PICKING UP THE OFFENSE:

After a tough month in June on offense, hitting .218/.308/.306/.614 with a league-worst 3.4 runs per game and just 13 homers (tied for second-fewest in the league), the Riders have been better in July. The Riders are tied for fourth in batting average (.237), fourth in slugging (.362), fifth in OPS (.666), third in home runs (19) and fifth in runs per game (4.5). The Riders are also 28-for-34 in steals during the month.

HE IS ABIMELECTRIC:

Abimelec Oritz has been on fire at the plate in July. In the month, he is hitting .288/.354/.534/.888 over 18 games with six doubles, four home runs, 10 RBIs and seven walks. In his last nine games, he is batting .389 (14-for-36)/.410/.694/1.104 with five doubles, two home runs and six RBIs.

WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

Aaron Zavala walked twice on July 18th, collecting his 207th career walk in a RoughRiders uniform to break the all-time franchise record, previously held by **Guilder Rodriguez**. Making it much more impressive, Zavala accomplished the feat in 312 games with a 15.1 percent walk rate over four seasons (2022-2025) while Rodriguez needed 524 RoughRiders games from 2009-2015 and a 9.8 percent walk rate.

HOLD ME CLOSE AND DON'T LET GO: In their last 14 games, the RoughRiders have had the lead or a tie game in the eighth inning in 11 of the 14 games, but they are 5-9. The Riders have blown six saves during that span. Their bullpen ERA of 5.03 in July is last in all of Double-A and while they have allowed 49 earned runs, they have also surrendered 12 unearned runs.

K-ROD ON FIRE:

Keyber Rodriguez has been swinging a hot bat for the Riders recently. Since June 15th, in his last 25 games, he is hitting .326 (31-for-95)/.407/.400/.807 with seven doubles, five RBIs, 12 walks, 12 runs scored and just 15 strikeouts. In July, he is batting .288 (17-for-59) over 16 games.

CAULEY! CAULEY, CAULEY ANYTIME:

Cam Cauley has been incredible for the RoughRiders lately on offense. In his last 62 games since May 7th, he is batting .276/.335/.461/.796 with 17 doubles, eight home runs, 25 RBIs and 15 stolen bases. In his last 27 games, he is slashing .298/.341/.509/.850 with seven doubles, five home runs, 14 RBIs, 20 runs scored and eight steals.

The RoughRiders have now stolen at least one base in 24 of their last 28 games. Over those 28 games, they have stolen 46 total bases, which is tied for second in the league. Sebastian Walcott is first in the league with 12 steals in that span while Cam Cauley is seventh with eight. Overall this season, the Riders are fourth in the league with 114 stolen bases.

WALLY'S WORLD:

Rangers top prospect Sebastian Walcott has showed off incredible consistency this season. In April, he hit .244 with a .766 OPS, in May, produced a .257 average and .811 OPS, but struggled with extra-base hits in June, hitting .239, but just a .640 OPS. This season, his walk rate of 12.2 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.6 percent, a career low. This season, he is on pace for 35 steals over 124 games, which would best his prior career high of 27 last year. The only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A are Elvis Andrus (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22). Walcott participated in the Futures Game for the second season in a row over the All-Star Break, going 0-for-1 with a sacrifice fly and a groundout to shortstop while playing third base defensively. Over an 13-game on-base streak, he is hitting .294 (15-for-51)/.368/.529/.897 with one double, one triple, three home runs and


