INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Jake Woodford struck out six in 6.0 innings, but his lone blemish — a solo home run off the bat of Moises Ballesteros in the second inning — was the difference as the Indianapolis Indians fell 1-0 to the Iowa Cubs on Thursday night at Victory Field. Ballesteros, the Chicago Cubs' No. 6 prospect according to MLB Pipeline and playing in just his third career Triple-A game, opened the second inning with a 427-foot shot over the wall in right-center. The long ball was his first for Iowa and 10th overall after hitting nine with Double-A Tennessee. The Indians tallied five hits through the first six innings but couldn't break the seal. Alike Williams doubled to start the bottom of the first but was stranded at third following a sacrifice bunt. In the next frame, Matt Gorski and Matt Fraizer collected back-to-back singles with one out, but Gorski was thrown out at third base on Fraizer's knock to right. Two innings later, Malcom Nuñez notched a one-out double but was left aboard, and a two-out single by Mike Jarvis and subsequent walk to Williams posed a minor threat in the fifth inning until Llover Peguero lined out sharply to third. Trey Supak (W, 1-0) outdueled Woodford with 6.0 scoreless innings, issuing one walk with one punchout. I-Cubs reliever Ethan Roberts retired all five batters he faced with three strikeouts, and Hunter Bigge (S, 2) pitched around a two-out walk to Canaan Smith-Njigba in the ninth. The game finished in 2 hours and 10 minutes, the fastest nine-inning game at Victory Field this season, and the second quickest behind a 6-1 win at Iowa on May 26 that was completed in 2 hours and 7 minutes.

SHUTOUT WIN, SHUTOUT LOSS: The Indians won the second game of the series on Wednesday night, 2-0, before coming out on the wrong end of a shutout on Thursday night, losing 1-0. The consecutive shutouts in which Indy won by shutout only to get blanked in the following game had not happened since the Indians won 6-0 vs. Louisville on July 14, 2017, and then lost on July 15 to the Bats by a 2-0 final.

CHOPPIN' WOOD(FORD): Jake Woodford delivered a quality start for the second time in as many outings with the Indians last night, striking out six and scattering four hits in 6.0 frames of one-run ball. After failing to record a quality start in each of his first five outings this season with Triple-A Charlotte, Woodford has reeled off six quality starts in his last seven appearances dating back to May 1 with the Knights. During that stretch, he is 0-3 with a 2.36 ERA (11er/42.0ip) and 34 strikeouts against only seven walks. With Indianapolis, he is 0-1 with a 2.25 ERA (3er/12.0ip), no walks, 13 punchouts and 0.92 WHIP.

PITCHING LESSONS: The Indians' overall 1.85 ERA (16er/78.0ip) over the last nine games leads all 30 Triple-A teams in that stretch and ranks second among all 120 full-season minor league teams (trailing Double-A Hartford [1.76]). The Indians' bullpen has been at the center of that success, logging an International League-best 0.82 ERA (3er/33.0ip) in that time. None of Geronimo Franzua (4.2ip), Brent Honeywell (5.0ip), Chris Gau (3.0ip), Isaac Mattson (5.0ip), Ben Heller (1.0ip) or Justin Bruhl (1.0ip) have allowed a single run during that stretch.

BULLPEN BULLETS: The Indians' bullpen has boasted a number of effective individual stretches beyond last week's success at Jacksonville:

REHAB CENTRAL: The Pirates today announced that catcher Joey Bart and utilityman Ji Hwan Bae will begin their respective rehab assignments with the Indians tonight. Bart is the seventh major leaguer assigned to Indy on eight separate rehab assignments this season, joining Bae (also: April 9-14), infielder Alike Williams, catchers Jason Delany and Yasmani Grandal, and right-handed relievers Colin Holderman and Carmen Mlodzinski. Bart, 27, was placed on the 10-day injured list on May 28 (retroactive to May 27) with a left thumb injury. He appeared in 22 games with Pittsburgh, hitting .267 (16-for-60) with seven runs, three doubles, four home runs, 12 RBI and an .879 OPS. Behind the dish, he logged a .994 fielding percentage (one error, 163 total chances) across 162.1 innings. Bae, 24, was placed on the 10-day injured list on June 4 (retroactive to June 3) with a right wrist sprain. He began the season on the injured list with a strain of his left hip muscle and was optioned to Indianapolis after completing a rehab assignment with High-A Bradenton and Indy. He was recalled by Pittsburgh on May 21 and hit .208 (5-for-24) with five runs and two RBI in eight big-league games before suffering his latest injury. In 27 games with Indianapolis this season, Bae hit .367 (36-for-98) with 23 runs, nine extra-base hits, 15 RBI, 21 walks and seven stolen bases. Across 144 career games in an Indians uniform, including his 2022 Team MVP campaign, Bae owns a .306 batting average (168-for-549) with 113 runs, 30 doubles, seven triples, 13 home runs, 69 RBI and 39 stolen bases.

TONIGHT: The Indians continue their lone homestand vs. the Iowa Cubs, Triple-A affiliate of the Chicago Cubs, tonight at 7:05 ET at Victory Field. The Indians and I-Cubs faced off at Principal Park in Des Moines, Iowa, from May 21-26, splitting the series 3-3. In that series, the Indians launched 14 home runs. RHP Luis Cessa (2-2, 4.04), who has gone 1-0 with a 2.35 ERA (2er/7.2ip) in two appearances (one start) against Iowa this season, will square off against RHP Dan Straily (0-4, 5.95). The 35-year-old faced Indianapolis for the first and only time in his career on May 23 this season at Iowa, and he was tagged for seven runs (six earned) on eight hits, including four home runs, in 3.0 innings pitched.

CESSA IMPRESSA: Right-hander Luis Cessa tossed 3.0 innings and allowed two earned runs in his Indians debut last Saturday at Jacksonville. He started the season with Triple-A Omaha, where he went 2-2 with a 3.89 ERA (17er/39.1ip) in 11 games (10 starts). Cessa, 32, has 208 career big-league games (35 starts) under his belt and owns a 17-22 record, 4.43 ERA (209er/425.0ip) and 331 strikeouts at the game's highest level. His best campaign in the major leagues came in 2021, when he went 5-2 with a 2.51 ERA (18er/64.2ip) in 53 games between New York (AL) (29 games) and Cincinnati (24 games).

THIS DATE IN 2014: Chris McGuinness went 4-for-5, Jaff Decker went 3-for-5 with three RBI and Nevin Ashley went 3-for-4 with four RBI as the Indians put up four multi-run innings to beat Norfolk, 10-4. All of Ashley's hits came for extra bases with two doubles and a triple, while Decker sent a game-tying two-run home run out of the park in the third inning.
