SUNDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Fisher Cats, 19-1, to earn a series split. Richmond scored seven runs in the first inning, including a two-run double by **Brett Auerbach** and a grand slam by **Riley Mahan**. **Armani Smith** added an RBI double in the second and **Tyler Fitzgerald** hit a two-run homer in the third to open a 10-1 lead. In the seventh, **Carter Aldrete** hit a solo homer, his third home run of the week. Richmond scored three in the eighth, including a two-run homer by Auerbach. In the ninth, **Jacob Heyward** hit a solo homer, **Tristan Peters** worked a bases-loaded walk, Auerbach hit a two-run double and **Sean Roby** brought in a run with a sac fly to open a 19-1 lead. **Jake Dahlberg** started and pitched five scoreless innings. The 19 runs scored were the second-most in a game for Richmond this year and five homers tied the second-most in a game this season.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. The two teams split a six-game series at The Diamond from June 21-26 to close out the first half. This series marks the Flying Squirrels' first trip to Portland since June 4-6, 2019, when Richmond won two-of-three in a the series.

WE ARE HEADED NORTH: The Flying Squirrels are in the second leg of a 12-game road trip to New England, their first visit to the league's two northernmost cities since the 2019 season. The two series against New Hampshire and Portland are the Flying Squirrels' only two sets this year on the road against Eastern League Northeast Division Richmond does not visit Binghamton, Hartford, Somerset or Reading this season, although all four of those teams have played or will play in Richmond.

TICKET PUNCHED: The Flying Squirrels clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division First-Half title with a win on May 26 paired with a loss by the Akron RubberDucks against the Harrisburg Senators. Richmond finished the first half tied with Akron, but held the tiebreaker with a 7-5 head-to-head record. The league adopted the split-season format in 2019. After playing a full-season system last year, they returned to the split-season format this year. The Flying Squirrels will play in the Eastern League playoffs for the third time in franchise history. In 2011, they swept the Senators in the division series before falling to the Fisher Cats in the ELCS, three games to one. In 2014, they eliminated the RubberDucks in four games before being swept in the championship series by the Binghamton Mets.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 11-21 to open the second half. They have lost 13-of-the-last-18 games, including a season-high six-game losing streak from July 14-23. The Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost seven and split four this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 1,120 strikeouts (11.1 per game) and rank fourth with 132 homers. The Flying Squirrels are 24-27 on the road this year. Richmond is 23-19 in games decided by two-or-less runs. They are 12-17 overall against teams from the Northeast Division, including a 3-3 record in road games.

THE SEA DOGS are leading the Northeast Division second-half standings by a half-game over Hartford and Somerset. They have won two-of-their-last-three games after dropping the previous five straight. Portland's roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 Red Sox prospects, including RHP Bryan Mata (7), RHP Thad Ward (14), 3B Alex Bineas (20), INF/OF/C Stephen Scott (23), SS Christian Koss (24), OF/INF Ceddanne Rafaela (25) or OF Wilyer Abreu (29).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Wil Jensen** makes his fourth Double-A start. Last time out, Jensen worked six scoreless, one-hit innings with no walks and five strikeouts in a win at New Hampshire on Wednesday night. That performance earned him the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week Award, which was announced on Monday. In his first two road starts for the Flying Squirrels, Jensen has pitched 11.0 scoreless innings. Jensen began the season with High-A Eugene, going 6-3 with a 2.84 ERA in 15 starts and three relief outings. Over his last four High-A starts, Jensen went 4-0 with a 1.46 ERA (4 ER/24.2 IP) and struck out 30 batters. At the time of his promotion to Double-A, Jensen ranked tied for second in the Northwest League in wins (6) and tied for seventh in strikeouts (77). After four years at Pepperdine, Jensen signed as an undrafted free agent with the Giants in 2020. Jensen was born in Phoenix but grew up near Salt Lake City. **For more on Jensen, see page two.**

FOR PORTLAND: Right-hander Michael Wacha makes a rehab start. He was placed on the injured list by the Red Sox on July 8 with right shoulder inflammation. Wacha made his first rehab appearance for the Worcester Red Sox on Thursday and pitched 4.2 hitless, scoreless innings. In that game, he combined with relievers Andrew Politi and Chase Shugart for a no-hitter against the Durham Bulls. Wacha was drafted by the Cardinals with the 19th-overall pick in the 2012 MLB Draft out of Texas A&M. He climbed to the majors the next year with St. Louis and was named MVP of the 2013 NLCS. Wacha spent seven seasons with the Cardinals, earning an NL All-Star selection in 2015. After pitching for the Mets and Rays the last two years, Wacha signed with the Red Sox as a free agent in November. Through 13 starts in the majors this year, Wacha is 6-1 with a career-low 2.69 ERA.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in total attendance (296,258) and average attendance (6,172). Richmond is 14th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night and again on July 4 are the largest crowds in all of Double-A this year.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 132 home runs this season, which is fourth in the Eastern League. On Sunday in the 101st game of the season, **Riley Mahan** hit a grand slam to give the Flying Squirrels their 128th homer of the season, breaking the previous franchise record. Last year, the Flying Squirrels broke the team record for homers with 127 in just 113 games, passing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 179 home runs. **Sean Roby** is tied for third in the league with 23 homers on the season, with 19 coming at The Diamond.

MARTY PARTY: **Brandon Martorano** is riding a six-game hit streak dating back to July 28, during which he is batting .455 (10-for-22) with a homer, two doubles and four RBIs. He has hit in the leadoff spot in each of the last three games, including a 4-for-5 game on Thursday night and a two-hit game on Saturday. In his three games this year batting first in the order, Martorano is batting .444 (8-for-18) with two homers and four RBIs.

BACH TO FORM: In his last six games, **Brett Auerbach** is batting .417 (10-for-24) with four homers, three doubles, 11 RBIs and seven runs scored. He opened last week's series with a four-game game on Tuesday at New Hampshire, including a homer. He went deep again on Wednesday, his third straight game with a home run. On Sunday, Auerbach picked up four hits again, including a homer and three doubles, and drove in six runs. On Monday, Auerbach was announced as the Eastern League's Player of the Week for August 2-7.

ALRIGHTY, ALDRETE: On Tuesday night, **Carter Aldrete** hit a grand slam for his first Double-A homer. It was Aldrete's third grand slam of the season, including two for High-A Eugene prior to his promotion. Aldrete homered again on Saturday and Sunday. On the road trip, Aldrete is batting .286 (6-for-21) with three homers and seven RBIs.

ROBUST: **Sean Roby** hit his 21st homer of the year on July 4 against the Fightin' Phils, moving him ahead of **David Villar** for the most home runs in a season in Flying Squirrels franchise history. He added his 22nd homer on July 7 and his 23rd on July 9. Roby is tied for third in the EL in homers. He has hit 19 homers at The Diamond this season, which is a new record for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history, ahead of 10 by **Adam Duvall** in 2013. It is also a new franchise record for the most career homers at The Diamond. He has also set the franchise record for the most multi-homer games in a season and a career with four.

FITZ ON FIRE: **Tyler Fitzgerald** has hit eight home runs over his last 19 games since July 10. In that span, he is batting .304 (21-for-69) with 15 RBIs. He homered twice in last week's series at New Hampshire. Fitzgerald homered five times, all solo shots, over a six-game span from July 10-17 heading into the mid-season break. In his first four games out of the mid-season break from July 22-27, he went 0-for-14, but responded with a nine-game hit streak since July 28, during which he is batting .361 (13-for-36) with three homers, a double and 10 RBIs. Fitzgerald's 18 home runs this season are tied for the third-most in a season in franchise history with **Jarrett Parker** (2013) and **Mario Lissou** (2014), trailing only 20 by **David Villar** (2021) and 23 by **Sean Roby** (2022).

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Frankie Tostado** is ranked fourth in batting average (.284). **Sean Roby** is tied for in homers (23). **Shane Matheny** is fifth in OBP (.391). **Mike Gigliotti** is ninth in OBP (.374) and tied for fifth in stolen bases (23). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is tied for ninth in homers (18).

WHERE THE SEA DOGS RANK: In the Eastern League, Christian Koss is ranked sixth in batting average (.282), fifth in RBIs (62), second in hits (102) and fifth in total bases (163). Tyler Dearden is 10th in OBP (.373). David Hamilton is tied for first in triples (7) and first in stolen bases (50).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have five players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Ryan Murphy** (11), **Cole Waites** (19), **Ricardo Genoves** (27) and **Chris Wright** (30). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. Waites is listed as having the "Best Fastball." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Murphy (11), **Tristan Peters** (25) and Genoves (30). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 20 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 23 overall prospect.
