- LAST TIME OUT:** For the first time since 2015, Cedar Rapids won the Midwest League West Division Title, taking down Peoria 9-3 in game three of the series. After dropping game one of the series on the road, 4-3, the Kernels took game two 9-4 and, behind a four-run first inning, once again erupted for nine runs in game 3. Luke Keaschall and Noah Cardenas both picked up three hits in the win, while Jose Salas' two-run triple in the seventh inning was the dagger. On the mound, C.J. Culpepper got the win in the winner-take-all game three, tossing five one-run innings with a high-A high eight strikeouts.
- WHAT'S AT STAKE:** A Cedar Rapids win would put the Kernels up 1-0 in the Midwest League Championship series, give the Kernels two chances to clinch their first title in 29 years at home, and set the Loons on the brink of elimination.
- TALKIN BOUT PLAYOFFS?:** For the 10th straight season Cedar Rapids enters the postseason. Last season, the Kernels fell to South Bend 2-1 in the MWL West Division Championship series, in 2021, the Kernels fell in a winner-take-all game five in the championship series against QC. Overall, the Kernels have not won the MWL championship since 1994, the team's second year as an Angels affiliate. The 29-year drought is the longest in the MWL league outside of Dayton who hasn't won a league title since its move to Dayton in 2000.
- TALE OF BOTH HALVES:** With the 3-1 victory over South Bend on 6/16, the Kernels captured the first half title in the MWL Division. CR has now reached the postseason in 10 straight seasons, every year as a Twins affiliate. On 9/5 CR followed up the first half victory by clinching the 2nd half with a 6-3 win over WIS.
- HOME SWEET HOME:** The Kernels finished off the regular season winning the final seven home series of the year, holding a record of 34-8 over that stretch dating back to the start of June. Overall CR finished the home slate with a league best 47-19 (2nd in all of MiLB, Bowling Green 41-16), the Kernels best home winning % since at least '05 (as far back as MLB Research tool goes). CR finished the year at home scoring 5.5 runs with a +63 run differential.
- THE SERIES:** For the first time ever, Cedar Rapids and Great Lakes meet in the postseason in the 2023 Midwest League Championship series. The Kernels and Loons have yet to meet as high-A affiliates and last met in 2019 when GL swept a three-game series in CR. The Kernels haven't been to Midland since 2018, when Cedar Rapids swept a three-game set. In 2023, the Kernels and Loons held the two best regular season records in the league, and both won their respective first-half titles. the league leader in RBI with now 94 on the season and in home runs with 21. The 94 RBI are the most in a season by a Kernel since Zander Wiel had 86 in 2016. No Kernel has notched more than 100 RBI since Adam Brent Walker tallied 109 in 2013.
- LIKE A LEGEND:** Cedar Rapids C Noah Cardenas and RHP Jackson Hicks were both honored as 2023 Harmon Killebrew Award Winners. The award is given to one player on every Twins minor league affiliate for outstanding community service. Cardenas was the recipient for the Kernels this year after taking home the honor in Fort Myers last year, while Hicks was honored as Fort Myers' award winner for his efforts prior to his promotion. Kernels manager Brian Dinklemen also took home the award as a member of AAA Rochester in 2013.
- WALK-OFF WONDERS:** Jorel Ortega's walk-off single Saturday night 8/19 was the Kernel's sixth walk-off win this season. Five of the Cedar Rapids walk-offs have come on singles and one via grand slam.
- STARS OF TOMORROW:** 12 of the Twins' top 30 prospects are on the currently on the CR roster. Top outfield prospect Emmanuel Rodriguez (no. 3 Twins, 53 overall), no.2 pitching prospect Connor Prielipp (6), INF Luke Keaschall (11), RHP Cory Lewis (13), RHP C.J. Culpepper (14), INF Jose Salas (17), OF Kala'i Rosario (19), INF Noah Miller (24), RHP Zebby Matthews (25), INF Ben Ross (26), RHP Alejandro Hidalgo (28) and C Noah Cardenas (30).

The third year, Loon first made his Great Lakes debut making nine starts in 2021, going 0-3 with a 4.17 ERA. Made just one start and pitched just three innings in 2022 before missing the rest of the year with injury and started this season on the IL, making his debut on 5/25. Held a 4.50 ERA in his nine outings at home compared to a 2.77 ERA in his seven outings on the road. Right-handed batters hit .296 off him while he held lefties to a .246 BAA. Born in Seoul, South Korea, singled by the Dodgers in 2018.
