- After four ties throughout the game, Daniel Perez put the Blue Jays ahead once and for all with a walk-off, RBI triple in the bottom of the ninth to 6-5 win at TD Ballpark.
- Jays starter Juaron Watts-Brown struck out eight batters in four innings, marking the third straight start he's struck out eight or more.
- Alexis Hernandez belted a solo homer in the second inning, part of a three-hit night. Victor Arias launched his own solo shot in the third - his first since April 11.
- After the Blue Jays took a 5-4 lead in the bottom of the eighth on a wild pitch, the Mets tied the game with two outs and two strikes in the top of the ninth on another wild pitch.
- In the bottom of the ninth, Hernandez came back from down 0-2 to run the count full and then single, setting up Perez's game-winning triple.
- The win marked just the fourth time this season Dunedin has won while being out-hit (4-16).

HEAD ABOVE WATER

Last night's Dunedin victory pushed the team's record to 24-23 - the first time the Jays have reached above .500 since April 24, as the Jays dropped to 9-8 with a loss to Jupiter. Dunedin dove as far as six-games below the .500 mark (13-19, 14-20). With last night's Clearwater loss to Lakeland, the Jays are eight games out of first place.

FEELING STREAKY

Following six straight wins to climb to 20-20 last week, the Blue Jays lost three straight to Bradenton. Following those three straight losses, Dunedin has won four straight.

WALK OFF WEDNESDAY

Last night's walk-off win was the Blue Jays' eighth walk-off result of the season - three for, and five against. Manuel Beltre collected each of the first two walk off knocks before Perez's triple last night.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

32 of the Blue Jays 47 games this season (68%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has an 17-16 record in those games. Dunedin has played 16 one-run games (8-8). The Jays have won five of their last six one-run contests.

JAYS JUICE

With two homers last night, the Blue Jays have homered in 14 of their last 16 games. Across that stretch, 10 different players have gone deep. Dunedin is second in the Florida State League and third in all of Single-A with 35 homers. Dunedin's 24 homers this month are the most in Single-A.

HOW ABOUT HERNANDEZ?

Alexis Hernandez continued tear last night, going 3-4 with a home run - his third in the last five games. Across his current five-game on base streak, Hernandez is 10-20 with 7 RBIs and just 2 strikeouts. Across those five games, Hernandez has boosted his batting average from .165 to .232, and his OPS from .509 to .724.

K COUNTER

Dunedin tied a season high with 15 strikeouts as a pitching staff last night, including eight from Juaron Watts-Brown. The Blue Jays pitching staff is third in the FSL and fourth in Single-A with 499 puunchouts this season (10.6 per contest), being St. Lucie and Clearwater.

WELCOME BACK, WILLIAMS

First baseman Peyton Williams began a rehab assignment with the D-Jays last night. Williams, a 2022 7th round draft pick, has spent parts of the last two seasons with Dunedin, hitting .274 with 7 homers in 45 games. He was selected as the league's best first baseman according to Baseball America's survey of FSL coaches last season. Williams is the seventh minor or major league rehabber to appear in Dunedin this season.

TAKE A WALK

This week's six game set pits the Florida State League's most walk-prone pitching staffs against each other. The Blue Jays have issued 241 walks to lead the league, while St. Lucie is not far behind with 237.

RELYING ON RELIEF

Much of the Blue Jays' success this season has largely hinged on its bullpen, with distinct differences in relief performance in wins and losses. In wins, Jays relievers have pitched to a 3.27 ERA with a 1.23 WHIP. In losses, the bullpen has accumulated a 5.79 ERA with a 1.72 WHIP.

- Full name is Grant Rook Rogers.
- Played a four-season college career, pitching two seasons at Panola College and two at McNeese State...
- Tallest player on the roster at six-foot, seven-inches.
- Throws five pitches from two arm slots; including a sweeper and change-up from a dropped, three-quarters arm slot.
