- Dunedin came out of the All-Star Break on a high note, defeating Lakeland 4-1 on Friday night at Joker Marchant Stadium.
- Nolan Perry turned in a season-high 4.2 innings, striking out five while allowing just one run.
- Nic Deschamps picked up three hits and two RBIs - both coming via two-out hits.
- Yhoangel Aponte delivered the go-ahead knock for Dunedin, a bases loaded, two-RBI single in the top of the fifth.
- Dunedin tallied all four of its runs with two outs.
- Bo Bonds earned the save with a season-high 2.2 innings of work, retiring all but one batter he faced.

## BIG STRETCH

The Blue Jays first nine games coming out of the All-Star Break come against the other two of the top three teams in the FSL West: three games at Lakeland, followed by six games at home with Fort Myers. With Friday's win, the Blue Jays jump Lakeland for second place. Dunedin will host Lakeland for six games August 27-31. Their six game set with Fort Myers will be the final time the D-Jays play the Mighty Mussels this season.

## NIC'S BIG NIGHT

Nic Deschamps' 3-4 performance last night marked the first three-hit game of his pro career and first multi-hit game in over a month (6/5 at Palm Beach). The Quebec native is hitting .245 through 30 games, compared to his .170 average in 57 games last season. Deschamps was signed by the Blue Jays as an undrafted free agent following his final season of High School in 2021.

## APONTE PACKS A PUNCH

Yhoangel Aponte's 2-5 performance marked the 20-year old's first multi-hit game since returning from a stint on the development list and in the FCL on July 11. Aponte's last multi-hit game came on May 19 at Jupiter.

## JAMMIN' IN JULY

The Blue Jays' team OPS in July stands at .804 through 13 games - the second-best mark in the FSL this month. Dunedin leads the league in runs scored this month, posing 69 (5.3 per game).

## WHAT A DIFFERENCE A BREAK MAKES

After Blue Jays pitching allowed 19 runs on a whopping 30 hits in the final two games before the break, Nolan Perry, JJ Sanchez and Bo Bonds combined to allow just one run on Friday night.

## SERIES SUCCESS

With last week's split with Tampa, the Blue Jays have achieved a split or better in eight of their last nine sets. Dunedin has especially been strong at home, having gone without a series loss at TD Ballpark since Clearwater took four of six from the Jays April 16-21 (six series). The lone series loss came at Lakeland, June 25-30, when the Flying Tigers took four of six games. A win tonight would mark a series victory, and Lakeland's first series loss since April.

## TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

The Blue Jays have played 32 one-run games this season - the most in the FSL. The Jays are 16-16 in those contests. 59 of the Blue Jays 87 games this season (67%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has a 32-27 record in those games.

## GIVING IT THE COLLEGE TRY

Of Toronto's 21 draft picks in last week's first year player draft, 16 were drafted out of college, including 10 of the team's first 11 selections. The selections could lead to an influx of college talent to Dunedin's roster. Of the team's 28 current players, just eight played college ball.

## FERNANDO IS THE FUTURE

Blue Jays RHP Fernando Perez represented Toronto in the All-Star Futures Game on July 13 in Texas, throwing one inning, allowing a solo homer. In 13 starts this season, Perez ranks among the Florida State League leaders in ERA (3.48), Ks (81), innings (75), and WHIP (1.01). Perez is the first active member of the Dunedin roster to be selected since Francisco Rios in 2016. Perez had his best month of the season in June, pitching to a 2.86 ERA in 22 innings across four starts.

## EIGHT IS SURE GREAT

Jorge Bautista's eight inning shutout effort on July 12 marked the first time since 2018 (Maverik Buffo, 7/9/2018 vs Clearwater) a Dunedin pitcher completed eight full innings. Bautista is the only hurler in the FSL to complete eight full innings this season and one of four pitchers to do so in Single-A in 2024. Despite the accomplishment, Bautista was not awarded FSL Pitcher of the week.

- Drafted by the Blue Jays in the 19th round of the 2022 draft out of Westfield High school in the Indianapolis area... Signed out of Cincinnati commitment.
- Was the fifth player to be drafted out of Westfield HS - recent draftees include big leaguers Ryan Pepiot (TB) and Kevin Plawecki (BOS).
- Low-to-mid 90s fastball is considered best pitch, complimented by a slider and split changeup.
- Pitched to an 0.74 ERA in 38 innings during his senior year of high school, striking out 83.
