TODAY'S GAME

Round Rock and Oklahoma City close out their six-game series at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark on Sunday afternoon with first pitch scheduled for 2:05 p.m. Express RHP A.J. Alexy is slated for the day's start against RHP Justin Hagenman.

LET'S RECAP

Round Rock posted a seven-run second inning to create a large gap early on. 1B Elier Hernandez hit a solo home run to start the frame's scoring. 2B Nash Knight followed with a triple before back-to-back walks from SS Ryan Dorow and CF Bubba Thompson loaded the bases. A third straight walk from LF Steele Walker scored Knight. After a Dodgers pitching change, 3B Diosbel Arias sent Dorow and Thompson across home plate for a 4-0 lead. Express DH Sam Huff blasted a home run that scored Walker and Arias, increasing the gap to 7-0 to end the frame. Oklahoma City put their first runner across in the fourth inning as RF Jason Martin homered. The Dodgers trimmed the gap to 7-3 when 2B Ty Kelly tripled then scored on a wild pitch in the fifth frame and DH Michael Busch hit a home run in the sixth. The E-Train added an insurance run in the ninth inning to go up 8-3. After working a leadoff walk, Huff moved to third base on a Josh Sale single before Hernandez sent Huff home on a sacrifice fly. RHP Yerry Rodriguez allowed one OKC hit during the bottom of the frame, but retired the final batter to secure the win.

ALL ABOUT ALEXY

Express RHP A.J. Alexy is slated for Sunday's series-finale start. The righty has amassed a 3-3 record and 7.31 ERA (49 ER/60.1) through 14 games, including 13 starts, which is good for the second-highest number in the Pacific Coast League. Alexy's 64 K's sit at No. 9 in the league.

MORE AND MORE DINGERS

Both 1B Elier Hernandez and DH Sam Huff blasted home runs for the second consecutive game after going yard on both Friday and Saturday nights. Hernandez' home runs this series bring his season total to eight while Huff has now hit nine dingers for the Express. The two sit at the top of the Round Rock leaderboard for home runs this season as the E-Train offense is still looking for a batter to crack into double digits. Ten different batters have hit five or more home runs while with Round Rock during the 2022 campaign.

WALK THIS WAY

Round Rock drew multi-digit walks for the sixth time this season as all but one starter earned a free base during Saturday night's victory in Oklahoma City. 2B Nash Knight and SS Ryan Dorow led the way as they both worked two walks, contributing to the E-Train's total of 10.

NOTEWORTHY PERFORMANCES

Four Express batters recorded multiple hits on Saturday night with 1B Elier Hernandez, 3B Diosbel Arias, RF Josh Sale and C Jack Kruger all tallying two knocks each. Three earned multiple RBI as DH Sam Huff lead the way with three and Hernandez and Arias each earned two.

THAT REALLY BIG INNING

Round Rock's second inning on Saturday night saw seven runs, four of which came from home runs. It was the highest-scoring second frame this season and matched the team's season high for runs scored in a single inning. The number also was the highest-scoring inning by an Oklahoma City opponent so far this year.

RECENT TRANSACTIONS

On Saturday, INF Nick Tanielu was added to the team's Injured List while RHP Daniel Robert came off of the Injured List. RHP Spencer Patton was assigned outright to Round Rock. After the day's action, LHP Taylor Hearn and INF Ezequiel Duran were optioned to the Express. On Sunday, RHP Glenn Otto completed his ML rehab assignment and RHP Josh Sborz was recalled by Texas. RHP Demarcus Evans was designated for assignment.

Alexy, RHP Justin Anderson, INF Sherten Apostel, RHP Kohei Arihara, RHP Jason Bahr, INF Ryan Dorow, OF Elier Hernandez, INF Yonny Hernandez, C Sam Huff, C Jack Kruger, LHP Jake Latz, RHP Tyson Miller, C Yohel Pozo, RHP Yerry Rodriguez, RHP Ryder Ryan, RHP Nick Snyder, OF Leody Taveras, INF Davis Wendzel and RHP Cole Winn. RHP Daniel Robert, INF Josh Smith and OF Bubba Thompson all made their Triple-A debuts on Opening Day - April 5, 2022 while RHP Hever Bueno made his on April 6.

STATING THE FACTS

American-born players hail from 12 different states, including Alabama, Arizona, California, Colorado, Florida, Illinois, Louisiana, Michigan, New York, North Carolina, Pennsylvania and Texas. The team's lone Texan, RHP Justin Anderson hailed from Houston before a collegiate career at the University of Texas at San Antonio.

In addition to the 27 players from the United States, Sherten Apostel calls Curaçao home, Ezequiel Duran, Elier Hernandez, Yerry Rodriguez and Leody Taveras all hail from the Dominican Republic, Kohei Arihara is Japanese, Jesus Tinoco and Yohel Pozo are Venezuelan, Diosbel Arias is from Cuba and Meibrys Viloria joins from Colombia.

EXPRESS MANAGER MATT HAGEN

The 2022 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Matt Hagen's Triple-A coaching debut. A resident of Austin, Hagen spent the last two seasons as the Texas Rangers' Minor League Field Coordinator. He is entering his seventh season in the Rangers organization after previously managing the Low-A Hickory Crawdads in 2018 and 2019 as well as the Short-Season Spokane Indians in 2017. In his three seasons as a manager, Hagen has compiled a .550 winning percentage, combining to post a 192-157 overall record, including capturing the South Atlantic League Championship with Hickory in 2019. He originally joined the Texas organization in 2016 as a coach for the Crawdads.

Prior to joining the Rangers, Hagen spent three years as the head coach at Four Points Baseball in Austin. Upon the conclusion of his playing career in 2012, Hagen returned to his alma mater, Liberty University, as an assistant coach. He also had a stint on the Liberty staff in 2007 and spent three off-seasons as a strength coach for the Flames' baseball, men's soccer and football programs.

An infielder in his playing days, Hagen was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 12th round of the 2002 MLB Draft and spent time in both the Seattle and San Diego Padres organizations, reaching Double-A Mobile in 2006. Hagen continued his playing career in the independent Frontier and Atlantic Leagues from 2007-2012, earning Atlantic League All-Star honors three times. Hagen was a first team All-Big South selection at Liberty University, leading the conference in home runs and RBI as a junior, and was a member of Liberty's 2000 Big South Championship team that advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Hagen graduated from Liberty in 2012 with a degree in Sport Management.
