WSH AFFILIATE NOTES

Double-A Harrisburg split both halves of their twin bill in Altoona (PIT) last night, winning game one 3-1 before dropping game two, 2-0...**3B CAYDEN WALLACE** drove in two and launched his eighth homer of the season in game one.

R PLOT TWIST: Following Wednesday evening's wild come-from-behind victory, the Rochester Red Wings faced Lehigh Valley in game three of their series on an icy Thursday night, looking to extend their season-long winning streak to six games...Rochester's five-game winning streak came to an end, however, as the IronPigs earned a 6-3 victory...CF **ANDREW PINCKNEY** turned in a two-hit night while adding a double at the plate, and RHP **HOLDEN POWELL** delivered a solid outing in his 2026 Red Wings debut...Rochester will look to get back on track and guarantee at least a series split tonight, sending RHP **CHANDLER CHAMPLAIN** to the mound against IronPigs RHP Alan Rangel.

R WHAT DID I MISS?: California-born right-hander **CHANDLER CHAMPLAIN** is slated to make his sixth start (8th app.) tonight, and second of the season against Lehigh Valley (4/10)...he is coming off his second consecutive quality start and third-straight victory on 5/9 at Syracuse, where he allowed two earned runs across 6.0 full innings, while striking out three with no walks...has allowed two earned runs or fewer in each of his last four starts dating back to 4/22 at SWB, and leads all International League starting pitchers (min. 10.0 IP) with a 0.74 WHIP and .211 opponent's OBP over that stretch...he also ranks second in opponent's OPS (.422) and ERA (1.66, 4 ER/21.2 IP), ranks third in opponent's SLG (.211), and fourth in hits-per-nine innings (4.57), and batting average against (.155)...
R 5/9 marked the first time Champlain has earned the win in three consecutive starts since 5/19-6/2 in 2023 with High-A Quad Cities (KC).

R MAKE THEM PAY: 3B **YOHANDY MORALES** picked up two more hits at the plate last night, going 2-for-4 with his seventh double of the season while adding two runs scored...he has now notched an extra-base hit in five consecutive games and hit safely in six, the first of which is the longest active streak in the International League and T-2nd-longest in all of professional baseball (MLB & MiLB)... Morales now leads the IL with a 1.043 OPS through the early part of the season, ranks second with a .353 batting average (48-for-136), third with a .603 SLG, T-4th with 82 total bases, T-5th with 48 total hits, and sixth with a .440 OBP...he leads, or holds a share of the lead among all Nationals Minor Leaguers in batting average, home runs (9), hits, and total bases...
R The Miami product is slashing .412/.468/.721 with nine XBH (6 HR, 3 2B) across 20 games at ESL Ballpark this season...a .412 batting average (28-for-68) is the highest by a Red Wing at home (min. 50 AB) since Danny Santana hit .464 [32-for-69] at what was then known as Frontier Field in 2015.

R HIT 2 HARD 4 THE RADIO: CF **ANDREW PINCKNEY** logged his ninth multi-hit game of the season last night...the Alabama product went 2-for-5 at the dish and notched a pair of hits, including a double, while adding an RBI...Pinckney now ranks second on the team with 24 RBI this season, just behind teammate **YOHANDY MORALES** (25)...he is now four RBI shy of becoming the eighth Red Wing since 2015 to notch 100 RBI with the team, joining INF **TREY LIPSCOMB** as the only other active player...his double in the third game off the bat at 112.3 MPH, the hardest-hit two-bagger by a Red Wing since Nick Schnell on 6/27/2025 vs. SYR...he now has four hits this season that have registered at 110 MPH+ off the bat, tied with Yohandy Morales for most on the team.

R SHABANG: Former first-round draft pick **DYLAN CREWS** tallied a hit and a run last night, going 1-for-3 in his matchup against the IronPigs pitching staff...he also tacked on two walks in the losing effort, and carries a home slash line of .357/.418/.657 with 15 RBI in 19 games at ESL Ballpark...the LSU alum has now hit safely in a team-leading eight consecutive games since 5/6, his longest hitting streak since 4/15-23 in 2025 with Washington...over the course of his current streak, Crews has tallied five XBH (HR, 4 2B) and ranks fifth among all International League hitters with an average EV of 95.2 MPH...
R Crews is now five hits shy of 200 in his MiLB career, across just 187 games played.

R NEW BESTIE: Making his 2026 Red Wings debut last night, RHP **HOLDEN POWELL** turned in 3.1 innings of relief, allowing one earned on five hits while striking out six and walking none...he is the first Red Wings reliever to strike out six batters since RHP Cory Abbott on 6/5/2022 vs. BUF, and first to do so without allowing a walk since RHP Bryan Bonnell on 10/1/2021 vs. SWB...he is the 37th player overall, and 22nd pitcher to suit up for the Red Wings this season.

THIS DAY IN RED WINGS HISTORY...

2015: 11 years ago today, the Red Wings rallied for three runs in the bottom of the ninth, beating Lehigh Valley in walkoff fashion, 5-4...CF **ERIC FARRIS** drove in the first run of the inning via an RBI single, which was followed by a two-RBI, game-winning base knock from 2B **JAMES BERESFORD**...Farris finished the ballgame with a 3-for-4 line at the plate, including his first and only homer with the Red Wings in 2015...RHP **LESTER OLIVEROS** picked up the win on the mound, tossing 2.0 scoreless frames on just one hit with a strikeout.

- Recalled by Washington on 5/6 before appearing in a game for the Red Wings...appeared in four games in relief with the Nationals (6.35 ERA, 4 ER/5.2 IP), striking out five without allowing a walk...optioned to Rochester on 5/15.
