YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels snapped a six-game losing streak with a 6-3 win over the Curve. **Diego Velasquez** opened the scoring with an RBI single in the first inning. The Curve tied the score in the top of the second with an RBI single by Yoyner Fajardo. In the second, **Zach Morgan** put the Flying Squirrels back in front with a solo homer in the second. In the third, **Turner Hill** hit a two-run triple and Velasquez added a run with a sac fly to open a 5-1 lead. Matt Fraizer hit a two-run homer to pull the score to 5-3. **Justin Wishkoski** added an insurance run with an RBI single in the bottom of the eighth. **Cameron Cotter** recorded the final six outs to close a save in his Double-A debut. **Nick Morreale** started and allowed one run over four innings. **Julio Rodriguez** threw two scoreless innings to pick up his first Double-A win.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates in the third of a six-game series at The Diamond. The two teams first met for a six-game series in Richmond from June 4-9 with Richmond winning the first two before Altoona won the last four. From July 30-August 4 in Altoona, the Curve won the first four games before the Flying Squirrels won the final two. The two teams will also face off to close the season at Peoples Natural Gas Field from September 10-15.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS snapped a six-game losing streak with their win on Wednesday night. They are 3-10 in their last 13 games since August 9. They have been held to two-or-less runs in six-of-their-last-11 games since August 10's doubleheader. They have been held to one-or-less runs and four-or-less hits in four-of-their-last-11 games.

THE CURVE have gone 4-12 in their last 16 games since August 3. Last week, the dropped four-of-six against the Baysox at home. Altoona's roster features four of Baseball America's top-30 Pirates prospects, including LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 5), SS Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 7), OF Jase Bowen (No. 27) and OF Tres Gonzalez (No. 28). Chen is also rated by Baseball America as having the best change-up in the Pirates system. MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects list including two Altoona players, including Solometo (No. 7) and Cheng (No. 18).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander John Michael Bertrand makes his league-leading 24th start of the season and the sixth of his career against the Curve. In his last start last Friday at Harrisburg, Bertrand threw 6.2 scoreless innings. In that game, he induced four double plays over the first four innings. It was tied for the most by a pitcher in a single game in the Eastern League with a 50.6 groundball percentage. In fielding, he leads all MiLB pitchers in total chances (33) and assists (27). Against the Curve, Bertrand is 1-2 with a 4.73 ERA in five career starts. This year, he has made nine scoreless starts, all at least five innings, which is the most in the Eastern League. Bertrand has been named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week twice this year, first for throwing seven perfect innings against the Baysox on April 27 and then for working six hitless innings in Bowie on May 23. Last season, he climbed three levels, working from Low-A San Jose to High-A Eugene before joining Double-A Richmond in July for the remainder of the season. For the year, he led all qualified Giants minor league pitchers in winning percentage (.688) and ranked second in ERA (3.65), second in wins (11), tied for second in WHIP (1.23), third in innings pitched (118.1) and fourth in BAA (.248). Entering 2024, Bertrand usa rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University of Notre Dame. He was selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. For more on Bertrand, see page two.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Grant Ford makes his second start and his 29th appearance of the season. He last pitched on Sunday against the Baysox and allowed one run over two relief innings. In his previous outing, he made his first start of the year and threw three scoreless innings against the Baysox last Thursday, his second-longest outing of the year. Ford was selected in the fifth round of the 2019 MLB Draft by the Pirates out of the University of Nevada.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Flying Squirrels have turned 82 groundball double plays this year, which is the most in the Eastern League. Richmond pitcher John Michael Bertrand has induced 19 double plays this year, which is the most in the minor leagues. The Flying Squirrels turned four double plays on July 27 against Binghamton, which is tied for the most in a game this season in the league. They matched that feat with four double plays in the first four innings at Harrisburg last Friday night with Bertrand pitching. Those four double plays were tied for the most induced by a pitcher in the Eastern League dating back to 2005, which is the first year those statistics are readily available. It has been accomplished by three other Richmond pitchers, including Daryl Maday in 2010, Clayton Blackburn twice in 2014 and Garrett Williams in 2019. Bertrand's 19 GIDPs this year league since at least 2005), 21 by Clayton Tanner in 2010 and 20 by Mike MacDonald in 2010.

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 53 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .298 (64-for-215) with four homers, 12 doubles, nine walks and 30 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he had not homered in 34 games before belting a two-run shot on August 9 off the scoreboard in left-center at The Diamond. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in 19-of-46 games dating back to June 15.

TAKE THE JAIRO: On Sunday, **Jairo Pomares** hit his team-leading 11th home run of the season, a 445-foot blast at FNB Field in Harrisburg. It snapped a stretch of 29 games without a home run. He went deep again in his next game on Tuesday at The Diamond against the Curve. For the season, Pomares' 12 homers are tied for fourth-most in the Giants organization. He is also tied for sixth with 32 extra-base hits. Last homestand, Pomares hit a walk-off double for an extra-innings win over the Yard Goats in the second game of a doubleheader on August 10.

TO THE MUNGUIA: In his 14 August games, **Ismael Mun-guia** is batting .346 (18-for-52), sixth-highest in the Eastern League, with three doubles and five RBIs, adding four stolen bases. He has at least one hit in 12-of-14 games played this month. Last year, he hit .282 over 75 games with the Flying Squirrels. In his Richmond career, Munguia is batting .286 (120-for-419) in 106 games, which is the sixth-highest career mark in franchise history (min. 450 PA).

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an aver-age of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Di-amond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 fol-lowed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked 10th among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,513), just shy of the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: This season, 12 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is the most in a season in franchise history. In 2014, 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including Joe Panik, Adam Duvall, Andrew Susac, Matt Duffy, Jackson Williams, Edwin Escobar, Hunter Strickland, Chris Dominguez, Gary Brown, Brett Bochy and Chris Heston. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are Erik Miller (2023 Flying Squirrels), Landen Roupp (2022-23), Kai-Wei Teng (2022-23), Nick Avila (2022), Randy Rodriguez (2022-23), Mason Black (2023), Gerson Garabito (2021), Spencer Bivens (2023), Nick Avila (2023), Hayden Birdsong (2023-24), Parker Dunshee (2023) and Grant McCray (2024). Dating back to 2022, 21-of-the-last-23 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) and Dunshee (Braves) being the only exceptions. Last year saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster.

LOTTA INS, LOTTA OUTS, LOTTA WHAT-HAVE-YOUS: The have been 60 players who have seen action for the Flying Squirrels this year, which ties the franchise record for a single season. In 2018 and 2019, the Flying Squirrels also had 60 different players see time on the field. This season, there have been 31 different pitchers used by the Flying Squirrels, which includes appearanc-es by Andy Thomas on June 1 against the SeaWolves and Luis Toribio on August 10 against the Yard Goats. There have been 31 different hitters who have seen at least one plate appearance with Richmond this season.

PROSPECT WATCH: Two of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF Vaun Brown (No. 11) and SS Diego Velasquez (No. 26). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, LHP John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features two Richmond players, including Velasquez (No. 17) and LHP Jack Choate (No. 21)
