CHIRINOS SHINES IN 10-1 WIN

Yonny Chirinos struck out 10 in 6.0 shutout innings on Saturday as Jacksonville rolled by Nashville 10-1. The victory was wire-to-wire for the Jumbo Shrimp, as **Tristan Gray** kicked off the scoring with a two-run homer in the first. In the third, both **Deyvison De Los Santos** and **Griffin Conine** added two-run doubles to make it 6-0. An **Agustín Ramírez** RBI single and Conine RBI ground out got things to 8-0 in the fifth. The Sounds' lone run came in the seventh, but consecutive bases-loaded walks in the ninth by Conine and **Will Banfield** set things at 10-1.

THE START OF SOMETHING?

Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have given the club a chance to win each of the last four games with strong starts. Over these four contests, **Adam Mazur**, **Darren McCaughan**, **Xzavion Curry** and **Yonny Chirinos** have yielded only four runs, all earned, on 12 hits in 22.2 innings for a 1.59 ERA. They have combined for 23 strikeouts against three walks. Jumbo Shrimp starting pitchers had surrendered at least four runs in the three games prior to this run.

IT GETS LATE EARLY OUT HERE

Against a tough Nashville starting rotation, Jacksonville's offense has performed reasonably well, knocking out Chad Patrick after three innings on Tuesday, Logan Henderson after 3.2 frames on Wednesday and DL Hall after 2.2 innings on Saturday. However, the Sounds' vaunted bullpen has completely dominated the Jumbo Shrimp offense. Nashville relievers have combined to surrender only five runs on 10 hits in 23.2 innings (1.90 ERA, 25 K, 8 BB) in the series thus far.. From the sixth inning on in the five games of the set thus far, Jacksonville is just 8-for-60 (.133) at the plate.

ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp have struggled this season at 121 Financial Ballpark, mustering a meager 28-34 (.452) record. Jacksonville has scored only 264 runs at home (4.3 per game), the fewest in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp are scoring about a half-run more per game on the road, totaling 295 (4.8 per game). Meanwhile, also on the road, Jacksonville has surrendered only 267 runs (4.4 per game), tied for the second-fewest in Triple-A. They've yielded the 11th-fewest runs of any team at home (307, 5.0 per game).

STRAIGHT AND NARROW

Of Jacksonville's 10 wins during the month of August, seven have come by three runs or fewer, including five by just one run. The Jumbo Shrimp have played in 42 games this season decided by one run, second to lowa (25-18) for the most in the International League. Jacksonville registered 85 contests (57.0 percent of total games, 39-46, .459) contests decided by three runs or fewer during the 2023 season. In 2024, their 79 games this season determined by these narrow margins represents 64.2 percent of the club's 123 games played thus far in 2024. The Jumbo Shrimp are 40-39 (.506) in those tightly-decided contests.

DF LOS SANTOS CLAUS

Over his last six games, **Deyvison De Los Santos** is 10-for-26 (.385) at the plate with three doublse, two home runs, eight RBIs and seven runs scored. On the season, the 21-year-old leads all of Minor League Baseball in home runs (35) and RBIs (105) and slugging (.616) while ranking second in hits (138), third in extra-base hits (59), fifth in OPS (.984), tied for 10th in runs (80) and 15th in batting average (.316). De Los Santos has 10 of Triple-A's 300 hardest-hit balls this season (111.0 MPH exit velocity & above) despite only playing in 73 games at the level. Among the 490 players with at least 100 plate appearances in Triple-A this season, De Los Santos' 90.6 average exit velocity ranks 26th.

WHEN THERE'S A WILL, THERE'S A WAY

Jacksonville catcher **Will Banfield** suffered through a disastrous 10-game stretch from May 30 through June 14, going 0-for-36 at the plate. In the 32 games since then, however, the Snellville, Ga. native completely turned his season around. Since this stretch began with a three-hit game on June 16, Banfield is 37-for-115, slashing .322/.362/.513/.875 with five doubles, one triple, five home runs, 22 RBIs, eight walks and 18 runs scored.

SHRIMP BITES

Luarbert Arias is Jacksonville's 23rd different starting pitcher this season. The franchise record came in 2022, when 26 different Jumbo Shrimp pitchers started a game. Arias' last start came in the finale of a doubleheader on August 24, 2022, when he pitched for Low-A Jupiter against Daytona (4.0 IP, H, 2 R, 2 ER, BB, 5 K).
