YESTERDAY: After a two hour, one minute rain delay, the Captains won a shortened, seven-inning game at Dayton, 4-2. Kevin Coulter started for Lake County and held Dayton to two runs on one hit, a two-run homer by Ivan Johnson in the fourth. The Captains' offense manufactured a run in the first on a double steal, in which George Valera scored from third when Joe Naranjo took second. Gianpaul González doubled home two runs in the fourth and Naranjo knocked in another with a double in the seventh.

NINE INNINGS? WHAT'S THAT?: None of the Captains' last five games have been nine innings long. Lake County has played four seven-inning games and one 12-inning game since Friday. The Captains played a seven-inning game Friday that was supposed to be the start of a doubleheader, but game two was postponed by rain. They then played a doubleheader on Saturday, a 12-inning game Sunday and a seven-inning game on Tuesday that was shortened by virtue of starting after 9 p.m. due to a rain delay.

TOP OF THE HEAP: The Captains are alone in first place in the High-A Central League East Division for the first time since May 23. Entering yesterday, the Captains held a share of first for the first time since May 26. The 26th is the last time the Captains held a share of a playoff position, but that was before Major League Baseball's July 1 announcement that there would be postseason baseball in the minors this season.

PLAYOFF PICTURE: The Captains enter today 1.0 game behind the Cedar Rapids Kernels for the second playoff spot in the High-A Central League (HAC). Lake County, Cedar Rapids, the Dayton Dragons and the Great Lakes Loons are all separated by just 2.0 games. The Quad Cities River Bandits currently hold the top playoff spot and are 11.0 games ahead of second place. The top two teams in the HAC eam playoff bids (regardless of division).

WALK-OFF WINNERS: The Captains had walk-off wins in three consecutive days to close out their series against West Michigan. George Valera hit a walk-off homer to lead off the seventh inning on Friday in what was supposed to be the first game of a doubleheader before game two was postponed. Julian Escobedo hit a walk-off double in the seventh inning to beat West Michigan in game two of a doubleheader on Saturday. Escobedo then hit a walk-off single in the 12th inning on Sunday.

LEADING THE PACK: George Valera does not yet have enough plate appearances to qualify for the league leaderboards. Among hitters with 230+ plate appearances, however, Valera leads the High-A Central League in wRC+ (163) and OPS (.975). He is also second in BB% (19.2), third in on-base percentage (.418) and third in slugging percentage (.557).

NO REST, NO PROBLEM: George Valera has played 21 consecutive games. Since his last game off (July 23), Valera is slashing .270/.466/.651 (1.117 OPS). Valera has seven homers and more walks (23) than strikeouts (19). José Tena has played 18 straight games, all of which have been at shortstop. Since his last game off (July 25), he is slashing .292/.363/.611 (.974 OPS) with seven homers.

TOP HEAVY: José Tena and George Valera have carried the Captains' offense in August. The duo boasts a .431 on-base percentage this month, while the rest of the team has a .286 OBP. Valera and Tena alone account for 24 of Lake County's 51 RBI in August (47.1%)

LIFT OFF: The Captains' pitching staff has allowed the most home runs in the High-A Central League since July 1 (57). Lake County's offense has the third-most homers in the league in that span (47).

LAST TIME OUT: In Burns' second start back from the Injured List, the right-hander worked 2.2 innings and allowed three runs, two earned. He allowed an RBI single to Ulrich Bojarski in the second and a two-run homer to Gage Workman in the third. Burns struck out five, but also walked three and hit a batter. The Captains scored five runs between the second and third innings to beat West Michigan, 5-3.

COLLEGE ACCOLADES: After a solid freshman campaign, Burns broke through in 2019 and was named a third team All-American by *Perfect Game*. Prior to the 2020 season Burns was Named Preseason All-SEC, Preseason All-America by *Baseball America*, *Collegiate Baseball*, *D1 Baseball* and *Perfect Game*. In just four games in 2020 Burns was off to a hot start striking out 12.9 per nine innings and had a 3-1 record with a 2.42 ERA.

TEAM USA: In 2018, Burns was selected to the USA Collegiate National Team. Burns appeared in four games allowing five runs over 7.2 innings. He allowed nine hits, struck out six and walked one. Also on the team were back to back first overall draft picks Adley Rutschman (2019) and Spencer Torkelson (2020).

2020 DRAFT: Cleveland selected Burns in the CBA round (36th overall) of the 2020 draft, which was shortened to five rounds. Burns was Cleveland's second selection in the draft, following SS **Carson Tucker** (1st Round – 23rd overall).

PREVIOUSLY DRAFTED: Originally drafted by the New York Yankees in the 37th round of the 2017 draft out of Decatur High School (Decatur, AL).

MR. ALABAMA: Burns was named Mr. Alabama his senior season of high school. Along with being one of the top pitchers in the state he hit .467 with 16 homers, 10 doubles, four triples and 46 RBI as a senior in High School.

RECRUITING BATTLE: A highly sought after recruit in Alabama, Burns originally committed to the University of Alabama but decided to weigh other options when Crimson Tide Head Coach Mitch Gaspard resigned in 2016, eventually committing to Auburn. Burns grew up an Alabama fan and only committed to the Tide's arch-rival Auburn due to Head Coach Butch Thompson's experience developing pitchers. He says he took a lot of heat for committing to Auburn from friends he grew up with.

STAR MENTORS: While at Auburn, Burns had a variety of people with great track records to learn from. Auburn Head Coach Butch Thompson has had 16 of his former pitchers make the big leagues including 10 since 2014. He previously worked as the Associate Head Coach and Pitching Coach at Mississippi State. Among the stars coached by Thompson is 2018 number one overall pick Casey Mize. Burns worked closely with Mize at Auburn, and was throwing partners with Mize during his freshman year of 2018. He took over the premier role in the rotation from Mize, operating as the teams Friday night starter in 2019 and 2020. Tim Hudson joined Thompson's staff in 2020 as a volunteer assistant and pitching coach, also getting the chance to mold Burns' game. The former Auburn great and 17 year MLB veteran worked with Burns for a short time in 2020 before the season was shortened but Burns says the two will have a relationship for the rest of his life.

FUTURE DEVELOPMENT: Kevin Goldstein of *FanGraphs* says Burns brings "big stuff out of a small package" with good secondary pitches to go with solid velocity (sits 93-94) on his fastball. Eric Longenhagen, also of *FanGraphs*, describes Burns as "an org based bet." Longenhagen sees Burns as someone who's future value mostly revolves around Cleveland's recent ability to develop pitchers. "I've always been a little lower on him due to his middling velocity and projectionless frame, but he executes his secondary stuff very consistently" Longenhagen said. *Baseball America* sites Burns offspeed pitches as potential plus pitches, especially his curveball and slider. Burns earns praise for his dedication, makeup and desire to learn.
