LAST GAME

The Baysox lost their sixth-consecutive game on Thursday night, falling to the Richmond Flying Squirrels, 7-2. Richmond led off the game with a solo home run from Ismael Munguia, hit off Baysox starter Justin Armbruester. Despite the early damage, Armbruester would go on to have another impressive outing, as he threw five innings with no further damage, only one additional hit allowed, and five strikeouts. Coby Mayo would tie the game with an RBI single in the third. However, Richmond would score two unearned runs in the sixth off a pair of errors from SS Cesar Prieto. This would not be the last time that Bowie's defensive miscues would haunt them. Mayo doubled and scored on a wild pitch for the Baysox in the bottom half of the sixth, cutting the Richmond lead to 3-2, but the Flying Squirrels would pull away by sending all nine men to the plate and scoring four runs in the seventh, for the second consecutive night no less. Richmond once again capitalized on an error to start the frame, this time from 2B Anthony Servideo, and would go on to cruise to the comfortable win thanks to another strong showing from the Flying Squirrels' bullpen.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Richmond Flying Squirrels enter this week's series atop the Eastern League Southwest division with a 9-6 record - a game ahead of jointsecond-place Akron and Harrisburg and 3.5 games ahead of the Baysox. The Double-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants, Richmond is coming off a first-half division title and postseason berth in 2022. The Flying Squirrels are led by second-year manager Dennis Pelfry, who returns most of his staff from last season. Through 15 games, Richmond is on a tear at the plate, leading the league in team average (.252), on-base percentage (.354), OPS (.732), hits (122) and runs (86). The Flying Squirrels also have the fewest errors in the league (10) and most strikeouts as a pitching staff (170). They are led by Patrick Bailey, who sits third in the Eastern League with 17 hits, and leads the team with a .340 average - sitting second on the team with 9 RBI. Riley Mahan leads all Flying Squirrels with three home runs and a .514 slugging percentage. Bailey (No. 11 SF) is one of seven Giants Top 30 prospects currently on the Richmond roster, per MLB Pipeline. Others include OF Luis Matos (No. 7 SF), along with RHPs Mason Black (No. 10 SF), Landen Roupp (No. 13 SF), Carson Seymour (No. 17 SF), Randy Rodriguez (No. 26 SF), and Ryan Murphy (No. 27 SF).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Richmond looks to start right-hander Kai-Wei Teng for game one of today's doubleheader . Teng has gone 11.2 innings in his first three starts of his second season with the Flying Squirrels. He's allowed four earned runs on six hits, but has struck out 25 - meaning nearly 72% of his outs have been recorded via the strikeout. A native of Taichung, Taiwan, Teng spent all of last season with Richmond. He started a Giants' system high 28 games for the Flying Squirrels, posting a 5.22 ERA in 136.1 innings with a franchise-record 169 strikeouts. Teng faced the Baysox five times in 2022, posting a 6.74 ERA overall, but only a 2.35 ERA in three starts at Prince George's Stadium. Teng was traded to the Giants from the Minnesota Twins organization in the Sam Dyson deal in July of 2019. He was originally signed by the Twins as an international free agent in October of 2017. Teng features a mid-90s fastball, along with a changeup, slider, and curveball For game two of the doubleheader, the Flying Squirrels look to send out right-hander Ryan Murphy. The fifth round selection by the Giants in 2020 has allowed a team-high 19 hits in just 13.2 innings through his four appearances (2 starts). Murphy has allowed nine runs, good for a 5.93 ERA on the season. He allowed two runs in 3.2 innings of relief Sunday against Erie. Murphy made two starts for Richmond towards the end of last season, but spent most of his year with High-A Eugene, posting a 2.90 ERA in 31 innings. Murphy pitched collegiately at Division II Le Moyne (NY) alongside MLB arm Josiah Gray in 2018. Currently the No. 27 prospect in the Giants' system, Murphy features a Low-90s fastball, along with a slider, curveball, and changeup.

HAIL CÉSAR

Cesar Prieto has been on a tear at the plate to start the season. The Bowie infielder leads the Eastern League, and is second in Double-A, with 26 hits. Prieto also ranks third in the Eastern League with a .371 average, among qualified players. He has hits in 14 of his 17 games. Among Baysox, Prieto leads the way in hits, average, and on-base percentage. He's also third on the team in slugging percentage and OPS. Prieto's 26 hits are also the most in the Orioles' system in 2023.

HESTON IS BESTON

OF/1B Heston Kjerstad has shown out as one of the top bats in the Eastern League so far this season. Kjerstad's solo shot on Wednesday was his sixth long ball of the season in his first 15 Double-A games - the most at that level this season. Beyond the home runs, Kjerstad also demonstrated consistency across the Eastern League leaderboards - ranking third in OPS (1.013), second in extra-base hits (9), while also ranking first in slugging percentage (.629) and total bases (39). Kjerstad has the second-most home runs throughout the Orioles' system, while his OPS and slugging percentage sits at third.

MOUND REBOUND

The pitching staff as a whole has bounced back nicely for Bowie so far in 2023. After posting a 4.42 staff ERA last season, Bowie has the thirdbest team ERA in the Eastern League, and the fourth-best in all of Double-A, through 17 games at 3.39. Baysox starters have been effective throughout the early portion of the season in particular, with a 2.84 staff ERA amongst starters, including five outings of at least five shutout innings. Bowie arms have limited the free passes, with the second fewest number of HBP (5) and fewest walks (67) in the league

After leading Bowie to a division-best 41-26 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the helm of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles system. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlantic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Baltimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his wife Whitney, and his two daughters, Madilyn and Cameron. Hitting Coach - Sherman Johnson

Sherman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023. Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.

Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

Fitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann Forrest Hermann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen IronBirds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Hermann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Hermann spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization. Herrmann also worked with current Orioles left-hander John Means at 73 Premier Pitching Performance center in Missouri. He pitched for three seasons at the University of Evansville prior to his coaching career.

Fundamentals Coach - Tim DeJohn

However, DeJohn also received a promotion this season and will also serve as the Minor League Infield Coordinator at all levels. DeJohn has been a part of the Orioles' staff since November 2019. Prior to joining the organization, DeJohn had an extensive background in the college ranks. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.

Development Coach - Ryan Goll
