Vasil was promoted on the heels of being named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Month for May. Vasil, the Mets' top pitching prospect, according to Baseball America, went at least six innings in three starts in May and tossed eight innings of one-run ball with seven strikeouts against Hartford on 5/11.

**Luke Ritter Promoted to Triple-A Syracuse:** INF **Luke Ritter** was promoted to Triple-A Syracuse on Monday. Ritter was promoted to Triple-A for the second time, on the heels of being named the Eastern League Player of the week for his performance in Reading. Ritter hit 11 home runs in his last 15 games for the Ponies, including a three-homer game in the series finale and three multi-homer games during the 12-game road trip.

**Recap in Reading:** The Binghamton Rumble Ponies took five of the six games in the series against the Reading Fightin Phils last week, including sweeping a doubleheader on Saturday. **Luke Ritter** hit five homers in the series and had a three-homer game in the finale. **Rowdey Jordan** hit .318 in six games with four homers and eight runs batted in, including two homers on Sunday. **Brandon McIlwain** drove in six runs across six games in the series. **Jose Peroza** hit .375 across four games with two home runs and five RBIs, while **Joe Suozzi** hit .333 across six games with four runs. Binghamton has now taken five-of-six games in two of its last three series (RIC and REA) and has swept two doubleheaders this season.

**Jordan's Brand: Rowdey Jordan** capped off a successful series in Reading with the first multi-homer game of his professional career. In six games in the series, Jordan hit .318 with seven hits, four home runs, one double, eight RBIs, nine runs, five walks, and just three strikeouts. He had a slugging percentage of .909 & 1.353 OPS.

**Portland's Roster:** The Boston Red Sox recently promoted their top prospect and MLB's No. 5 overall prospect, 20-year-old shortstop **Marcelo Mayer** to Double-A Portland. Portland currently has nine of the Red Sox top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline: No. 1 Marcelo Mayer, No. 3 Ceddanne Reafaela, No. 5 Nick Yorke, No. 13 Matthew Lugo, No. 15 Nathan Hickey, No. 18 Niko Kavadas, No. 19 Chase Meidroth, No. 24 Jacob Webb, and No. 30 Phillip Sikes.

2022: Began the season with Brooklyn (A+) and made four starts before being assigned to Binghamton (AA) on May 2. Chacin had a strong Double-A debut last year on May 4 at Hartford. He went seven innings and struckout three batters, while allowing two runs on four hits. Chacin led the Rumble Ponies in innings pitched (101.2) and starts (20) in 2022. He finished third in strikeouts (94) for Binghamton. Chacin pitched to a 4-9 record with a 5.67 ERA at the Double-A level in 23 appearances.

#### Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

AJ Sager - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. Sager served in the same role for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) last season. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo.
