Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send LHP Scott Moss to the mound tonight, looking to stop the skid at two (haven't lost three straight since five game losing streak immediately after clinching the IL West, 8/24-8/28/19). Omaha will counter with LHP Jake Kalish. The Clippers were 26-12 (.684) against left handers in 2019. Kalish has never pitched against Columbus in his career (44G in PCL from 2017-19).

vs. the Storm Chasers

Columbus had not played Omaha in the regular season since 1991, when they were known as the Royals and played in the American Association. From 1988-91, the two leagues played crossover games with the Clippers winning 11 of 21 against Omaha, including six of nine in Columbus. The Clippers met the Storm Chasers in the 2011 Triple-A National Championship in Albuquerque (W, 8-3).

That's Two Thus Far, Shooter

The Clippers have lost consecutive games in the last inning for the first time since 7/30/19 (at Indianapolis) and 7/31/19 (vs. Louisville). In each of the last three seasons, the Clippers have led the IL in last at bat win%, going 16-8 (.667) in 2019, 26-8 (.765) in 2018 and 14-7 (.667) in 2017. Each of the last two losses have seen blown multi-run leads, as well (first time since 6/29-6/30/19 at Louisville).

Johnson on a Roll

After dipping below .300 with an 0x5 day on 8/8/19 vs. Pawtucket, Daniel Johnson hit safely in nine straight (.424, 14x33 from 8/9-8/18). On 8/22/19, Johnson tied his single game best with 5RBI and kicked off a streak of four straight games with an XBH. In his last 24G at Triple-A, he is hitting .330/.402/.549 with 3HR and 13RBI. Yesterday's steal was the 70th of his career and first since 7/26/19 (35G).

Miller Time

Owen Miller will take another shot at giving the three-hole a boost, as Clipper #3 hitters are slashing .147/.216/.206 with 0HR and 2RBI (13th in batting, last in OBP and SLG, tied for last in RBI). Miller went 0x4 in his first go-round in front of Bobby Bradley (5/6 at Louisville), but has hit .517 (15x29) behind Bradley. Miller is one of two IL hitters (Ernie Clement) with a top-37 SLG and 0HR.

Struggles Continue

In 48 games since getting optioned on 7/16/19, **Bobby Bradley** has hit .200/.311/.423 with just 11HR and 27RBI while posting a strikeout in 37% of his PA (75 of 206). Only 11RBI since the option are on non-HR and he has accumulated 79LOB in 48 games. In 43 games immediately prior to getting recalled (5/3-6/21/19), Bradley hit .310/.373/.732 with 21HR and 44RBI (32% strikeout rate, 59K in 185PA).

Bump it Up

Gabriel Arias doubled his season hit total with yesterday's 3x4 performance, raising his average 97 points from .143 to .240 (going into the game, Arias was one of four regulars hitting .150 or below, joining Bradley Zimmer, Bobby Bradley and Nolan Jones). Arias failed to draw a walk yesterday for the first time since opening day, but he still has an eight game on base streak (.424OBP).

Swinging Hard

Heading into tonight, the Clippers have two players among the top four in the IL in strikeouts, as both Bradley Zimmer and Nolan Jones have 16K (two off the lead). Zimmer has seen a full 50% of his trips to the plate end with a walk back to the dugout, while Jones is at 46%. Neither player has homered yet, but Jones does have a double. Bobby Bradley has 13K on the year (35%) and 2HR.

Time to Shine

Tyler Krieger is getting the start at 2B tonight, riding a three game hit streak to start the season (.417, 5x12). Krieger struggled over his last 14G of the 2019 season, batting .158 (6x38) with a HR and 3RBI between Akron and Columbus (only career HR in Triple-A came at Huntington Park vs. Norfolk on 6/9/19), before he was shelved for the rest of the season with a left quad strain on 7/14/19.

Shutting It Down

The Clipper bullpen had not allowed a run in the final third of a ballgame through the first six, but has given up six runs in the 7th or later in the last two games. Despite the last two games (8.2IP, 7ER), the bullpen still carries an IL-best 2.13ERA (28.1IP, 2ER, through first six games). Relievers started the year with 0HR to 132TBF, but have allowed 2HR to the last 25TBF.

Columbus Clippers Game Information

This Date in Clipper History

The Clippers trounced the Syracuse Chiefs 10-2 with a gritty effort from **Dave**Wehrmeister. Wehrmy labored through 8.0 innings, allowing 6 hits and 7 walks while throwing 130 pitches to pick up the win. The 1983 season was his 5th and final year with the Clippers as he finished his career as the

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 years since the move downtown, Huntington Park has ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game, totaling 2.25 per contest (1,763HR, 783 games). Last year, HP averaged over three per game for the first time ever (seventh time averaging over a pair), as the Clippers surrendered a record 127HR and just missed out on triple digits themselves (97HR was second highest team total). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (927 to 895).

Record Destruction

The Clippers broke the established mark for homers in a season (182 in 1983) on 8/7/19 and finished with a total of 213 (most in the IL). From 5/14-6/2, they homered in 20 straight games (44HR total) and they had seven straight multi-HR games from 6/14-6/21 (22HR). On the mound, they broke the record for homers allowed (156 in 1998) on 7/31/19, giving up 198 for the year (2nd most in the IL).

Ain't Over 'Til It's Over

Since the start of the 2014 season, no team has had more come from behind victories than the 210 posted by Columbus (35 last season) and no team has produced a better winning percentage when trailing than the .353 of the Clippers (Scranton/WB ranks 2nd in win percentage at .338 and wins, 192).

Walk-Off Magic

Columbus was 5-2 in walk-off games last season, winning four thanks to the courtesy runner in extra innings (Columbus pitching did not allow a run through first 9.0IP in extras last year). On 6/29/19 at Louisville, they suffered their first walk-off loss of the year, snapping an 81 game streak without (previous loss was 5/31/18 at Buffalo). Additionally, the Clippers ranked 1st in the IL with a 16-8 (.667) record in games decided in the last at bat.

Trending Downward

While ranking in the top three of the IL with a 4.71ERA (3rd), the 2019 Clippers registered their worst mark since the 1998 season (4.85ERA). In 2018, they ranked dead last in the IL with a 4.34ERA, marking the third straight (now fourth) season that the team ERA had gotten worse. From 2011-16, the Clipper staff turned in a sub-4.00ERA five times in six seasons (zero such seasons from 1993-2010), including the best two ERAs of the past 30 years (3.33 in 2015 and 3.65 in 2016).

Doing Damage

In 2019, the Clippers ranked tied for 5th in the IL with 112RBI with the bases loaded, while carrying a .252 average (10th, 36x143, 4HR). In both 2017 and 2018, the Clippers led the IL in RBI with the bases loaded (243RBI total) and paced the circuit in grand slams (16 total, no other team had more than eight).

Free Swingers

After two straight seasons leading the IL in strikeouts, the Clipper lineup was atop the IL again in 2019 (1,392K, 60 more than 2nd place). They obliterated the franchise record (1,297, set in 2017; 2018's total of 1,290 was 2nd worst in franchise history), passing it on 8/22/19 (reduced strikeout rate to 8.3 per game after setting record, 10.1 prior). On the season a Clipper was punched out at least four times in a game on 15 occasions (**Eric Haase** led the team with three golden sombreros).

That's More Like It

In 2019, the Clippers were 50-30 (.625) when playing errorless baseball, while turning in a 31-29 (.517) mark with at least one error. Contrary to logic, in 2018 they actually had a worse winning percentage when playing mistake free (.514), than when committing at least one error (.530). The Clipper defense finished 1st in 2019 (.983) after falling to 6th in the IL in 2018, ending a run of three consecutive seasons ranked among the top three (2015-17 resulted in the three best seasons in franchise history).

One On, No Out Success

When the leadoff batter of an inning reached base in 2019, the Clippers plated him nearly 60% of the time (over 51% only once in the last six seasons, 55% in 2016). Getting more than one base was a specialty of Clipper hitters, as they led the IL with 136XBH to lead off the inning, including 54HR (led the IL, had 28 leadoff homers in 2018). From 4/13-4/20/19, the Clippers hit 16 leadoff doubles over 72 innings, including four straight innings in a win at Louisville on 4/15/19.

Good Baseball

Ernie Clement advanced a runner with a sac bunt on 5/8 at Louisville and the runner came around to score in the win. During 2019, the Clippers struggled in the bunt department (12 successes), but when the advanced runners did score, they were 7-1. During 2018, Columbus was 23-2 in games in which a run was scored after a good bunt attempt (54 successes; won 17 in a row from 4/12-7/31/18).

International Accolades

Bobby Bradley was named International League Player of the Month for May 2019, reaching base in 24 of 25 games during the month while hitting .302/.374/.740 with 12HR (led IL) and 28RBI. **Brandon Barnes, Eric Haase, Josh Smith** and **Asher Wojciechowski** were named to the 2019 IL All-Star Team and Bradley, Barnes and Haase were selected to the postseason squad.

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy makes his Clippers debut in 2021, following Tony Mansolino's championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; Gene Michael-'79, Joe Altobelli-'80, Frank Verdi-'81, Bucky Dent-'87 and Mike Sarbaugh-'10). This season marks Tracy's second year as a manager (first with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 35-49 (.417), 5-3 with Columbus (.625).

Trade Worthy:

Although dwarfed by names like **Trevor Bauer, Yasiel Puig, Franmil Reyes** and **Taylor Trammell**, Moss showed why he was included in the 7/31/19 deal among Cleveland, Cincinnati and San Diego, turning in a 1.46ERA (24.2IP, 4ER) after joining the Cleveland organization in 2019. During his week in the Eastern League, Moss was the only pitcher to record more than 7.0IP with 0ER and he ranked tied for 3rd in the league with 13K. He then made four starts in the IL and did not allow more than 2ER in any of them (two scoreless appearances, including 5.0IP win vs. Louisville on 8/22/19).

Southern League All-Star:

Prior to getting traded, Moss had pitched the entire season with Chattanooga in the Southern League, earning his second career All-Star selection (2017 with Dayton, Midwest League). Moss made 20 starts and at the time of the trade was one of 13 SL pitchers with at least 100.0IP. His 123K ranked 3rd in the circuit, as did his 57BB.

Hot Steaks:

After a rough start to the 2019 season (17.0IP, 12ER), Moss turned in consecutive scoreless outings, including a no-hit bid on 5/6/19 vs. Tennessee (6.0IP, lost by **Joe Mantiply** with two out in the 7th; held opponents hitless for 8.0IP from 5/1-5/6/19). Additionally, Moss struck out 10 Smokies on 5/6/19, his fourth career game with double-digit strikeouts. Combined between Chattanooga, Akron and Columbus, Moss has a 1.75ERA (36.0IP, 7ER) over his last seven starts.

Not Hot Streaks:

Moss started the 2019 season with multiple walks in each of his first eight starts, averaging 7.82BB/9IP (38.0IP, 33BB). That included a career-worst 6BB in his season debut, vs. Montgomery on 4/6/19 (4.0IP; since tied with 6BB in 4.2IP vs. Mobile on 6/2/19). Also, the last Moss victory with the Lookouts, on 7/4/19 vs. Jacksonville, was the last win for Chattanooga until 7/22/19, as the team suffered a 14 game losing streak (lost 20 of 22 from 7/5-7/29/19).
