## RAILRIDERS WIN SERIES OPENER 7-6

Both Griffin Conine and Victor Mesa Jr. homered but Jacksonville fell 7-6 on Tuesday Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. Each team scored a run in the first. Josh VanMeter hit a two-run homer to give the RailRiders the lead. Conine's solo shot came in the bottom of the fourth. After T.J. Rumfield's tworun long ball made it 5-2 in the seventh, Mesa Jr. tied the game with a three-run bomb in the bottom of the seventh. However, two Scranton/Wilkes-Barre runs in the eighth put the RailRiders ahead. Will Banfield collected an RBI triple in the bottom of the eighth, but he was stranded on third.

## FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 17 of Jacksonville's 28 games ( 60.7 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer. The Jumbo Shrimp have excelled in these contests, going 12-5 (.706) in those closely-decided affairs thus far. Last season, 85 of the club's 149 games ( 57.0 percent) were determined by no more than three runs, with the club going 39-46 (.459) in those contests. Prior to that, Jacksonville had been over .500 in games decided by three runs or fewer in every season from 2019-22.

## STEAL HEARTS, NOT BASES

In the 22 games since April 5, Jacksonville has registered only seven stolen bases in nine attempts, both figures that represent the fewest in the International League. That said, the Jumbo Shrimp rank 13th in runs scored (112, 5.1 per game) during this stretch. The club has walloped 32 home runs over this 22 -game run, a figure that ranks second in the IL. Jacksonville also places second in slugging percentage (.480), tied for third in doubles (46) and fifth in both batting average (.274) and OPS (.833), respectively, since April 5.

## SHRIMP ON THE POND

Through 28 games in 2024, Jacksonville has mustered 131 runs ( 4.7 per game), a figure that ranks 22 nd in Triple-A in large part due to the club's struggles with runners in scoring position. Thus far during the 2024 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are a woeful 58 -for-249 (.233/.331/.382/.713, ranking 25th, 26th, 26 th and 26th, respectively, in Triple-A) hitting with runners in scoring position. In 2023, Jacksonville hit just $.247 / .336 / .400 / .736$ with runners in scoring position, figures that respectively ranked 27th, 29th, 27th and 29th in Triple-A.

## TROY MEETS WORLD

Troy Johnston, the Miami Marlins Minor League Player of the Year in 2023, got off to a slow start this season. Through his first 16 games, the Puyallup, Wash., batted just .203/.292/.234/.526 with two doubles, six RBIs, four walks and three runs scored. In his last 12 games, however, Johnston is 18 -for- 48 at the plate, hitting .375/.412/.604/1.016 with eight doubles, one home run, five RBIs and 10 runs scored. Entering play on Wednesday, Johnston is riding a 10 -game hitting streak, the longest active streak in the IL.

## ALWAYS THE BRIDE, NEVER THE BRIDESMAID

Entering play on Wednesday, Jumbo Shrimp infielder Jonah Bride has homered five times in his last 12 games. Bride began the season with Miami, batting just 1-for-7 in five games before getting optioned to Jacksonville. Since coming to the First Coast, Bride is 27 -for- 77 (.351/.480/.740/1.220) with seven doubles, one triple, seven home runs, 15 RBls, 16 walks and 14 runs scored. Bride leads the International League in OPS while ranking second in both on-base percentage and slugging percentage, tied for fourth in extra-base hits (15), sixth in average, tied for sixth in home runs, tied for 17th in doubles (seven) and tied for 20th in walks (17).

## 'CAUSE WHEN YOU'RE 15...

Jacksonville began the season by losing two of three games against Gwinnett, but since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have won 15 of their last 25 games. Of those 15 victories, 11 have come by three runs or fewer. Thus, during this stretch, Jacksonville is only outscoring its opponents by a narrow 119-118 margin. The Jumbo Shrimp's pitching has excelled during this stretch, with the club placing third in ERA (4.43) and eighth in runs allowed (111) in Triple-A during this stretch.

## SHRIMP BITES

On the season, Jumbo Shrimp starters have worked 126.1 innings, or just 50.9 percent of the club's total of 248.1 entering Wednesday. Jacksonville's bullpen has totaled 122.0 innings... Griffin Conine is 11 -for-28 (.393/.541/.750/1.291, 2B, 3 HR, 5 RBIs, 8 BB, 7 R) in his last nine games. He had been 0 -for-20 in the previous six games.

-The Miami Marlins' first-round pick in 2016, Garrett made his professional debut in 2017 but lasted just four starts until an injured elbow forced him to undergo Tommy John Surgery. Garrett went under the knife on June 20, 2017 and missed the rest of the 2017 campaign, as well as the entirety of the 2018 season. While rehabbing, however, he roomed with fellow Marlins prospect Jordan Holloway, who had underwent Tommy John Surgery just five days before Garrett did so.
-Garrett began his high school career at Foley High School in Alabama. However, he moved to Florence when his father, Steve, became the Florence Falcons' head baseball coach.
-Under the tutelage of his father, Garrett was named Alabama's Mr. Baseball as a junior and the state's Gatorade Player of the Year and a first team USA Today All-American as a senior, when he posted a 0.53 ERA with 131 strikeouts in 65.1 innings.

## 2024 SEASON

-Began rehab assignment from a left shoulder impingement on April 5 for Jacksonville.
2023 SEASON
-Garrett began the 2023 season as a long reliever but joined the Marlins starting rotation in April 2023 after Johnny Cueto injured his right biceps.
-Right-handed hitters batted .261/.300/.448/.748 against him in 503 plate appearances, but Garrett held left-handed batters to a $.211 / .276 / .324 / .600$ line in 156 plate appearances.

## 2022 SEASON

-In the major leagues, right-handed hitters batted .280/.346/.455/.801 against him in 284 plate appearances. However, Garrett held southpaws to a $.173 / .247 / .235 / .482$ mark in 90 plate appearances.

## 2021 SEASON

-Garrett was promoted on May 15 to Miami. He made a three-inning relief appearance that night at Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles before being optioned back to Jacksonville the following day. The Marlins have recalled and optioned Garrett several more times throughout the 2021 season.
-Garrett's best major league start came on July 24 against San Diego, a game in which he yielded just two runs on four hits in 7.0 innings with 10 strikeouts against one walk.

## 2020 SEASON

-Garrett made his major league debut for the Marlins in game two of a doubleheader on September 13, 2020 against the Philadelphia Phillies. He ceded just one run on three hits in five innings, striking out six against two walks.
-The southpaw made one additional MLB start one week later, in the backend of a doubleheader against the Washington Nationals. However, Garrett surrendered five runs, four earned, on five hits and three walks in 2.2 frames.
