The Round Rock Express and Albuquerque Isotopes (Colorado Rockies) are set for game five of their six-game series on Saturday night. First pitch is scheduled for 7:35 p.m. CT.

E-TRAIN EVEN THE SERIES

The Express earned a 9-6 win on Friday. In the third, Albuquerque C Daniel Cope hit a solo homer. CF Braiden Ward was hit by a pitch and moved into scoring position with a stolen base. 2B Owen Miller sent him around with a single and the Isotopes took a 2-0 lead. In the fourth, RF Abimelec Ortiz tallied an RBI double and LF Trevor Hauver followed with an RBI single, tying the game at two. The Express later loaded the bases and 2B Alex De Goti delivered with a base hit to give Round Rock a 3-2 edge. Hauver drove in two with a double in the fifth. With two down, C Cooper Johnson hit a single to left sending Hauver home. Albuquerque LF Sean Bouchard made a fielding error on the play that allowed Narvaez to come around and the E-Train held a 7-2 lead. In the sixth, Ortiz hit a triple and Martin scored as the Express led, 8-2. The Isotopes got a run back in the bottom of the sixth on 1B Michael Toglia's solo homer. In the seventh, Ward drove a run in with a base hit and Miller's two-run single cut the Albuquerque deficit to two. The Express added an insurance run in the ninth when Hauver tripled home Ortiz to make it a 9-6 final.

JOSE SET FOR TRIPLE-A

RHP Jose Corniell is slated for his Triple-A debut on Saturday. Corniell missed all of 2024 after undergoing Tommy John ligament replacement surgery. He is listed as the No. 3 (MLB Pipeline) and No. 9 (Baseball America) prospect in the Rangers system. Prior to his promotion, Corniell held a 0.45 ERA (1 ER/20.0 IP) in six starts for Double-A Frisco.

ROUND ROCK RANGERS

OF Dustin Harris woke up in Albuquerque Friday and ended up walking-off the Houston Astros in the 12th inning last night. His pinch-hit double scored INF Cody Freeman. Since Freeman re-joined Texas on August 17, the Rangers are 12-6 and tied with the Yankees for the best record in the American League. On August 17, Texas was 7.5 games back of Houston in the AL West and 5.5 back in the Wild Card. They are now 4.0 back in the AL West and a 0.5 game back in the Wild Card.

HERE COMES HAUVER

LF Trevor Hauver went 3-for-5 with a double, a triple, four RBI, two runs scored and a strikeout. His three hits and four RBI match his season high. He has recorded a hit in 14 of his last 16 games for a .327/.424/.571 slash line since August 20. He is 15 hits from a new single-season high (102 in 2023).

AWESOME IN ALBUQUERQUE

Since the start of 2024, Express starting pitchers are 10-2 with a 4.15 ERA (50 ER/108.1 IP) in 23 games in Albuquerque. The Express are 17-6 at Isotopes Park since the start of 2024 and they own a 4.52 ERA (99 ER/197.1 IP) as an entire staff.

NO FREE PASSES

The Express pitching staff has struck out 32 batters while issuing just five walks against the Isotopes through four games this week. They lead the league with 6.40 K/BB ratio during this stretch.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2025 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's third season with the E-Train. In 2024, Davis secured his 800th win as a manager on July 12 at Reno. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided the E-Train to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 744-665 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.



In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
