TODAY'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Sugar Land Space Cowboys (Houston Astros affiliate) are set for game one of their six-game series at Constellation Field. Last time out, the Express played a doubleheader on Sunday afternoon. The Saturday matchup with El Paso was suspended after two innings due to heavy rain. Before the delay, El Paso plated a run in the first and Round Rock followed with one in the second. When play resumed on Sunday, the Chihuahuas scored a run in the third and followed with three in the fourth, extending their lead to 5-1. The Express scored one in the eighth on a wild pitch but fell, 5-2. In the second game, both clubs were held to a run in the first five frames. SS Cam Cauley led off the sixth with a home run to put the E-Train in front. RF Alejandro Osuna tacked on an RBI single and 2B Justin Foscue recorded a sacrifice fly for a final score of 4-1.

BRIDE'S BALLING

In last week's homestand against El Paso, Round Rock INF Jonah Bride posted league-highs in on-base percentage (.571) and on-base plus slugging (1.321). On Friday, Bride went 4-for-5, with two doubles, a homer, three RBIs and three runs scored, becoming the third Express batter to accomplish the feat since the start of 2024 (D. Harris on 6/4/25 at SL and M. Helman on 6/25/25 vs TAC).

STEPHAN TOES THE SLAB

RHP Josh Stephan is slated to make his team-leading fifth start in Wednesday's series opener. Last time out, Stephan threw a season-low 1.2 innings in his start against El Paso on April 15. Stephan owns a 1-1 record and 6.89 ERA (12 ER/15.2 IP). He has walked just three batters in four starts and struck out a team-high 17.

FOSS IS BOSS

Round Rock INF Justin Foscue has been held hitless in his past two games for the first time this year. Foscue opened the season on a nine-game hitting streak and has a hit in 15 out of 19 games played. Among PCL batters (min. 75 PA), Foscue ranks fifth in strikeout percentage (13.5%) and is tied for fifth in average exit velocity (90.9 MPH).

BULLPEN BULLIES

Despite recording the most innings pitched in the PCL (112.1), the E-Train relievers are holding opponents to a league-low, 11% walk rate with the most strikeouts (124). RHP Peyton Gray leads the Express and ranks third among PCL relievers with a 7.50 K/BB ratio (15 K/2 BB).

SERIES WIN

Round Rock is coming off their first series victory of the season after taking four of six from El Paso. They are 1-3 in series play. Five of the six games last week were decided by three runs or less. Of their eight wins this year, seven have been decided by three runs or less. Seventeen of the 21 games have been decided by three runs or less including nine, one-run games.

ON THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - SUNDAY, APRIL 22, 1973

Nolan Ryan tossed 8.2 innings of two-run baseball while allowing 10 hits and walking four, but earned a no-decision at the Oakland Coliseum. The A's beat the Angels in 10 innings, 3-2, as Ted Kubiak's single won it for Oakland. After throwing complete games in each of his first three starts of 1973, Ryan threw 146 pitches and still made it through an embarrassingly short 8.2 innings.

The reigning World Series champion Athletics were off to a slow start, as the win helped them improve to 5-8. Ryan had an observation after the game, telling reporters, "I don't think Oakland will find it as easy as it was the last couple of years. I think the A's are starting to realize it now. They're missing a tough hitter like Mike Epstein, and Ray Fosse certainly isn't the batting threat that Dave Duncan was." Ryan went on to say that with first base open, he wouldn't hesitate to pitch around Reggie Jackson. On this day, it was Sal Bando who lifted a solo homer in the second off Ryan. A Joe Rudi single in the bottom of the fifth made it 2-0. Bobby Valentine homered for the Angels in the fifth off Catfish Hunter, who finished after 7.2 innings with one earned run allowed. A leadoff homer from Tom McCraw tied it at two in the ninth before Oakland won it in the 10th.

The quote of the day came from Reggie Jackson postgame: "Trying to hit Nolan Ryan is like trying to drink coffee with a fork." Jackson nearly won the game with a grand slam in the ninth when Ron Perranoski entered to face him, but right fielder Lee Stanton robbed him and brought the baseball back.
