JACKSONVILLE WINS FOURTH STRAIGHT

Matthew Etzel's grand slam capped a six-run ninth to ice Jacksonville's wire-to-wire 9-1 victory over Memphis. The Jumbo Shrimp got out to a lead in their first at-bats thanks to a two-run home run from **Graham Pauley**. The Redbirds plated a run in the second on **Matt Koperniak's** RBI single. The game remained deadlocked at 2-1 until the eighth, when **Kemp Alderman** knocked in a run on an RBI single. RBI base knocks from **Deyvison De Los Santos** and Pauley plated the first two runs of the ninth before Etzel's grand slam made it 9-1.

ON THE OFFENSIVE

Heading into play on April 22, Jacksonville had scored at least five runs in a contest just three times in 22 affairs, ranking last in Triple-A in runs (68, 3.1 per game) and each slash line category (.186/.296/.282/.578). The Jumbo Shrimp have now plated at least five runs 14 times in the 19 games since. During this stretch, the club ranks fourth in Triple-A in runs (132, 6.9 per game). They also place in the top 13 in doubles (2nd, 44), hits (5th, 190), average (7th, .279), OBP (12th, 361) and slugging (12th, .443). Jacksonville was hitting just .166 with runners in scoring position over the season's first 22 games; they are 62-for-201 (.308) in those situations over the last 19 contests.

'PEN PALS

The Jumbo Shrimp bullpen surrendered 12 runs in 7.0 innings on May 7 in a 16-1 loss to Charlotte. In the five games since, the club's relief pitching has been nothing short of excellent. During this stretch, Jacksonville relievers have combined to yield only three runs on 14 hits (5.2 H/9) in 24.1 innings for a 1.11 ERA. Jumbo Shrimp relief pitching has combined to strike out 28 (10.4 K/9) against 12 walks (4.4 BB/9) over the last five games. Jacksonville's bullpen has worked 8.0 consecutive scoreless innings heading into play on Thursday.

BERRY BLAST

Jacob Berry struggled significantly over the 2025 season's first 33 games, going just 13-for-103 (.126/.229/.223/.452) at the plate with 35 strikeouts in 119 plate appearances (29.4 percent). The Queens Creek, Ariz., has been truly excellent since that point. Over his last 120 Triple-A games, Berry is batting .308/.397/.450/.847, cutting his strikeout rate by more than half at 14.0 percent with just 68 over 484 plate appearances. Berry ranks tied for 11th in the IL in steals (12), 14th in OBP (.418) and 23rd in average (.309).

GOOD MORNING, GOOD AFTERNOON, GOODNIGHT!

Jacksonville's pitching staff has recorded a whopping 445 strikeouts through 41 games, a rate of 10.9 per game. The Jumbo Shrimp have 42 more punchouts than Norfolk, the team that ranks second in Triple-A. Thus, the Tides' 403 strikeouts are as close to 13th-place Toledo (361) as they are to Jacksonville in first. In addition to the swings and misses, the Jumbo Shrimp have also shown an ability to limit hard contact; their 87.1 average exit velocity against is the second-best such figure in Triple-A.

KEMPIRE STATE OF MIND

Jacksonville outfielder **Kemp Alderman** got off to a slow start to the season. Through his first 11 games, Alderman was just 5-for-35 (.143/.318/.200/.518) with only one triple, one RBI, eight walks, seven runs and 18 strikeouts over 44 plate appearances (40.9 percent strikeout rate). The Decatur, Miss., native has surged since then; Over his last 26 games, Alderman is a scorching 35-for-103 (.340/.393/.583/.876) with four doubles, seven home runs, 18 RBIs, five walks and 20 runs scored. He ranks tied for 12th in the IL in runs (27) and tied for 18th in hits (40).

DEFENSE AGAINST THE DARK ARTS

Jacksonville has yielded the second-fewest runs (176) in Triple-A while posting the level's second-best ERA (4.01). While the club leads all Triple-A staffs in strikeouts (445), the Jumbo Shrimp have also done a phenomenal job at turning batted balls put into play into outs; Jacksonville ranks second in Triple-A by turning 72.5 percent of balls put into play into outs. Only two clubs have recorded a rate of at least 71 percent this season.

SHRIMP BITES

Just four of Jacksonville's last 13 games have been decided by three runs or fewer. Fifteen of the club's previous 17 had been determined by no more than three runs... In his first six career Triple-A starts, **Thomas White** has generated 63 whiffs out of 187 swings (33.7 percent)... The Jumbo Shrimp are trying to equal a season-high five game winning streak.

ABOUT THOMAS

-A native of Rowley, Mass., White burst onto the national scene in middle school. When he was in eighth grade and only 14 years old, his fastball was clocked at 91 miles per hour, leading *Prep Baseball Report* to rank him as the top player nationally in the 2023 class when he was a high school freshman.

-White had committed to Vanderbilt for college, but was selected in the supplemental first round (35th overall) by the Miami Marlins in 2023. He signed with Miami for an over-slot \$4.1 million.

-In *MLB Pipeline's* 2026 prospect rankings, White is ranked as the No. 1 Marlins prospect and No. 17 prospect in all of baseball. He is ranked as the fourth-best pitching prospect behind Nolan McLean of the New York Mets, Bubba Chandler of the Pittsburgh Pirates and Trey Yesavage of the Toronto Blue Jays.

-White won Gatorade Player of the Year in the state of Massachusetts twice while at Phillips Academy Andover (Andover, Mass.) in high school. He went 6-1 with a 0.21 ERA as a junior. As a senior, he was 5-2 with a 1.66 ERA and 95 strikeouts with just 10 hits allowed over 42 innings pitched.

-White has pitched in the Futures Game in both 2024 and 2025.

2025 SEASON

-White began the season with High-A Beloit before earning a promotion to Double-A Pensacola on June 17. He was promoted on September 2 to Triple-A Jacksonville.

-With the Blue Wahoos, White struck out a career-high 14 - the second-most in Pensacola club history, including a run of 13 strikeouts over 14 hitters. According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, a strikeout span of 13 across 14 batters -- in White's case, eight in a row, a single, followed by five more K's -- has never been recorded during the Expansion Era in the major leagues (since at least 1961).

-At all three levels he pitched at, opposing left-handed hitters slashed .145/.283/.184/.467 against White in 90 plate appearances. Right-handed hitters batted .183/.304/.238/.542 against him in 280 plate appearances.

2024 SEASON

-In his first full season, White posted a 2.81 ERA across two Class A levels (Single-A Jupiter and High-A Beloit) and struck out nearly 30% of batters faced. He was named the Midwest League's Top MLB Prospect and earned post-season All-Star honors. He also received the organization's Pitcher of the Year and High-A MVP awards.
