Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Daniel Espino** to the mound tonight, making his first start since last season's penultimate game (9/20/25 vs. Omaha, first game since 2022). Omaha will counter with RHP **Henry Williams**. Columbus is 26-12 (.684, best in the IL) versus right handers this year. Williams has never pitched against Columbus in his career (tonight is sixth career game in Triple-A).

vs. the Storm Chasers

Columbus has lost 45 of the last 70 regular season games against Omaha, dating to 5/5/22. Of those 70G, the Clippers are 7-43 (.140) when they allow at least four runs to Omaha, while going 18-2 (.900) when they hold the Storm Chasers to three or fewer. Individually, **CJ Kayfus** has played 5G against Omaha in his career, hitting .524 (11x21) with 1HR and 6RBI.

Climbing

Entering tonight looking up at only four other teams, the Clippers hold their highest ranking in the standings (5th) since ending the day tied for 4th on 4/8 (6th to 13th in between). Unfortunately, Columbus is still 3.5 games out, having spent the last 34G between 3.0 (three times, last on 5/20) and 6.0 (twice, last on 5/2). The Clippers are 10-3 (3rd in the IL) since getting swept in a DH at St. Paul on 5/15.

Domination

In the last 7G, the Clippers have trailed after only one of 61 innings played (walk-off loss at Toledo on 5/25), while leading after 48 (79%), including 42 of the last 44 (have scored in four straight 1st innings). That has resulted in 6G in which they never trailed, after totaling 6G through the first 49G of the year. Columbus is now 16-9 (.640, 14th) when scoring first and 15-16 (.484, 1st) when allowing the first run.

Too High

Though **Cooper Ingle** has reached in seven of his last 21PA, his OBP dipped to .479 (9th in MiLB among players with at least 100PA). Since going deep in consecutive games at St. Paul on 5/16, Ingle is slashing .292/.397/.625 with 4HR and 14RBI in 12G. He reached 200BB in his career on Friday (17% of PA) and Sunday marked his first ever game played in fair territory (196G at catcher, 66G at DH).

Familiar Foes

Juan Brito will bat second tonight for the 186th game since his debut (9/19/23; +96G and +447PA on 2nd place, Omaha's **Drew Waters**). Only one batter in the IL has more games and PA at a particular spot in that time, Omaha's **John Rave** at leadoff (tonight will be his 195th game; +39G and 180PA on 2nd). Brito is 6x17 (.353) with 4RBI in his last 4G (0x18 with 0RBI previous 5G).

Misleading Streak

Nolan Jones has reached base in 20 straight games, posting a .368OBP since 5/3, but has seen his OBP drop 10 points over the course of the streak, while his average has dipped nine points (.257, 19x74). The streak is tied for 12th longest in the IL this season and ranks as the 7th longest active streak. Jones has not homered since the start of the month vs. Toledo (80AB; 3RBI in last 21G).

Weak Spot

Over the last 11G, in which Columbus is 8-3, the Clippers have a total of 7HR (359AB), the worst 11G stretch of the season. Only 1HR has come from hitters 4-6 in the order (**George Valera** batting fifth on 5/19 vs. Louisville), with two of today's such batters (**Ralph Velazquez** and **Bo Naylor**) having yet to homer with Columbus. **CJ Kayfus** is homerless in his last 81AB with Columbus (7/19/25).

Gaining Steam

George Valera owns a 17G on base streak since 5/5 (.400OBP). Over the first 8G of the streak, Valera had a .250OBP (36PA; hit .182, 6x33 with 3BB and 11K), but he has over reached half the time in the last 9G (.538OBP in 39PA; hitting .357, 10x28 with 11BB and 4K). Valera's K-rate is down considerably this season (16.4% from 26.5% in first four seasons with Columbus), with 3K in his last 34PA.

Back on Track

In the last 18G, the Columbus bullpen has a 2.79ERA (71.0IP, 22ER), 2nd best in the IL (3ER or fewer in all 18G, longest streak of the year). Clipper relievers allowed 21ER in 10.1IP of the 2G prior to the streak, as the relief ERA rose to 6.08 (worst in the IL, currently 13th at 5.11; starters have a 5.45ERA, 15th). Relievers allowed 1HR to 182BF from 5/10-5/22, but have given up 4HR to 126BF since.

This Date in Clipper History

6/2/2018

Adam Plutko fired the 9th no-hitter in franchise history in a 6-0 win at Syracuse (9.0IP, 1BB, 8K). Plutko's bid at perfection was ended with one out in the 8th inning with a walk to **Bengie Gonzalez**, but it marked the third time in his Columbus career that he had started a game by retiring the first 22 batters he had faced (7/26/16 at Norfolk and 4/28/18 vs. Indianapolis).

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,429 to 1,376).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 80-76 (.513) in pitch reviews, with batters going 44-51 (.463) and pitchers/catchers going 36-25 (.590). They have run out of challenges in 31G and have not challenged in 3G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 1-3 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 51-36 when playing past regulation (.586, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 87G to require extra play, 69 have been resolved after one frame (including eight DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to easily top 800 again, with an outside chance to establish a new team high (on pace for 851, would rank as 4th most all-time; 898 scored in 1983).

On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 79 through the first 56G (on pace for 210SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 18CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing for the 3rd most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (48; nabbed 51 times in 2004).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 78 grand slams and 1,933RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.28 through the first 56G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). However, the staff is pacing to give up only 155HR (3rd lowest total since 133HR in 2018; averaging 182 per season since the Year of the Homer in 2019).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 9th in the IL this year (.979), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 30G this season (19-11, .633), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

Good Baseball

Kody Huff bunted a run in, while moving another to scoring position in a 5/24 win vs. Louisville. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 87-23 (.791) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 4-2 mark this season (.667, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses last season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (-17th, .439).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 417-431 (.492), 387-385 with Columbus (.501).
