The Fightin Phils remain home and continue a six-game series against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays. It is the 10th-of-18 matchups between the teams this season and 10th-of-12 games at FirstEnergy Stadium. The Fightin Phils won the first series between the teams 4-2 from May 13-18. Reading heads to New Hampshire from Aug. 5-10. Reading leads the season-series 5-4.

The Fightin Phils snapped a three-game losing skid with a back-and-forth, 9-7 win, over New Hampshire on Thuresday night. It was the first time this season that a game between Reading and New Hampshire was decided by more than a single run. Reading was five-for-15 with runners in scoring position, after starting the week just four-for-32 (.125). Jean Cabrera started for Reading and allowed two runs on two hits over five innings, with five strikeouts. A five-run fifth from Reading catapulted them ahead, which was thanks in large part to a three-run home run from Alex Binelas, his first in a Reading uniform. Despite New Hampshire scoring three in the sixth and one in the seventh to tie it, the R-Phils scored two in hte seventh and one in the eighth to secure their first win of the week. Tommy McCollum picked up his first save with a scoreless ninth. Hendry Mendez, Felix Reyes and Binelas had two hits, while Carson DeMatinin had 3.

Alex Binelas turned in the best game for Reading since signing with the Phillies on May 26. He had two hits, a run, his first Reading home run and a career-high five RBI. His five RBI marked the third time Fightin Phil posted five RBI in a game this season.

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller continues to be a threat on the base paths. After two-more stolen bases on Wednesday night, Miller is alone in first place in the Eastern League with 24 stolen bases, three clear of second place. In the Phillies organization, Miller is second, behind Oscar Mercado, who has 25.

Felix Reyes continued his red-hot start to the week with two hits, a run, double and RBI on Thursday night. So far this week, Reyes is slashing .500/.556/1.250 (1.806 OPS), with four runs, a double, triple, home run and three RBI. With Keaton Anthony's promotion to Triple-A, Reyes not leads all active Fightin Phils hitters in average, sluggin percemtage, OPS and triples.

Trip Trip Triples

The Fightin Phils set a new season-high with two triples in Wednesday night's game. It was the first time Reading hit two triples in a game since Aug. 20, 2024, at Binghamton. Felix Reyes became the first R-Phil with multiple triples this season as he has one in back-to-back games he's played in, after tripleing on Sunday at Harrisburg. Hendry Mendez and Reyes had triples in back-to-back at bats in the sixth inning on Wednesday night.

Robert Moore hit two-more doubles on Wednesday night, giving him two-straight nights with a pair of doubles. It was the third two-double game of the season, with the other instance outside of Tuesday and Wednesday, being May 7 at Binghamton. Moore is the first Fighitn Phil to double in back-to-back games since Johan Rojas did it from Sept. 1-2, of the 2022 season.

Beer, Beer, Beer

Seth Beer has turned it on as of late for the Fightin Phils. Following a stretch in which he went 0-for-27 over seven games (May 23-June 3), Beer has followed that with hits in six-straight games from June 4. Over the last six games, Beer is 8-23, which is good for a .348 average.

Crowe is Cooking

Friday night's starter Wil Crowe has posted the following line over his last three starts: 1-0, 0.00 ERA, 11.0 IP, 2 H, 3 BB, 5 SO.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 13, 2024: At Reading, Philadelphia Phillies outfielder Brandon Marsh makes his first rehab appearance with Reading in front of 8,487 fans on a Thursday night. Marsh goes three-for-five, with a run scored, in Reading's 8-6 win over Portland. Marcus Lee Sang hits a pinch-hit home run, while Robert Moore also goes deep. Otto Kemp, playing in his third Double-A game, launches a three-run home run, his first at the Double-A level.

Here Come the Cats

New Hampshire enters tonight with a 27-32 record, which is fourth in the Northeast Division and 12.5 games out of first place. The Fisher Cats were home against Altoona last week and took five-of-six games, shutting out the Curve in the first four contests. After this week, New Hampshire hosts the Somerset Patriots. New Hampshire's roster has six players on the Blue Jays' top-30 prospects list (MLB Pipeline): Trey Yesavage (2), Charles McAdoo (12), Juaron Watts-Brown (15), Jace Bohrofen (22), Dasan Brown (27) and Peyton Williams (28).

Pitching for the Fisher Cats

Righty Grant Rogers makes the start tonight for New Hampshire. Over 12 starts between Vancouver (A+) and New Hampshire, Rogers is 4-2, with a 2.08 ERA (14 ER, 60.2 IP). Last Saturday against Altoona, Rogers allowed one run over six innings in a win. He split 2024 between Dunedin (A) and Vancouver, going 3-6, with a 3.87 ERA over 21 appearances. Toronto selected Rogers in the 11th round of the 2023 draft out of McNese State.

Crowe remained red-hot with five-shutout innings in his last start at Harrisburg. He set a season-high in innings pitched and earned his first win with Reading. Crowe faced just one-above the minimum against Harrisburg, with the one hit being a double in the second inning, but that runner was left stranded. Crowe was relieved by Andrew Schultz in the bottom of the sixth.
