2.25 The Captains rank 2nd in the Midwest League with a 2.25 ERA during the month of August. Lake County pitchers have permitted just 20 ER in 9 games so far this month.

6 LHP Matt Wilkinson, tonight's Captains starter, pitched 6 scoreless innings in his lone career start against Peoria back on Sept. 4, 2024. The southpaw allowed just 3 H and 1 BB, while throwing 5 K in an eventual 2-1 Lake County road win.

.333 1B/3B Maick Collado owns a .333 AVG (9-for-27) during his current 7-game hitting streak. The Santiago, DR native is also currently on a 12-game on-base streak, during which he is batting .310 (13-for-42).

WELCOME HOME, CAPTAINS: On Tuesday night, the Captains will begin a 12-game homestand after going 8-4 during a 12-game road trip against the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (won series 4-2) and Dayton Dragons (won series 4-2). As a team, Lake County batted .240 with 100 H, 22 2B, 8 HR, and 47 RBI, outscored its opponents 52-34 during this span. On the mound, Captains pitchers logged a 2.36 ERA and 94 K in 106.2 IP during the team's 12-game road trip.

JAISON'S JOYFUL ROAD TRIP: OF Jaison Chourio, MLB Pipeline's No. 6 Guardians prospect, led the Captains with a .347 AVG and 17 H during the team's 12-game road trip. The 20-year-old played in 11 of Lake County's 12 games, tallying 2 2B and 7 RBI.

DEFEND THE 'SHIP: This season, the Captains are looking to win back-to-back Midwest League Championships. Lake County aims to record the 7th instance of a franchise winning consecutive MWL titles.

TRENDS & NOTABLES

SANTOS STANDS ALONE: On Jan. 30, it was announced that Manager Omir Santos would return for his 3rd season as Lake County's skipper. He is now the longest-tenured manager in Captains history, and 1 of just 2 to win a championship for Lake County (Ted Kubiak, 2010). With his 17th win with the Captains on June 8 at West Michigan, Santos is now the winningest manager in history. He surpassed 2003 South Atlantic League Manager of the Year and former longtime Toronto Blue Jays First Base Coach Luis Rivera (2003-04; father of current Lake County Bench Coach Yan Rivera) for the most wins by a manager in Captains history.

A REUNION 13 YEARS IN THE MAKING: On Tuesday, July 8, RHP Tyler Naquin was promoted to Lake County from the ACL Guardians. Naquin, 34, converted to pitcher after an 8-year MLB career as an outfielder from 2016-23. After not playing in 2024, he signed with the Cleveland Guardians as a Minor League free agent on March 6, 2025. In his 1st pro stint as a pitcher, Naquin made 13 relief appearances for the ACL Guardians this year, going 2-0 with a 5.14 ERA, 8 K to 11 BB, and a .170 opposing AVG in 14.0 IP. Cleveland originally drafted Naquin with the 15th overall pick in the 2012 MLB Draft out of Texas A&M. Soon after, he played for the Captains during the 2012 Midwest League Playoffs, batting .353 with 6 H, 5 R, 2 2B, 1 RBI, and a .961 OPS in 5 games. Naquin has made 8 relief appearances for Lake County this year, logging a 3.60 ERA and a .121 opposing AVG in 10.0 IP.

FOUR CAPTAINS SAIL TO AKRON: On Monday, Aug. 11, the Cleveland Guardians Player Development System promoted 4 Captains players to the Double-A Akron RubberDucks: 1B/LF Ralph Velazquez, MLB Pipeline's No. 10 Guardians prospect, C Jacob Cozart, MLB Pipeline's No. 18 Guardians prospect, INF Christian Knapczyk, and RHP Jack Jasiak. At the time of their promotions, Velazquez led the MWL in HR (17) and TB (174), Cozart led the MWL in RBI (16) and 2B (7, tied) on Sundays, Knapczyk ranked T-9th in the MWL with 96 H, and Jasiak ranked 2nd in the MWL with 13 saves.

SIX HILLCATS ARRIVE IN LAKE COUNTY: On Monday, Aug. 11, the Cleveland Guardians Player Development System promoted 6 players to the Captains from the Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats: C Bennett Thompson, INF Garrett Howe, INF Jeffrey Mercedes, LHP Rafe Schlesinger, LHP Luis Flores, and RHP Conner Whittaker. At the time of their promotions, Thompson ranked 8th in the Carolina League in AVG (.269), Schlesinger ranked T-5th in the CL in K (88), and both Flores and Whittaker ranked T-7th in the CL in saves (5).

DEVERS DELIVERS EXTRA BASES: INF Jose Devers has been one of the premier extra-base hitters in MiLB this season, leading High-A in 2B (30) and XBH (44, tied) this year. The Samaná, DR native is 1 of just 2 MiLB players with 40+ XBH, 30+ 2B, and 12+ SB this season (also Triple-A El Paso (SD) OF Yonathan Peraza). Devers is just 6 2B away from breaking the Lake County single-season franchise record of 35 2B, which was set by both INF Kevin Kouzmanoff (2004) and C Matt McBride (2007).

HARTLE'S HEROIC CAMPAIGN: LHP Josh Hartle, MLB Pipeline's No. 25 Guardians prospect, has been one of the Midwest League's premier pitchers this year. The southpaw leads the MWL in wins (9), WHIP (1.08), win percentage (.818), and games started (21, tied), while ranking top-5 in ERA (2.50, 2nd), opposing AVG (.202, 2nd), K (96, 3rd), and IP (97.1, 4th).

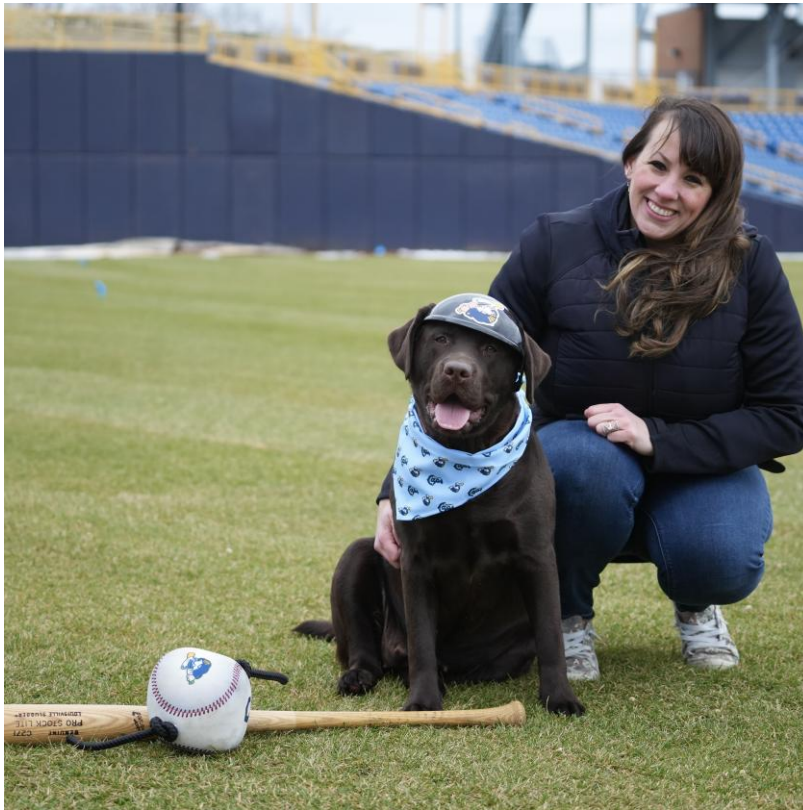

BIO

Mokoro (wears #43) enters her first season as Lake County's Bat Dog, and first season with the Guardians organization. The 1-year-old Chocolate Labrador Retriever is owned and trained by **Victoria Brody**. **Brody** is a professional dog trainer who started Mission Empawthy (pronounced "EMPATHY"), LLC, a local dog training company which focuses on specializing in psychiatric service dogs for those whose disabilities aren't always visible. **Mokoro will retrieve bats and balls for the Captains alongside Brody at all Thursday home games and select additional games this season!**

Mokoro is named after a type of dugout canoe found in Botswana. These vessels, which usually carry 1-2 passengers, are commonly used to navigate the Okavango Delta for both transport and game viewing safaris. While mekoro (plural form of "mokoro") used to primarily be made from Jackalberry, Mangosteen, and Sausage trees, they are now mainly made from fiberglass.

LAST TIME OUT: LHP Matt Wilkinson (ND) did not record a decision in an eventual 7-1 Captains road defeat to the Dayton Dragons back on Wednesday, Aug. 6. The southpaw pitched 5.1 innings, allowing just 1 run on 3 hits, while throwing 3 strikeouts to 2 walks in 84 pitches (49 strikes). Wilkinson's lone run allowed was courtesy of a bequeathed runner scoring on an RBI double permitted by former Captains RHP Robert Wegielnik in the bottom of the 6th inning.

TOP 30 PROSPECT: Wilkinson is currently the No. 26 Guardians prospect according to Baseball America. *Baseball America on Wilkinson:* "He's a functional mover on the mound despite his size and creates plenty of deception thanks to a low release height and crossfire landing. Wilkinson has a three-pitch mix that is uninspiring in a vacuum but effective in practice."

A HISTORIC 2024 CAMPAIGN: Across Lake County and Single-A Lynchburg, Wilkinson led qualified Minor League pitchers with 13.20 strikeouts per 9 innings and a 37.6% strikeout rate. He also ranked 2nd in MiLB in: strikeouts (174), ERA (1.90), opposing AVG (.169), and WHIP (0.91). *Wilkinson became the only MiLB pitcher with a 0.95-or-lower WHIP, 1.90-or-lower ERA, and at least 170 strikeouts in a season since at least 2005.*

2024 HONORS: Wilkinson was named to the 2024 All-MiLB Prospect Second Team and Baseball America Second Team Minor League All-Star Team. He was also named a 2024 Midwest League All-Star, as well as MLB Pipeline's 2024 Cleveland Guardians Pitching Prospect of the Year and the Canadian Baseball Network's 2024 Wayne Norton Award winner (Top Canadian Minor League Pitcher - Affiliated). From his High-A debut on May 25 through the end of the regular season, Wilkinson led High-A in ERA (2.30) and opposing AVG (.174), while leading the Midwest League in strikeouts (103). He also finished 2nd in both the Midwest League and High-A in WHIP (0.98) during this span, going 5-5 in 16 regular season starts for Lake County.

PLAYOFF HEROICS: Wilkinson made 2 starts for the Captains during the 2024 Midwest League Playoffs. The left-hander was the only pitcher to log double-digit innings (12.1) during the 2024 MWL Playoffs, while also leading in win percentage (1.000, 1-0), wins (1, tied), and games started (2, tied). Wilkinson saved one of the best performances of his career for last with Lake County's season on the line in Game 2 of the 2024 MWL Championship Series vs. Wisconsin. *The southpaw recorded the longest start of his professional career, pitching a career-high 6.2 innings in his first career postseason quality start.* He allowed just two earned runs, and two walks, while throwing five strikeouts in a career-high 96 pitches (career-high 60 strikes). *Wilkinson ultimately helped force a decisive Game 3, which Lake County eventually won the following night to clinch the 2024 Midwest League Championship.*

ALL ABOARD THE "TUGBOAT": Wilkinson has held the nickname "Tugboat" from a young age. His father's best friend growing up, Phil McNeil, gave Matt the nickname, "after seeing Wilkinson run around the bases at a pace he thought was similar to that of the boat designed to tow larger vessels." MLB.com's Rob Terranova wrote, *"I love it, I love being called Tugboat," Wilkinson said to Terranova. "But I don't want people to forget that I'm Matt Wilkinson, too."*

THE INVISI-BALL: When Wilkinson trained at the Okotoks Dawgs Academy in Canada early in his career, a place where he still trains during the offseason, one of his coaches, Joe Sergeant, took note of the left-hander's unique delivery, particularly for his fastball. *"He's just got a certain run and life on his fastball that you don't see in regular pitchers. There's just another gear that comes out of his hand," Sergeant told Ian Wilson of AlbertaDugoutStories.com. "It's just the way the ball comes out of his hand – we call it the 'invisi-ball.'"*

PROMOTED TO THE CAPTAINS: Wilkinson was promoted to the Captains from Single-A Lynchburg on May 21, 2024. *The portside led MiLB with a 1.12 ERA and 71 K at the time of his promotion in 8 starts for the Hillcats, while ranking 2nd with a 0.77 WHIP and 7th with a .159 opposing AVG.*

A START FOR THE AGES: On April 25, 2024, Wilkinson made Minor League Baseball history in his start against the Myrtle Beach Pelicans (Single-A, CHC). The left-hander pitched 6 scoreless, hitless innings, allowing just 1 walk and throwing 15 strikeouts in 82 pitches (56 strikes). According to MiLB.com's Jesús Cano, *Wilkinson became the 5th MiLB pitcher since 2005 to record at least 15 strikeouts without allowing a hit.* The MiLB pitchers to do this are Hall-of-Famer Warren Spahn (1960), 1971 NL All-Star Don Wilson (1967), Hall-of-Famer Nolan Ryan (3 times), 3-time NL Cy Young Award winner Clayton Kershaw (2014, whom Wilkinson said was his favorite player at the 2015 Little League World Series), and 3-time Cy Young Award winner Max Scherzer (2015).

PITCHER OF THE MONTH: Wilkinson was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Month for the month of April 2024 as a member of the Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats. *In 4 starts, he went 2-0 with a 0.44 ERA, a Minor League-best 41 strikeouts, and a Minor League-best .091 opposing AVG.* Wilkinson also allowed just 6 hits and 6 walks in 20.2 innings of work.

VALIANT VAQUERO: After initially committing to the University of Washington, Wilkinson pitched collegiately at Central Arizona College (JUCO), where he was the 2023 NJCAA Division I Pitcher of the Year, a 2023 NJCAA 1st Team All-American, the 2023 ABCA/Rawlings Pitcher of the Year, and the Arizona Community College Athletic Association Pitcher of the Year. In 2023, he went 10-2 with a 1.07 ERA, 136 strikeouts, a 0.73 WHIP, and 2 complete games in 16 appearances (14 starts), and won the NJCAA Division I Baseball World Series in 2022. Following his 2023 campaign, Wilkinson eventually chose to forgo his commitment to Arizona State after being selected by the Guardians in the 10th round of the 2023 MLB Draft.

LITTLE LEAGUE LEGEND: When he was 12 years old, Wilkinson had a remarkable performance at the 2015 Little League World Series as a member of Team Canada. *On Aug. 21, 2015, in his only start of the tournament, he pitched 5 scoreless innings against Team Mexico, allowing just 2 hits and throwing 16 strikeouts in a 1-0 defeat.* (The LLWS) was definitely a cool experience, it was like a dream come true," Wilkinson told The Daily Sentinel's James Burky. "It felt like more than a game for the first couple of weeks. Leading up to the tournament, you had to do ESPN interviews, all of those walkup things. I loved it because it was something that I wanted to do since I was eight."

MORE ON WILKINSON: Wilkinson grew up in Ladner, British Columbia, the same hometown as former longtime MLB LHP James Paxton. He has 2 Australian Kelpie dogs, Reggie and Mookie, who are named after Baseball Hall-of-Famer Reggie Jackson and 8-time MLB All-Star Mookie Betts.

LAST TIME OUT: LHP Rafe Schlesinger (W, 4-6) earned his 4th win of the season in an eventual 6-3 Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats road win over the Carolina Mudcats (Single-A, MIL) back on Tuesday, Aug. 5. The southpaw pitched 5 innings, allowing just 1 run on 3 hits, while throwing 6 strikeouts to just 2 walks in 70 pitches (47 strikes). **Schlesinger's** lone run allowed was courtesy of a 2-out RBI double in the bottom of the 2nd inning.

SCHLESINGER'S SINGLE-A SUCCESS: Schlesinger was promoted to Lake County from Single-A Lynchburg on Aug. 11. In his 1st full pro season, the left-hander made 20 appearances (16 starts) for the Hillcats this year, going 4-6 with a 3.33 ERA and 88 K to 34 BB in 83.2 IP. At the time of his promotion, **Schlesinger** ranked T-5th in the Carolina League with 88 K and 11th with 83.2 IP. **Also, the southpaw's 2 HR allowed were tied for the 3rd-fewest among Single-A pitchers with 80+ IP this year.**

A JOYOUS JUNE: During the month of June, Schlesinger recorded a 0.77 ERA in 5 appearances (4 starts). The southpaw allowed just 4 runs (2 earned) in 23.1 IP, throwing 21 K to 9 BB and holding opposing hitters to a .200 AVG.

RAFE THE HURRICANE: Schlesinger pitched for 3 seasons at the University of Miami (FL). The left-hander went 9-6 with a 5.01 ERA and 115 K to 52 BB in 118.2 IP. **One of the best performances of his career was in the 2023 Coral Gables Regional vs. Texas, when he pitched a career-high 7 innings (since tied) of scoreless long relief and threw a career-high 9 strikeouts (since tied) to no walks in a 4-1 defeat.** After making 43 relief appearances for the Hurricanes during his first 2 years, Schlesinger became a full-time starter as a junior in 2024, making 15 starts (5 quality starts) for Miami. **He was also teammates with 2024 Captain and current Cleveland Guardians 1B/OF C.J. Kayfus during the 2022 and 2023 seasons.**

INSPIRING OTHERS: Schlesinger was diagnosed with a tic disorder when he was in 2nd grade. According to [Cleveland Clinic](#), "Tics are quick, repetitive movements or sounds that your body makes involuntarily... If your child has more severe or frequent tics, they may have a neurological condition that causes them to perform tics, called a tic disorder." **Despite this adversity, Schlesinger is using his baseball career to be an inspiration to others.** "Whatever platform you're at, you can use. I've already had a few kids reach out and tell me how my story has inspired them," **he told Josh White of MiamiHurricanes.com.** "The way I look at it is I'm blessed enough to have a gift of a left arm that works pretty well on the baseball diamond," Schlesinger also said. "In return, I have to have something that's not so great. You have to look at the positive about it and not ask, why me."

IT'S NAH OR NEVA: Off the field, Schlesinger is the CEO of [Nah Neva Apparel](#), a clothing brand established in 2024.

CAPTAINS TO THE MAINLAND

3 former Lake County Captains have made their MLB debut during the 2025 season.

1B/LF C.J. Kayfus: On Saturday, August 2, **1B/LF C.J. Kayfus** was promoted to the Cleveland Guardians, making his MLB debut on the same day in a home game versus the Minnesota Twins. The 2023 3rd-round pick out of Miami (FL) batted 8th and started in RF for Cleveland, going 0-for-4 with an RBI groundout in his 1st career MLB at-bat in a 5-4 Guardians win. **Kayfus played 40 games for the Captains in 2024, leading the Midwest League in OPS (1.015), SLG (.578), and AVG (.338, tied) during his Lake County tenure.** The left-handed hitter also ranked top-5 in the Midwest League in OBP (.437), TB (89, 4th), RBI (37, 5th), and XBH (21, T-5th), while hitting 7 HR.

RHP Nic Enright: On Saturday, May 24, **RHP Nic Enright** was promoted to the Cleveland Guardians. He made his MLB debut on Sunday, May 25 at Comerica Park against the Detroit Tigers, **just under 2 ½ years after being diagnosed with Hodgkin's Lymphoma.** The right-hander pitched 2 scoreless innings, allowing 2 hits and throwing 3 strikeouts on 36 pitches (25 strikes), as Cleveland lost 5-0. **Enright** made 11 appearances for the Captains in 2021, going 1-0 with a 1.47 ERA, a 32/3 K/BB ratio, a .179 opposing AVG, and a 0.82 WHIP in 18.1 IP. **During his tenure with Lake County (May 7-June 24, 2021), the right-hander ranked top-five among Midwest League pitchers (min. 18 IP) in fewest runs allowed (3, T-1st), fewest HR allowed (0, T-1st), fewest earned runs allowed (3, T-3rd), saves (3, T-3rd), fewest walks (3, T-3rd), WHIP (4th), ERA (5th), and K/BB ratio (10.67, 5th).**

LHP Doug Nikhazy: On Saturday, April 26, **LHP Doug Nikhazy** was promoted to the Cleveland Guardians as the 27th man for a home doubleheader versus the Boston Red Sox. The left-hander started Game 2 of the twin bill, suffering the loss in a 7-3 defeat. He pitched 3 innings, allowing 5 hits, 6 earned runs, and 6 walks, while throwing 3 strikeouts. **Nikhazy** made 21 starts for the Captains in 2022, going 4-4 with a 3.19 ERA, 118 K, and a .182 opposing AVG in 93.0 IP. **His 118 K were tied for the Lake County lead, while his 93.0 IP and 21 GS (tied) ranked 2nd on the team.**
