HOMER HAPPY SHUCKERS

The Shuckers enter today with 15 home runs, the 2nd-most in the Southern League and tied for the 3rd-most in Double-A... The 15 home runs are the most through 11 games in franchise history (since 2015) and tied for the 6th-most in the Southern League in the Digital Stats Era (since 2005).

☞ The Shuckers have recorded a home run in 8 of 11 games to begin the season and have hit at least one in 4 of 5 road games.

WALKING ON SUNSHINE

The Shuckers enter today with 88 walks through 11 games, the most in Double-A... The Shuckers set a season-high on Wednesday with 13, the most in a game since May 6, 2021, at Birmingham, when they set the single-game franchise record with 16... Opponents are averaging 172.3 pitches per game against the Shuckers, the highest mark in Double-A.

☞ The Shuckers 88 walks mark the most by a Southern League team through 11 games since 2005... The next closest Southern League team is the 2018 Knoxville Smokies, with 68.

SPEED? I AM SPEED

The Shuckers enter today with 35 stolen bases, tied for the most in the Double-A and tied for the 6th-most in Minor League Baseball... The Shuckers recorded 24 stolen bases in 6 games during last week's series, the 3rd-most in Minor League Baseball.

☞ On Tuesday, the Shuckers recorded at least 6 stolen bases for the 4th time this season... It marked the 15th game in franchise history (since 2015) with at least 6 stolen bases.

EDUARDO GARCIA IS BACK!

With a multi-hit performance on Wednesday, INF/OF EDUARDO GARCIA is 5-for-15 with a double and 3 walks since his return to the lineup... This winter, Garcia held a .324/.395/.581 slash line with a .976 OPS and 6 home runs with Cardenales de Lara in Venezuela.

BEST OF THE BEST

1B BLAKE BURKE was named the No. 10 first base prospect by *MLB Pipeline* on Monday, and was also named to the *MLB Pipeline* Prospect Team of the Week.

☞ Entering today, Burke has reached base in all 11 games to begin the season... Burke has recorded a hit in 8 games and a walk in 6.

☞ Last Thursday, Burke became the 1st Double-A player in the Digital Stats Era to record 6 home runs in a team's first 6 games.

SAVE TONIGHT

RHP **SAM GARCIA** earned his 2nd save of the season on Tuesday with a perfect 9th inning... Prior to 2026, Garcia recorded 2 career saves between his college and pro career, coming on May 8, 2025, at Kannapolis with Single-A Carolina and March 4, 2022, at the College of Charleston with High Point University.

RUNS? WHAT ARE THOSE?

RHP **TANNER GILLIS** tied his career-high with 5.0 shutout innings in relief on Friday... Gillis retired 14 consecutive batters to begin the outing and 15 of 16 batters faced.

☞ Gillis has recorded 7.1 consecutive scoreless innings dating back to April 4, 2026, the longest streak by a Shucker pitcher this season.

CALLING THE KIDS!

Baseball America released the list of the youngest players by level on April 8, including **SS/2B JESUS MADE** and **RHP MANUEL RODRIGUEZ** as 2 of the 3 youngest players in the Southern League.

☞ 7 of the 25 youngest Southern League players are on the Shuckers roster, including Made and Rodriguez.

☞ The median age of the league is 25.0 y/o... 21 of the 26 players on the active roster are under 25 y/o.

PROSPECT-PALOOZA

The Shuckers have 4 Top 30 prospects on their roster, including 2 Top-100 prospects and 2 Top-10 prospects.

☞ The 4 are: **SS/2B JESUS MADE** (No. 1, No. 3 overall), **RHP BISHOP LETSON** (No. 7, No. 96 overall), **RHP TYSON HARDIN** (No. 13) and **1B BLAKE BURKE** (No. 18).

MADE FOR THE BIG STAGE

SS/2B JESUS MADE enters the 2026 season as the top-ranked Brewers prospect and the 4th-ranked overall prospect by *Baseball America*.

☞ Made will become baseball's top prospect once Konnor Griffin (37 AB), Kevin McGonigle (64 AB) and JJ Wetherholt (66 AB) all reach 130 AB.

BACK IN THE SADDLE

MANAGER MIKE GUERRERO returns to the Shuckers dugout for 2026 after 2 seasons as a Roving Infield Instructor with the Brewers organization.

☞ After reaching 1,400 career wins during the 2023 season, Guerrero needs 49 wins to reach 1,500... His 1,451 wins are the sixth-most among active managers in Minor League Baseball.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

RHP **BISHOP LETSON** (0-2, 20.25) makes his 3rd start of the season and the 4th of his Double-A career... Today marks his first career appearance against the Clingstones and 2nd against an affiliate of the Atlanta Braves... Against Single-A Augusta on April 18, 2024, Letson allowed 1 unearned run over 3.0 hitless innings.
