CORPUS CHRISTI HOOKS (22-44) vs. SPRINGFIELD CARDINALS (41-26)

RHP JOEY MANCINI (0-7, 4.65 ERA) vs. RHP MAX RAJCIC (2-3, 4.25 ERA)

SETTING THE SCENE: The Cards and Hooks (HOU) continue the series with the 5th of 6 games and the 11th game of a season-long 12-game homestand ... are 3-1 in series and 9-1 on the homestand ... tonight 2,000 fans receive a vintage Cardinals shirt presented by Coca-Cola.

HISTORY AT HAMMONS: Springfield threw its first-ever 9-inning no-hitter in a 1-0 win over CC on Friday night ... RHP Tink Hence (4.1), RHP Zane Mills (2.2), RHP Austin Love (1.0), and RHP Sean Harney (1.0) combined on the feat with 4 total walks and 13 strikeouts.

A NO-NO ANNIVERSARY: The Cardinals no-hitter on Friday night came on the 1-year anniversary of the club's 7-inning no-hitter on June 20, 2024, the only other no-hitter in franchise history ... it took place against the Hooks in Corpus Christi with LHP Cooper Hjerpe and RHP Andrew Marrero on the mound.

THE KINGS IN THE NORTH: Springfield clinched the 1st Half North Division title with its win Thursday vs. CC ... is the franchise's 5th 1st-Half title all-time (2007, 2009, 2016, 2024), first back-to-back 1st-Half titles in team history, and 3rd-straight postseason appearance ... will host Game 2 (and 3 if necessary) of North Division Series on Sept. 18/19 at Hammons Field.

A RECORD RECORD: At 41-26, the Cardinals own the best record in the Texas League and have matched the most 1st-Half wins in franchise history with 2 games remaining in the half ... previous best record was 41-29 in 2016.

RAJCIC CARPET RIDE: RHP Max Rajcic makes his 13th start of the season and 1st vs. CC ... last start was cut short after just 2.0 IP when last Saturday's game was suspended by rain ... was coming off back-to-back quality starts at Frisco where he allowed just 2 ER on 6 hits in 11.2 IP.

HENCEFORTH: RHP Tink Hence made his season-debut for Springfield with 4.1 no-hit IP on Friday to begin the no-hitter ... was the 2024 Texas League Pitcher of Year with Cardinals after going 4-3 with a 2.71 ERA in 20 starts ... rehabbing from a rib injury during Spring Training.

HOW THE TURN TABLES: Springfield is 29-10 in its last 39 games since falling to 5th place in the North Division with a season-worst record of 12-16 on May 7 ... is 15-2 in June with 21 HR and a 2.90 team ERA for the month.

BYE BYE BAEZ: OF Joshua Baez recorded his 2nd multi-HR game in the TXL on Friday night ... has 6 HR and 20 RBI in 18 games ... has 3 HR and 8 RBI through first 3 games of series vs. CC.

BAITING THE HOOKS: Tonight's game is the 4th of 12 in the season series with CC and 4th of 6 at Hammons Field ... club's will match up in Texas for a 6-game series, July 8-13.

TUNE IN: Tonight's game can be heard on the radio home for Cardinals baseball, Classic Rock 106.7 FM, with video feed available on Bally Sports Live & MiLB.TV ... Jason Schwartz provides the play-by-play ... local TV broadcast on KY3 with Ned Reynolds and Scott Bailes.

- Enters 2025 as the Cardinals #23-ranked prospect by MLB Pipeline and #25 by Baseball America ... ranked #12 by Baseball America before 2024 season
- Spent entire 2024 season in Springfield rotation ... went 10-11 with a 4.33 ERA over 131.0 innings (25G/24GS) ... set career-highs in wins, starts, innings and strikeouts (131)
- Ranked 2nd in Texas League in wins, 3rd in strikeouts, and 4th in innings ... led Springfield in wins, strikeouts, starts and innings
- Struck out a career-high 9 batters three times, including his longest career start of 8.0 innings on July 4 vs. NW Arkansas ... held opponents to 2-or-fewer runs in 7 of last 8 starts
- Started Game 2 of Division Series vs. Arkansas (4.1IP, 4R, 5SO)
- In 2023 was named Cardinals MiLB Pitcher of the Year after going 9-6 with a 2.48 ERA in 23 starts between Palm Beach and Peoria ... joined Rick Ankle (1998) and Anthony Reyes (2004) as only Cardinals minor league pitchers to win the honor in first professional season
