- **TODAY'S GAME:** The Jackets survived 5 errors and took advantage of 12 Woodpecker walks to walk off Fayetteville 6-5 on Isaiah Drake's 2-out single in the 9th. Didier Fuentes will look to keep the momentum going and bring Augusta back to .500 in the 2nd half.
- **PLEASE SEND PITCHING:** The GreenJackets have seen a handful of moves that have shortened the bullpen over recent weeks. Most recently, relievers Beau Philip and Isaac Gallegos were promoted to High-A Rome. The corresponding move saw JR Ritchie return from Tommy John recovery and join the rotation, albeit still not built up to full strength.
- **SHORT & SWEET:** The GreenJackets are now 3-0 in games shortened by rain, all of which have come at SRP Park. Augusta has seen a high level of rainfall this season, and it has benefited the home side more often than not.
- **LEFT FOR DEAD:** The GreenJacket offense has struggled intensely against left handed pitching all season long, hobbling to a .148 average against southpaws. The last 8 games started by a lefty have all been losses for Augusta, who greatly enjoyed a week against the Fireflies who do not have an LHP on the roster.
- **ERROR, PAGE NOT FOUND:** The GreenJacket defense has been light years ahead of its early struggles, moving from most errors in all of MiLB in May to out of the Carolina League's bottom 3. The defense took a step back last night with 5 errors, but snared the win anyways in an ugly contest.
- **LOW POWER MODE:** The GreenJackets have struggled with the long ball often this season, but have seen the power numbers rise at home of late. 18 of the team's 30 long balls (counting Noah Williams' grand slam from Sunday's suspended game) have come at SRP Park, including 7 in the last 10 home games.
- **NEXT TIME OUT:** Kadon Morton continues his search for his first win on the mound, bouncing back after a solid but losing performance last week against Columbia. He will face off against Alain Pena, who has bounced between the rotation and bullpen.

WYNSTON SAWYER

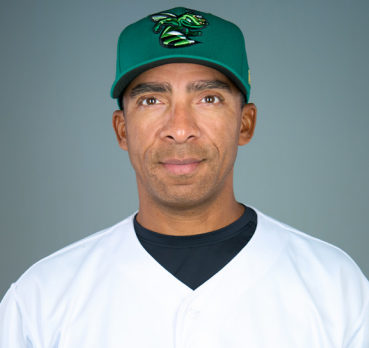
MANAGER

He got his start coaching in the Orioles system for nearly a decade, working for the Delmarva Shorebirds and managing the Rookie-level Bluefield Orioles before working for the major league club as an assistant hitting coach for 6 seasons.
