## Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (18-17) vs. Norfolk Tides (27-9)

#### SIX-RUN THIRD PROPELS NORFOLK TO 8-4 WIN

A six-run third inning sunk the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp in the Norfolk Tides' 8-4 victory on Friday night. Down 2-0, the Norfolk (27-9) offense exploded in the third inning. With six runs in the top of the third, the Tides never looked back. The Jubmo Shrimp cut the deficit to 6-4 when **Jacob Amaya** (3) blasted a two-run home run to give him four RBIs on the day. Norfolk added their final two runs in the top of the sixth inning when **Lewin Diaz** doubled, increasing the Tides lead to 8-4.

#### DOCTOR, DOCTOR GIVE ME THE NEWS

Jacksonville starting pitching seemed to find their footing over their previous 20 games. From April 13-May 5, Jacksonville starters yielded 42 runs, 35 earned on 90 hits (8.2 H/9) in 98.2 innings for a 3.19 ERA. Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have struggled in the six games since. They've allowed 26 runs, 25 earned on 31 hits (13.5 H/9) in 20.2 innings for a 10.89 ERA with 14 walks (6.1 BB/9) and 17 strikeouts (7.4 K/9).

#### WALKING ON SUNSHINE

Over the season's first eight games, Jacksonville mustered only 25 walks, the second-fewest such total in the International League. However, the Jumbo Shrimp have shown a significant amount of patience of late; Jacksonville has registered 139 free passes over the last 27 games since April 11, a figure that ranks fouorth in the International League. During this stretch, the club has walked in 13.1 percent of their plate appearances. The Jumbo Shrimp walked in just 7.6 percent of plate appearances in their first eight games. Jacksonville's 11 walks on April 30 were their most in a game since tallying 12 against Birmingham on 6/15/19. The last time the club tallied 11 walks at home was 8/6/15 vs. Pensacola.

#### **"DOUBLE AA" BAT-TERY**

Despite starting off slow (2-for-47) in his first 12 games, **Austin "Double AA" Allen** has recharged since Jacksonville traveled to Memphis. The St. Louis native is 12-for-35 (.343) in his last 11 games with two doubles, three home runs and seven RBIs. His OPS has jumped from .342 to 1.096 during this span. Since April 25, Allen ranks leads Jacksonville in OPS (1.096), home runs (3) and slugging (.657). Last year, Jacksonville struggled against their International League East foes, going 39-45. However, against Norfolk, Jacksonville went 11-10, winning the Navy Town Showdown. Although the Jumbo Shrimp slashed .250/.327/.403/.730 with 21 home runs and 93 RBIs, the pitching staff struggled. The Jumbo Shrimp hurlers compiled a 5.03 ERA, which was the third-worst ERA among 2022 opponents. Norfolk hit .233 against Jacksonville pitchers, plating 102 ER in 182.1 innings. The Tides' 21 home runs against Jumbo Shrimp

pitchers was the third-most hit against the pitching staff out

of the 10 teams Jacksonville faced in 2022.

#### KING CHARLES

WAVE RUNNERS

Over an eight-game stretch from April 14-27, **Charles Leblanc** went just 1-for-26 (.038) at the plate. The native of Laval in Canada has been absurdly hot at the plate since. Over the last 13 games dating back to April 28, Leblanc is a scorching 14-for-41 (.341) with two doubles, one home run, five RBIs and a remarkable 15 walks for a. 518 on-base percentage. On the campaign, the 26-year-old has walked (27) nearly as much he has struck out (28). Leblanc ranks second in the International League in walk percentage (22.0 percent) and tied for fifth in total walks (27). His swingingstrike rate of 7.4 percent ranks 19th-lowest out of the circuit's 133 qualified hitters.

#### 'PEN PALS

The Jacksonville bullpen struggled mightily during a seven-game stretch from April 14-26. Over that timeframe, Jumbo Shrimp relievers collectively surrendered 27 runs, 26 earned, on 38 hits (11.7 H/9) in 29.1 innings for a 7.98 ERA. However, in the 14 games since, Jacksonville relievers have combined to cede 21 runs, 15 earned, on 29 hits (3.8 H/9) in 69.1 innings for a 1.94 ERA. The Shrimp bullpen has combined for 74 strikeouts (9.6 K/9) against 44 walks (5.7 BB/9) during this recent run.

#### SHRIMP BITES

In Friday's game, Jacksonville pitchers issued eight walks, and hit two batters... The Jumbo Shrimp have at least five opposing hitters in five of the last six games. As a staff, Jacksonville pitchers have walked 165 batters, sixth-most in the IL.

#### **ABOUT GEORGE**

-Signed in 2015 as a non-drafted free agent for just \$55,000, Soriano has risen to become the No. 27 prospect in the Marlins' organization according to MLB.com

-Due to an injury that caused him to miss the 2017 season and the canceled 2020 minor league season because of the COVID-19 pandemic, Soriano had totaled just 307.0 innings in six years in the Marlins' organization entering the 2022 season. It took him four seasons to finally reach full season pro ball in 2019 with Low-A Clinton.

#### 2023 SEASON

-Made his major league debut with the Marlins on April 16, 2023 against the Arizona Diamondbacks.

-Pitched three scoreless frames, allowing just one hit and notching two strikeouts on 25 pitches thrown.

#### **2022 SEASON**

-Soriano was transferred to Jacksonville on May 22 from Double-A Pensacola. Among the 114 pitchers who had logged at least 20.0 innings in the Southern League at the of his promotion, Soriano had logged the 11th-highest fly ball rate (50.9 percent) and fourth-lowest groundball rate (25.5 percent). His HR/FB rate at 7.1 percent, which was the 27th-lowest in the Southern League.

-Against right-handed hitters with Double-A Pensacola, Soriano posted .143 batting average against in 35 at-bats. Left-handed batters collected a 292 average in 48 at-bats against Soriano.

-With the bases empty (i.e. when pitching from the windup) with Pensacola, Soriano yielded a .308 opponents' average and 1.053 OPS. However, with runners on (i.e. when pitching from the stretch), opponents batted only .159 with a .469 OPS against his ledger.

-Soriano faced only two batters during the duration of his time with the Blue Wahoos in which Pensacola had a lead. He gave up a single and then an RBI triple for that contest to fall back into a tie.

#### 2021 SEASON

-In 10 starts at home between both Low-A Jupiter and High-A Beloit, Soriano went 3-1 with a 4.50 ERA in 48.0 innings (45 H, 22 BB, 64 K). Conversely, in eight starts on the road between the two levels, Soriano was 4-0 with a 2.18 ERA in 41.1 frames (39 H, 15 BB, 50 K).

-Between both levels, opponents batted .280 (52-for-186) against Soriano with the bases empty (i.e. when working from the windup). However, with runners on base, Soriano held opponents to a .203 (32-for-158).

-With Beloit, left-handed hitters batted .313/.411/.385/.796 in 96 at-bats against Soriano. Right-handed hitters slashed .231/.279/.397/.676 in 121 at-bats.
