EIGHT-RUN FIRST INNING PROPELS RIDERS TO VICTORY:

The Frisco RoughRiders plated eight runs and took an early 12-0 lead in an eventual 12-6 win over the Amarillo Sod Poodles on Friday night from HODGETOWN. The Riders (10-9) plated their first run in the first when **Dustin Harris** bounced into a fielder's choice against Amarillo (10-9) starter **Chad Patrick** (0-4), allowing **Evan Carter** to score, and **Chris Seise** then made it 3-0 when he doubled in a pair of runs. The very next batter, **Jax Biggers** hammered a three-run homer to make it 6-0. It was his second home run in as many days after he hit a grand slam on Thursday night. **Luisangel Acuña** capped the inning with a two-run double to button up the biggest scoring inning on the season at eight runs. In the second, Riders catcher **Scott Kapers** crushed a two-run home run for his second long ball of the series and third on the season and Frisco added on with an RBI groundout and a wild pitch scoring a run in the fourth to take a 12-0 advantage. Amarillo answered back with two runs in the fourth, another in the fifth and three more in the seventh, but the Riders won their second-straight game to tie the series at 2-2. Acuña paced the offense with three hits and **Thomas Saggese**, **Kapers** and **Trevor Hauver** each had two hits in the win. **Alex Speas** (1-0) earned the win with 1.2 shutout innings from the bullpen.

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire to start his 2023 season. Acuña is hitting .329 (28-for-85)/.370/.459/.829 through the first 19 games while ranking seventh in the Texas League in batting average (.329), second in hits (28), tied for sixth in doubles (6) and sixth in total bases (39). The Venezuelan is riding a six-game hitting streak, in which he is batting .357 (10-for-28)/.400/.429/.829. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he struck out at a 21.3 percent clip. This season, he is striking out just 17.2 percent of the time and his wRC+ has nearly doubled (68 in 2022, 120 in 2023).

STRONGER IN A WOLF(RAM) PACK:

The RoughRiders bullpen has been highlighted by **Grant Wolfram** this season. The 6'8 lefty has thrown six scoreless outings this season and is 2-0. Over 9.1 innings, he has allowed just three hits while striking out 11 and walking one. On Thursday in Amarillo, Wolfram threw 3.0 scoreless innings, his longest scoreless outing since July 4th, 2021 when he threw 6.0 scoreless as a starter with Hickory. Through his last 16 games with the Riders in 2022, he went 1-1 with a 1.77 ERA.

LOAD UM UP:

The RoughRiders have had a league-high 29 RBIs with the bases loaded this year, which is also tied for the most in Double-A (Biloxi). As a team, they are hitting .391 (9-for-23)/.357/1.043/1.400 with four grand slams and 29 RBIs. They are the only team in Minor League Baseball with four grand slams this season already as **Trevor Hauver** hit one on Opening Day, **Dustin Harris** added another in San Antonio, **Luisangel Acuña** blasted one against Arkansas and **Jax Biggers** slugged one in Amarillo. The Riders have had one grand slam in each of the four series they have played this season.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The RoughRiders have just committed eight errors through 19 games. The team's .988 fielding percentage is second in Minor League Baseball (Triple-A Memphis, .989). Their eight errors are the fewest in the minors.

WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 107 walks lead Double-A while their .358 team OBP is second in Double-A. **Dustin Harris** and **Evan Carter** are tied for the Double-A lead with 18 walks while Carter is fifth in OBP (.481).

I LIKE BIG WINS AND I CANNOT LIE:

The RoughRiders 10 wins this season have come by eight, six, seven, seven, 10, four runs, eight runs, three runs, four runs and six runs, respectively, while their nine losses have come by a combined 25 runs. That gives Frisco a +38 run differential through 19 games, which is first in the Texas League (second in Double-A) despite being second in the South Division. The only team with a +20 run differential in the league is Tulsa, which is 11-8 (+28). The RoughRiders have scored at least six runs 11 times (9-2) and scored three or fewer runs seven times (0-7).

EVAN ALMIGHTY:

Outfielder **Evan Carter** has reached safely in 15 of his 16 games this season, batting .323 (20-for-62)/.481/.532/1.013 with a double, four home runs, 18 walks, 18 RBIs and three stolen bases. Carter is eighth in the Texas League in average (.323), tied for eighth in home runs (4), second in RBIs (18), tied for first in walks (18) and sixth in OPS (1.013). The No. 1 prospect in the Rangers system won a MiLB Rawlings Gold Glove in 2022. The reigning Tom Greive Rangers Minor League Player of the Year, Carter joined the RoughRiders for the last week of the 2022 season and the playoffs. Carter is also the third-youngest player in the Texas League this season, trailing on 19-year-old Deyvison De Los Santos of Amarillo and 20-year-old Juan Santander of Corpus Christi. Since going 0-for-4 for the first time this season on Saturday in San Antonio, Carter has walked 13 times to four strikeouts over eight games with a .512 OBP.

ABOUT JACK

-Leiter was drafted in the first round (No. 2 overall) in 2021 by the Rangers out of Vanderbilt University. With the Commodores, Leiter was a unanimous First Team All-American and a finalist for both the Golden Spikes Award and the Dick Howser Trophy.

-Threw first regular-season, complete-game no-hitter to start SEC play since 1971 against No.16 South Carolina on March 20th, 2021. He walked the first batter of the game before retiring the last 27 he saw with 16 strikeouts on 124 pitches. Followed up that no-hitter with 7.0 no-hit innings in his next start (20.2 consecutive no-hit innings over three starts from March 20th - April 2nd).

-Drafted in 20th round in 2019 by NYY out of Delbarton School (NJ). Named 2019 New Jersey Gatorade POY, striking out 95 in 57 innings as a senior.

-The family lineage is strong with Jack. His father, Al, pitched in 19 MLB seasons (1987-2005), making two All-Star teams and winning both the 1993 and 1997 World Series. His uncle, Mark, played 11 seasons in the majors (1990-99; 2001) and his cousin, Mark Jr., pitched two seasons (2017-2018) with Philadelphia and Toronto. Al now works as an analyst for MLB Network.

2023 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2023 season as the No. 78 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com and the No. 5 prospect in the Rangers system.

2022 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2022 season as the No. 17 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com and the No. 1 prospect in the Rangers system.

-Leiter dazzled in his professional debut, striking out seven over his three innings against the Arkansas Travelers on April 9th. The righty helped draw the largest crowd since 2019 at Riders Field for the debut (9,322).

-Threw the Riders first quality start of the season on May 7th against Arkansas. Leiter retired the last 15 batters he saw, allowing just two hits (one in the first and one in the second inning).

-Leiter came out of the bullpen as a "start" to finish a suspended game on May 31st (game was finished on June 1st) and recorded a career-best eight strikeouts against Wichita over 5.2 innings. The game resulted in a 3-0 win for Frisco, the Riders second shutout win of the season to that point.

-The righty allowed just one home run over his first nine outings before allowing two against Amarillo on June 7th. The two home runs were a grand slam and a two-run shot in a 7-4 loss to the Sod Poodles.

-Leiter was placed on the Development List on June 28th and was activated on July 10th before his start against San Antonio.

-Pitched a 1-2-3 inning on nine pitches in The SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game from Dodger Stadium on July 16th.

2021 SEASON

-After being drafted second overall in the 2021 draft, Leiter did not pitch in the minor leagues. Instead, he returned to Vanderbilt to workout, continue college and prepare for 2022. Did not finish degree, but got closer.
