LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox had their hitting once again stifled by the Harrisburg Senators on Thursday Afternoon at Prince George's Stadium, as they dropped the third game of their six-game series 6-1. Despite taking an early lead and drawing 11 walks for the second-consecutive day, Bowie only went 0-for-5 at the plate with runners in scoring position, and stranded 14 runners on base. Bowie made the first strike in the contest after drawing out two long innings against right-hander Cole Henry with three walks and a wild pitch. In what turned out to be his only start for Bowie, top left-handed prospect DL Hall opened the morning strong for Bowie, retiring the first six batters of the game before allowing a pair of runners in the fourth inning that eventually scored against Bowie's bullpen. Harrisburg plated two additional runs in the seventh and eighth, including a two-run home run by Dondrei Hubbard, to push the game out of reach.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Senators had held the top spot in the Eastern League's Southwest Division for most of April, but enter the first series in May tied for second place behind Richmond. A team mostly lead by its pitching staff, Harrisburg has the third best team ERA in the league at the start of this series, at 3.59, as well as the fewest home runs allowed in the league, at just 16. They also sport one of the best closers in the league, as Matt Brill has already collected seven saves and a win in his nine appearances. The Senators sport one of the oldest rosters in the league with an average age around 25.5 years old.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-handed pitcher Steven Fuentes returns to the Nationals organization after seven years of service. He was signed as a minor league free agent on November 15th. Last season, he pitched in four levels of the Nationals organization, most notably to a 19.96 ERA in seven appearances in AAA Rochester. He has bounced back this season, pitching to a 3.43 ERA in four starts, not giving up an earned run in six innings against Hartford last time out. Fuentes last pitched against Bowie on September 9th of 2021, giving up five earned runs in 5 1/3 innings pitched. In game two, left-handed pitcher Evan Lee enters as the Nationals' 18th ranked prospect. He has had a strong start to his 2022 season, pitching to a 1.88 ERA in four starts. Lee has yet to give up more than one run in an outing, pitching five innings of two-hit one-run ball against Hartford on May 1st. Lee's last two outings of the 2021 season were against Aberdeen where he pitched a combined ten innings, giving up ten hits and four earned runs. On September 9th, he struck out nine Ironbirds through five innings.

MUNDY MASH

After missing about a week of play from a non-COVID illness, first baseman JD Mundy has been seeing the ball better than most in his return. In his last six games at the plate, Mundy has gone 5-for-16 at the plate, with a double, a home run, and five runs driven in. Most notably, Mundy has been drawing walks at a much higher rate. Prior to the time missed, Mundy had only drawn one walk in 35 plate appearances, but has drawn four walks in his last 22 plate appearances, including a career-high tying three-walk day against Harrisburg on May 5.

WE HARDLY KNEW YE

Following the conclusion of Thursday's game, the Baltimore Orioles announced the transfer of top prospects Adley Rutschman and DL Hall from Bowie to Triple-A Norfolk. After just three games with the Baysox, Rutschman hit 5-for-12 with two doubles, two runs driven in, and five runs scored. Hall made one start with Bowie, and threw 3.2 innings, while allowing two hits and two runs, against six strikeouts and only one walk.

PATIENCE, YOUNG GRASSHOPPER

Bowie has been frustrating opposing pitchers this season with their patience and discipline at the plate. Despite playing two fewer games than many teams in the league, their 108 walks lead the Eastern League. Bowie also sports three of the top ten batters in the Eastern League for most pitches seen, as Andrew Daschbach, Gunnar Henderson and Jordan Westburg sit in the rankings. Harrisburg, on the other hand, has not been too concerned with drawing walks, as their 78 walks is the second-fewest in the league.

TOP GUNNAR

Infielder Gunnar Henderson drew a walk on an automatic ball in Thursday's game, extending his on-base streak to 23-consecutive games, the best mark in the Eastern League this season. Henderson also has 22 walks on the year, second-most in the League. Gunnar has increased his walk rate from just 12.1% across three levels played last season up to over 20% so far this season. Henderson is ranked as the Orioles #3 prospect and Minor League Baseball's #64 overall prospect entering the 2022 season according to MLB Pipeline. Listed as #4 for the Orioles and #57 in MiLB by Baseball America. He was named the Orioles Organization All-Star at third base by MiLB.com for his 2021 season.

Career Notes

- Spent his time following the 2020 draft at the Angels alternate site at Long Beach State before being dealt to Baltimore the same December
- Orioles EVP/GM Mike Elias had targeted Stallings in the 2020 draft, but was taken earlier by the Angels.
- Threw two complete game shutouts in his junior season at Tennessee. He earned two SEC Pitcher of the Week awards, and was also named to the 2019 SEC All-Defensive team

What They're Saying:

Baseball America (2021): "Stallings is a polished righthander who mixes his pitches, limits his walks and lasts deep into his starts. His fastball sits 90-92 mph and his short, sharp mid-80s slider is his best secondary offering. Stallings mixes in an average low-80s changeup he commands well and a big, upper-70s curveball he is trying to throw for more strikes early in the count. He has a smooth, up-tempo delivery that is easy to repeat and allows him to command and sequence his four-pitch repertoire effectively. Stallings has a chance to move fast because of his command, advanced feel for pitching and business-like approach. His lack of a plus pitch limits his ceiling to a back-of-the-rotation starter."

Baysox Pitching Coach Josh Conway - Working with Stallings at Aberdeen in 2021: "He's a gamer. As far as the stuff goes, he's not going to blow up the radar gun, but he knows how to use what he's got....He's always in the zone.....a very efficient guy pounding the zone, coming right after you and basically daring you to hit him, which is nice. And he takes his strikeouts as needed. He found himself in a ton of 0-2, 1-2 counts this year, just being ahead of hitters, attacking guys in four pitches or less. Really had that mentality of, 'I'm just going to go right after you.' It was intriguing to see. He did a great job."

Notes by Outing*

- 4/13 @ BNG Allowed three baserunners in the first inning, but no runs across thanks to a double play. Struck out two batters in a perfect second inning, but allowed two runs across in the third on consecutive two-out doubles. Followed with a perfect fourth on a pop out and two ground outs. Bowie had an early three-run home run, Binghamton would tie the game, and Bowie would sneak a run across in the seventh to win.
- 4/20 v AKR Allowed a two-out single to Brayan Rocchio in the first inning, the only hit in the game for Akron. Logged two strikeouts looking in the second inning, part of a string of nine consecutive outs after the single. Allowed a two-out walk in the fourth inning, then again in the fifth inning. Ryan Watson piggybacked with four perfect innings. Tied for the longest scoreless outing of his career.
- 4/26 @ RIC Struck out the first two batters of the game, but allowed a solo home run to Sean Roby. Loaded the bases to start the second inning on a walk, a hit-by-pitch, and an error, but retired the next eight batters and worked a double play to avoid more runs. Bowie was shutout.
- 5/1 @ RIC All four hits given up to Richmond went for extra-bases, and all scored. Double and home run by Frankie Tostado, double by Rob Emery, and 2R HR by Shane Matheny.

Manager: Kyle Moore

He played three seasons with the Cubs organization, making it to Double-A in 2016. The Smithburg, Md native returned to the Chanticleers to complete his undergraduate degree and served as a student assistant and assistant pitching coach before joining the Orioles.
