**TODAY'S GAME:** The Fayetteville Woodpeckers (Low-A Astros) and Down East Wood Ducks (Low-A Rangers) will finish up Thursday night's game before the two teams will play a seven-inning contest. The game will resume prior to the start of the bottom of the third with no score. For the second game, RHP Shea Barry will be on the mound for the Woodpeckers while RHP Josh Stephan gets the start for the Wood Ducks.

**THE OPPONENT:** The Down East Wood Ducks were founded in 2017 as the High-A affiliate of the Texas Rangers, spending three seasons in the Carolina League and winning the league title in its inaugural season. Ahead of the 2021 Minor League season, the Wood Ducks were reclassified as the Single-A affiliate for Texas and joined the Low-A East division where they would win the 2021 division title. They play in Kinston, NC, a city that has ties to professional baseball dating back to 1908.

**CERNY NAMED ASTROS POTM:** The Houston Astros announced on Friday that Woodpeckers outfielder Logan Cerny has been named the organizational Minor League Player of the Month for June. During June, the 22-year-old Cerny batted .337 (29-for86) with seven doubles, five home runs, 27 RBI and a 1.011 OPS (.418 OBP/.593 SLG) in 23 games. This is the second award that Cerny has received this season, also being named the Carolina League Player of the Week back on June 13th. Former Fayetteville Woodpeckers pitcher Jaime Melendez was the Astros monthly award on the pitching side, pitching to a 2.01 ERA with 31 strikeouts over 22.1 innings in June.

**HEARTBREAK HOTEL:** The Woodpeckers have found themselves on the wrong side of a number of tough defeats in recent times. During last week's series against Carolina, Fayetteville lost twice and extras and three of their five losses came in one-run ballgames. The team is now just 1-8 in extra innings contests and have lost 16 games by a single run in 2022.

**THE PROSPECTS:** The Woodpeckers are currently carrying three of the Astros Top-30 Prospects on their active roster. RHP Alex Santos is the highest of the trio, sitting at #9. Outfielder Tyler Whitaker sits right behind him at #10 after dropping down a couple of spots. After a red-hot start to the month of June, outfielder Logan Cerny has surged up the rankings, coming in at #24 in the most recent rankings from MLB.com.

**SLUGGERS OF THE CAROLINAS:** Over the first 76 games of the regular season, the Woodpeckers have hit 71 long-balls, second to only Kannapolis in the league. 31 of Fayetteville's homers have been hit at Segra Stadium compared to 40 on the road, the second-most road homers of any team in the league behind Myrtle Beach (41). Additionally, the Woodpeckers are on pace to blow by their home run total in the 2021 season, where they finished fourth in the league with 111 homers.

**RUNNING WILD:** The new pitch clock and pick-off rules have led to a huge uptick in stolen bases across the league this season and multiple Woodpeckers are on-pace to steal close to 40 bases this year. With a pair of steals on Wednesday night against the Down East Wood Ducks, Logan Cerny (25) passed Ronaldo Urdaneta (2021) for the most steals in Woodpeckers franchise history since 2018. Joey Loperfido (23) and Cody Orr (22) are also on pace to shatter the current record. Myles Straw remains the all-time franchise record holder, swiping 36 bases for the Buies Creek Astros in 2017.

**CARLOS IS CRUISIN':** RHP Carlos Calderon has quietly put together an impressive 2022 season with the Woodpeckers. Calderon leads the team in innings pitched (60.1) and strikeouts (67), but also finds himself near the top of the Carolina League in other categories. He has the lowest opponents against average (.183) in the league and the eighth-lowest WHIP (1.24) among qualified arms.

**SOUTHPAWS BEWARE:** Left-handed pitchers have struggled this season against the Woodpeckers' offense. Fayetteville leads the league in batting average vs. LHP (.257) and also has the highest slugging percentage (.426) and OPS (.764) against lefties. In addition, the Woodpeckers have hit a league-high 16 homers off of lefties in 2022. Joey Loperfido has led the way for the Woodpeckers with a .362 average versus southpaws, the fourth-highest in the Carolina League.

Christian Mejias was lights out in relief, pitching five scoreless innings to set the stage for Miguel Palma, who singled home Cerny in the bottom of the eighth which proved to be the deciding run.

**WOODPECKERS FIELD STAFF****15 Joe Thon****Manager**

Thon makes his return to Fayetteville and begins his first season as Woodpeckers manager after serving as a development coach in 2021. As the development coach, Thon helped coach Woodpeckers hitters and fielders, as well as assist with lineup planning and creating reports on individual athletes on the team.

Prior to joining the Astros as a full-time coach, Thon served as a summer intern with the organization during the 2019 summer. He helped analyze and balance revenue summaries, verified accounts for reconciling payments and processed and organized invoices for the Astros and Astros Foundation.

Following his intership, Thon broke into the coaching ranks by joining the University of Houston Baseball program in August 2019 as a student assistant coach before becoming the volunteer assistant prior to the 2020 season. After one season with UofH, Thon returned to the Astros in a full-time coaching role.

The former Minor League infielder enjoyed a seven-year minor league playing career. Thon was drafted in the 5th round (pick 156) by the Toronto Blue Jays in 2010 out of Academia Perpetuo Socorro in San Juan, Puerto Rico. He played in the Blue Jays organization until 2016 when he signed to join the St. Louis Cardinals. Thon played in the Cardinals farm system through 2017, reaching as high as Double-A with the Springfield Cardinals. His playing career concluded in 2017 in the Independent Atlanta League with the Sugar Land Skeeters, now the Triple-A Affiliate of the Astros. In total, Thon appeared in over 500 games across his MiLB career, posting a .243/.356/.318 slash line with 79 doubles, 17 triples, 27 home-runs and 178 RBI. Thon also played for Liga de Beisbol Profesional Roberto Clemente in Puerto Rico from 2010 through December 2016.

Thon comes from a deep baseball background. He is the son of former Astros shortstop Dickie Thon, a 1983 All-Star with Houston who enjoyed a 15-year MLB career with the California Angels, Astros, Padres, Phillies, Rangers and Brewers. Joe and his fiance Erika spend their offseason living in Houston with their dogs.

**23 Jose Puentes****Hitting Coach**

Joining the Woodpeckers for his first season with the franchise and third season in the Astros organization is hitting coach Jose Puentes.

Puentes started his career with the Astros as a hitting coach in the Dominican Summer League and most recently served as hitting coach with the Florida Complex League Astros in 2021.

He has coached at the high school level at MacArthur High School, Johnson High School, Steele High School and Wagner High School. From 2006-2007, he was the head baseball coach at St. Anthony Catholic High School. Puentes has owned and operated two hitting academies, Gap to Gap Academy and Cardinals Select Baseball Academy.

He earned his bachelor's degree in Spanish and Master's degree in teaching from University of Incarnate Word along with a Master's degree in education from the University of Texas at San Antonio.

**16 John Kovalik****Pitching Coach**

John Kovalik takes over as the third pitching coach in Woodpeckers history, bringing three years of coaching experience to the Woodpeckers staff. The 30-year-old enters his fourth season in the Astros organization after serving as the pitching coach for the Tri-City Valley Cats in 2019, along with the pitching coach for the Florida Complex League Astros in 2021. While with the Valley Cats, Kovalik coached Astros farmhands and future big leaguers Luis Garcia, Jose Urquidy and Shawn Dubin along with other high-level pitching prospects.
