LATE OFFENSE LIFTS CARDINALS OVER ROUGHRIDERS, 6-3:

The Frisco RoughRiders were defeated by the Springfield Cardinals 6-3 on Tuesday evening from Riders Field. Springfield (24-16, 61-48) opened the scoring against Frisco (23-17, 67-42) starter **Ben Anderson** in the top of the first inning when Jimmy Crooks singled home Nathan Church, giving the Cardinals a 1-0 advantage. The Cardinals added to their lead with an RBI groundout from Church in the top of the third, making it a 2-0 game. Frisco chopped the lead in half in the bottom of the fourth where **Cody Freeman** scored on a fielder's choice off the bat of Luis Mieses. Anderson settled in to deliver a career-high matching 7.0 innings of two-run baseball, allowing two hits and no walks with a pair of strikeouts. Trailing 2-1 in the bottom of the seventh inning, the Riders tied the game on an RBI double from **Alejandro Osuna** and later took the lead on a double by Freeman. The Riders took a 3-2 lead to the top of the eighth, but a solo homer by Crooks against **Seth Clark** (1-2) evened the score. Clark exited with two outs after surrendering a single and a walk. **Jackson Kelley** allowed an RBI single to Dakota Harris, giving Springfield a 4-3 advantage. In the top of the ninth, the Cardinals added a pair of runs on four consecutive hits with RBI singles for both Crooks and Jacob Buchberger to extend the lead to 6-3. Offensively, the Riders collected 11 hits but went just 1-for-9 with runners in scoring position. **Abimelec Ortiz** paced the offense with a three-hit night and Freeman also collected a pair of hits.

START ME UP:

RoughRiders starting pitchers have been dominant over their last 13 games, owning a 1.66 ERA (12ER/65.0IP). Overall, Frisco has allowed just 34 earned runs in their last 13 games for a 2.71 ERA (113.0IP). The Riders have played incredibly close games over the last 13 games with 11 of the 13 games being decided by three runs or fewer (Frisco is 5-6 in those games).

RISP-ECT THIS PLEASE:

Over the last 19 games, the Riders are third in the Texas League with a .715 OPS, second with a .259 batting average and are sixth with 3.8 runs per game. Holding them back, Frisco is just batting just .166 (28-for-169) with runners in scoring position over their last 19 games.

READY TO ROCK(ER):

RoughRiders starting pitcher **Kumar Rocker** has been fantastic in his three starts with the RoughRiders since returning from his "Tommy John" surgery rehab this season. In the three starts, he has pitched 11.0 shutout innings, allowing just five hits and one walk with 16 strikeouts. Additionally, he has been incredibly efficient, averaging just 11.9 pitches per inning with the Riders. Rocker, who was selected by the Rangers as the No. 3 overall pick in the 2022 draft, is the No. 3 prospect in the Rangers organization and the No. 1 pitching prospect.

HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 35-16 at Riders Field this season. Their .686 winning percentage at home is first in Minor League Baseball. At home this season, Frisco has a +71 run differential, a 3.78 ERA and is averaging 5.5 runs per game with a .760 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 32-26 with a 3.22 ERA, but a +21 run differential while averaging 3.9 runs per game and owning a .638 OPS (10th in the league). **Cody Freeman** is slashing .343/.400/.598/.998 at home this season with nine of his 13 home runs. His .343 batting average is the best in the Texas League by a player at their home stadium.

OSUNA FROM THE RIDERS:

Alejandro Osuna has been incredible for Frisco since joining them from High-A Hickory. In 32 games, he is hitting .298 (37-for-124)/.397/.516/.913 with 14 doubles, two triples, three home runs and 18 RBIs. Over his last 29 games, he is batting .306 (34-for-111)/.414/.532/.946 with 12 doubles, two triples, three home runs and 18 RBIs. He has reached in 29 of his 32 games with the Riders. He set that career high in his final game in High-A this year, also hitting for the cycle in a 5-for-5 game.

THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen is the second-best in the Texas League this season, owning a 3.21 ERA, which is also the fifth-best in all of Minor League Baseball. Overall, the Riders are on pace to have the second-best team ERA in franchise history (3.49), just behind 2014 (3.39). Additionally, their .230 BAA is on pace to be the second-best in the franchise's history (.228 in 2021).

WE'RE GOING DANCING:

The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

ABOUT DANE

-Went to Brenham High School in Brenham, Texas (between Austin and Houston). His senior year of high school, he went 5-2 with a 1.79 ERA.

-Acker attended Rice for freshman season, going 5-2 with a 4.20 ERA and earned Conference USA All-Freshman Team honors. From there, transferred to San Jacinto College for sophomore season in 2019, going 10-0 with a 2.36 ERA in 14 starts. He struck out 97 batters in 76.1 IP.

-Drafted by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 2019 23rd round, but did not sign.

-For his junior season, he went to Oklahoma University, making four starts in the COVID-shortened season, going 1-1 with a 3.51 ERA. At the Schripes College Classic on March 1st against No.11 LSU, Acker threw the first Oklahoma no-hitter since 1989, striking out 11 batters to just one walk and two hit batters. He threw 117 pitches in the game.

-Acker was taken by the Oakland Athletics in the 4th round of the 2020 draft, one pick after Braves pitcher Spencer Strider.

2024 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 28 prospect in the Texas system by MLB.com entering the season.

-In first start at Wichita on Opening Day, threw 3.2 no-hit innings before allowing his first hit. Finished with 4.2 innings, allowing just one run in a 6-4 Riders win.

-Pitched first two quality starts in MiLB career on 6/15 and 6/22. On 6/22, he went 5.0 scoreless before allowing three runs in the sixth.

2023 SEASON

-Ranked as the No. 22 prospect in the Texas system by MLB.com entering the season.

-In Double-A debut at San Antonio on July 3rd, allowed two-run inside the park homer in the third inning to Juan Fernandez, but struck out five.

-When he was promoted to Double-A Frisco on July 3rd, Acker had just thrown 53.1 career MiLB innings over 17 games with only 50.1 innings and 12 games in affiliated ball above the Rookie level.

-Finished out High-A time with a 1.65 ERA (3ER/16.1IP) in June.

-Induced ground balls at a 46.9% rate with High-A Hickory over his six starts.

-Earned first career MiLB win with five strong innings against San Antonio on July 18th.

-Made best start of MiLB career on August 30th against CC with 5.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 2 BB, 5 K.

2022 SEASON

-Acker returned from rehab in mid-July, throwing in the Arizona League before making four starts with Hickory, debuting with the Crawdads on August 21st.

-After the season, Acker participated in the Rangers' Fall Instructional League program.

2021 SEASON

-After trade to Rangers, Acker made two starts with the Down East Wood Ducks before his second ended with "Tommy John" surgery.

-Traded from the Oakland Athletics along with OF Khrist Davis and C Jonah Heim in exchange for INF Elvis Andrus and C Aramis Garcia and cash on February 6th, 2021.
