**Tonight's Game:** The Nashville Sounds take on the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp in game three of the six-game series. Jacksonville walked-off the Sounds 10-9 in 10 innings yesterday afternoon. Caleb Boushley gets the start for Nashville, facing Jacksonville's Bryan Hoeing.

**Caleb Boushley:** 29-year-old Caleb Boushley gets the start for Nashville, his International League-leading fifth start of the 2023 season. The right-hander is 0-1 with a 10.13 ERA (10.2 IP/12 ER) to start the 2023 season. He took his first loss as a Sound since April 12, 2022 in his last outing on Saturday vs. Norfolk (4.0 IP, 9 H, 7 R, 7 ER, 0 BB, 3 K). Boushley went 12-2 with a 3.25 ERA (127.1 IP/46 ER) across 25 starts with Nashville a season ago. The Wisconsinite was drafted by Milwaukee in the Triple-A phase of the 2021 Rule 5 Draft from San Diego. He was originally selected in the 33rd round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft by the Padres out of Wisconsin-La Crosse.

**Bryan Hoeing:** 26-year-old Bryan Hoeing starts for the Jumbo Shrimp this evening. The right-hander is 0-0 with a 2.92 ERA (12.1 IP/4 ER) through three outings (2 starts) this season. His last start came on April 14 at Charlotte, taking a no decision despite lasting 5.1 innings (2 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 0 BB, 5 K). He holds a 6.75 ERA in home games (4.0 IP/3 ER) compared to a 1.08 ERA (8.1 IP/1 ER) on the road in 2023. Hoeing went 7-5 with a 5.07 ERA (94.0 IP/53 ER) in 18 games (17 starts) for Jacksonville a season ago. He made his Major League debut with the Marlins on August 20, 2022 at Los Angeles-NL (L, 3.0 IP, 8 H, 7 ER, 1 BB, 2 K) and finished 1-1 with a 12.08 ERA with Miami last season. The Batesville, Ind. native was selected in the seventh round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Louisville.

**Eddy's Four Hit Day:** Sounds infielder/outfielder Eddy Alvarez became the first Sound with four hits in a game in yesterday's loss (4-for-5, 2 2B, 3 RBI). Overall on the season, Alvarez is batting .341 (15-for-44) with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 2 home runs, 7 RBI, 10 walks, 9 runs and 3 stolen bases on the season. His .341 average is the best in Milwaukee's minor league system.

**Toro on a Tear:** Abraham Toro pushed his on-base streak to 12 games last night with a two RBI single in the first inning. It is one of 17 active on-base streaks of 12 or more games in the IL. He is also tied with Jon Singleton's 12-game on-base streak as the longest team on-base streaks.

**Made For Walking:** Jon Singleton extended his on-base streak to 12 games with three walks yesterday afternoon. After walking only once through his first 10 games, Singleton has earned eight free passes over the past five games and five to start the series. He set a Sounds single season record and led the league with 117 walks in 2022.

**Our Hiura:** Keston Hiura clobbered his seventh home run of the season and first of the road trip with a solo homer in the third inning of Wednesday's contest. Hiura trails only Jacksonville's Peyton Burdick (8) among league leaders in home runs.

**Skid Hits Five:** The Sounds have dropped below .500 for the first time since April 7, 2022 (1-2) with yesterday's loss. It is their fifth consecutive defeat, the longest losing streak since June 4-9, 2022. Nashville has not been under .500 17 games into the season since 2019, when they started 5-12 as a Rangers affiliate.

**On the Mend:** Brewers rehabbing starter Adrian Houser made his second appearance with the Sounds on his MLB rehab stint on Tuesday night. The right-hander struck out five over 3.0 innings while allowing a couple of home runs in the second. Overall, Houser has a 3.60 ERA through 5.0 innings with Nashville since joining the team on rehab last Thursday.

**The Future Brew Crew:** Nashville opens the 2023 season with five players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 9 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 13 prospect, right-handed pitcher Janson Junk is the No. 15 prospect and right-handed pitcher Cam Robinson is the No. 24 prospect.

**How Sweet It Is:** Sounds manager Rick Sweet begins his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 608-527 record during an eight-season span.

**LAST OUTING:** Boushley's last start came on April 15 vs. Norfolk. He ran into trouble in the fourth and fifth innings, facing four batters in the latter without recording an out. He took the loss after tossing 4.0+ innings, allowing seven runs (all earned) on nine hits. He also struck out three.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** Boushley is 1-0 with a 3.27 ERA (11.0 IP/4 ER) and nine strikeouts in two career starts against Jacksonville. In his most recent start (9/17/22) at First Horizon Park, he spun six scoreless frames.
