**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels dropped their third straight game to the Altoona Curve, 4-2. Brendt Citta opened the scoring with an RBI single in the first inning. Canaan Smith-Njigba added an RBI single later in the inning. In the second, **Ryan Howard** hit a solo homer, his second in the last two days, to close within a run. In the third, **Shane Matheny** brought in a run with a groundout to tie the score at 2-2. Altoona pulled ahead in the seventh when Arden Pabst scored on a wild pitch. Deon Stafford stretched the Curve's lead to 4-2 with a solo homer in the ninth. Howard finished with two hits for the second straight game. **Caleb Kilian** made his second Double-A start and allowed two runs over 5.0 innings with four strikeouts.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, at The Diamond. This series marks the only trip to Richmond this season for the Curve. The Flying Squirrels play six games at Altoona's Peoples Natural Gas Field from August 24-29.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have lost three straight games. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 6.0 games behind first-place Bowie. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked seventh in the league with a .238 batting average. The pitching staff is third in the league with a 3.28 ERA for the season so far.

**THE CURVE** have won six of the last eight games. They are currently tied for third place in the Double-A Northeast, 3.5 games behind first-place Bowie. Altoona's roster includes six of MLB.com's top-30 Pittsburgh Pirates prospects, including Oneil Cruz (4), Ji-hwan Bae (14), Mason Martin (15), Cal Mitchell (18), Roansy Contreras (20) and Canaan Smith-Njigba (26).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Sean Hjelle** makes his sixth start of the 2021 season. Last time out, he surrendered four runs (three earned) over 5.0 innings in a win at Reading on Saturday in the second game of a double-header. In 2019, Hjelle climbed three levels in the Giants' system. He began the year with Single-A Augusta for nine starts, made 14 starts with A-Adv. San Jose and joined the Flying Squirrels for five starts at the end of the year. Hjelle finished the year ranked fourth in the Giants organization in strikeouts (139) and fifth in ERA (3.32). He enters the 2021 season rated by *Baseball America* as the Giants' No. 13 prospect. Hjelle was drafted in the second round in 2018 out of the University of Kentucky. **For more on Hjelle, see page two.**

**FOR ALTOONA:** Left-hander Trey McGough makes his Double-A debut. He began the season with High-A Greensboro, where he posted a 2.00 ERA in six appearances, including one start. In his lone start of the year to date, he tossed 5.0 scoreless and allowed three hits. He did not allow a run in his final three appearances with Greensboro, spanning 11.0 innings. McGough was drafted by the Pittsburgh Pirates in the 24th round in 2019 out of Mount St. Mary's in Maryland. That year, he made 18 appearances between rookie-level Bristol and short-season West Virginia, combining to go 3-1 with a 3.86 ERA.

**ING: Ryan Howard** has homered in each of his last two games, his first home runs of the 2021 season. He holds a .500 batting average (4-for-8) in the current series against Altoona with the two homers, one double and three RBIs. Through his first 17 games from May 4-30, Howard hit .194 (7-for-36). This week, he has played the first games of his professional career at first base after previous playing on the three other infield spots throughout his career.

**ADDING IT UP:** Over his last 10 games since May 23, **Shane Matheny** has hit .300 (9-for-30) with four doubles, a homer and six RBIs. On Saturday at Reading, Matheny hit the first home run of his Double-A career, a go-ahead shot in the Flying Squirrels' 2-1 win. Matheny is currently riding a 16-game on-base streak since May 15, during which he is batting .255 (12-for-47) with 13 walks. For the season, Matheny is ranked tied for fifth in the league with 17 walks.

**RAMOS RAKING:** On Wednesday, **Heliot Ramos** went hitless and his 12-game on-base streak ended. However, over his last 14 games since May 18, he is batting .327 (18-for-55) with one homer, three doubles and seven RBIs. For the season, Ramos is currently ranked eighth in the league in batting average (.299) and tied for third in hits (29).

**STRONG ARMS:** This season, the Flying Squirrels rank third in the Double-A Northeast with a 3.36 ERA, which is fifth in Double-A overall. The pitching staff also ranks second in the league in WHIP (1.18) and opponents' batting average (.208).

**THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY:** The Flying Squirrels' relievers have the fourth-best bullpen ERA in all of Minor League Baseball at 2.65 on the season, which is second-best in Double-A. The bullpen is second in Double-A with 10 saves. Richmond relievers have allowed the second-fewest runs (38), second-fewest hits (65) and have the best BAA (.170) in Double-A. **Patrick Ruotolo** is third in the Double-A Northeast with four saves and **Norwith Gudino** is tied for fourth with three.

**STRONG START:** The Flying Squirrels' 15-12 record is tied for the second-best start in team history through 27 games, matching the starts of the season in 2014 and 2018. It trails only a 16-11 start in the 2010 season. The team's best start through 28 games is a 17-1 record in 2010. The Flying Squirrels went 16-12 in 2014 and 2018.

**GETTING ON THE BOARD:** Dating back to August 25, 2019, the Flying Squirrels have scored at least one run in 36 consecutive games. That streak includes all 27 games of the 2021 season. The only team in the Double-A Northeast with a longer streak is Portland, which has scored at least one run in 39 straight games. Richmond and Portland are the only two teams in the Double-A Northeast that have not been shut out this year.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Tristan Beck** (12), **Sean Hjelle** (13) and **Jose Marte** (30). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Four players, Ramos (3), Hjelle (11), Beck (20) and **Caleb Kilian** (30) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.

**GOING FOR GOLD:** Flying Squirrels manager **José Alguacil** is taking an absence from his position in Richmond to manage the Venezuelan national team for the WBSC Baseball Americas Olympic Qualifier at Clover Park in St. Lucie, Fla. and The Ballpark of the Palm Beaches in West Palm Beach, Fla. Venezuela is playing in Group B with Canada, Colombia and Cuba. Venezuela picked up a 6-5 win over Cuba on Monday and beat Colombia, 3-2, on Tuesday. They improved to 3-0 with a 5-0 win against Canada on Wednesday. The top two teams from each group will play in a super round on June 4 and 5, with the team holding the best record from that round earning a spot in the Olympics in Japan. **Tony Diggs** managed the team for its six-game series in Reading from May 25-30, going 5-1. **Jason Wood** is managing the Flying Squirrels during this week's series. He spent the last 10 seasons as a manager in the Texas Rangers organization. He was with High-A Myrtle Beach from 2011-2013, Double-A Frisco in 2014, Triple-A Round Rock from 2015-2018 and Triple-A Nashville in 2019. Wood is currently the Giants' Coordinator of Infield Instruction. Catcher **Andres Angulo** is also away from the team, heading down to Florida to play for his home country, Colombia, in the Qualifier.

**MOVIN' UP:** Right-handed pitcher **Matt Frisbee** has been promoted to Triple-A Sacramento, one day after being named Double-A Northeast Pitcher of the Month for May. During his time with the Flying Squirrels, Frisbee went 4-1 with a 1.24 ERA. For the month of May, he led all of MiLB in WHIP (0.41), ranked second in BAA (.112) and second in innings pitched (29.0). He also ranked fourth in Double-A in ERA (1.24), tied for first in wins (4) and led the level in innings pitched, BAA and WHIP. In the Double-A Northeast, Frisbee led the circuit in ERA, wins, inning pitched, BAA and WHIP. He also ranked seventh in strikeouts (32) and ninth in winning percentage (.800). The Asheville, N.C. native opened the season with 11.0 consecutive scoreless innings across his first two starts. On May 13, Frisbee combined with Joey Marciano, Matt Seelinger and Patrick Ruotolo to hold the Harrisburg Senators hitless, the first nine-inning no-hitter in Flying Squirrels history. On Sunday at Reading, Frisbee, closed out the month setting a season high in innings pitched (7.0) and strikeouts (8). After allowing a single in the first inning, Frisbee retired the next 21 batters in order to earn his fourth win.
