NW ARKANSAS NATURALS (1-4, 30-42) vs. SPRINGFIELD CARDINALS (4-1, 35-38)

RHP FELIX ARRONDE (3-2, 5.36 ERA) vs. SHP JURRANGELO CIJNTJE (3-4, 5.07 ERA)

SETTING THE SCENE: The Cardinals and Naturals (Royals) wrap up the opening series of the 2nd half at Route 66 Stadium with the final game of the 6-game set ... Springfield is 4-1 this week and clinched a series victory with last night's win ... the Cardinals have won 4 straight games and 8 of their last 9 ... SHP Jurrangelo Cijntje starts for Springfield against RHP Felix Arronde.

SWITCH ON 'EM: RHP Jurrangelo Cijntje makes his 15th start of the season and his 3rd against the Naturals ... started the opening game of this series on Tuesday and took a loss despite giving up only 1 run on 3 hits over 6.0 innings ... struck out 6 and walked 2 ... was his 2nd 6.0 inning start of the season.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Springfield clinched a series victory with a 4-0 win over NW Arkansas ... three Cardinals pitchers combined on the team's 2nd shutout win of the season and the first at Route 66 Stadium ... OF Tre Richardson III scored the team's first 2 runs on a passed ball in the 4th and a sac fly in the 6th ... LHP Jack Findlay pitched the final 2 frames to earn his 2nd save.

MOLINA'S MOUND: LHP Mason Molina went 6.2 innings for the 2nd straight start on Saturday to tie his season and team highs ... continues to be the only Springfield starter to pitch into the 7th inning this season ... was his 2nd straight start of 6.2 innings and 0 ER ... leads the Cardinals with a 2.87 ERA and 1.10 WHIP ... both rank 2nd in the Texas League ... leads the Cardinals and ranks 4th in the league with 82 strikeouts.

MOORE HITS: IF Brody Moore collected 2 hits on Saturday to extend his hit streak to 14 ... is Springfield's longest hitting streak of the season and tied for the longest in the Texas League this season ... has hit safely in every game since joining the club from Triple-A Memphis ... hitting .368 (21x57) during the streak.

STAYCATION: Springfield is currently in the midst of its longest homestand (12 games) this season ... a 6-game series vs. Arkansas begins Tuesday.

DEN AND DUSTED: IF Deniel Ortiz hit a 3-run walk-off home run to complete a Cards' comeback in Game 1 on Friday ... was his first homer at Double-A and Springfield's second walk-off homer this season ... completed the Cardinals largest comeback of the season (down 5-0).

CHO SHOW: OF Won-Bin Cho's grand slam on Friday was his 2nd homer at Double-A and the Cardinals' 6th grand slam of the season ... last was IF Trey Paige on 6/9 vs. Amarillo.

OZARKS SERIES: Today's game is the 12th of 24 in the season series with NW Arkansas and the 5th of 12 at Route 66 Stadium ... Springfield is 5-6 against the Naturals.

- Acquired by Cardinals from Seattle as part of a three-team deal including Tampa Bay on 2/2/26 ... STL also acquired OF Tai Peete, OF Colton Ledbetter, and two Compensation Round B picks while sending IF Brendan Donovan to Seattle in deal
- Entered 2026 season ranked as the No. 6 prospect in Cardinals organization according to *Baseball America* and the No. 91 overall prospect in baseball according to *MLB Pipeline*
- Is designated as a switch-pitcher and will pitch both right-handed and left-handed with the Cardinals
- Drafted by Seattle in the 1st round (15th overall) in 2024 MLB Draft
- Originally drafted by Milwaukee in 18th round in 2022 MLB Draft, but did not sign
- Born in Gravenhague, Netherlands ... grew up primarily in Willemstad, Curaçao
- Played collegiately at Mississippi State ... went 11-7 with a 5.25 ERA over two seasons
- Graduated from Champagnat Catholic School in Hialeah, FL ... was rated No. 1 switch-pitcher in the nation and the No. 34 pitcher overall by Perfect Game
- Played for Curaçao in 2016 Little League World Series ... played infield and pitched from both sides of the mound
