The Round Rock Express face off against the Sugar Land Skeeters in game two on Friday night at Dell Diamond. Express LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang is set to get the start up against Skeeters RHP Hector Velazquez. First pitch in Round Rock is scheduled for 7:05 p.m.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT

The Sugar Land Skeeters claimed a 2-1 series-opening win over the Round Rock Express on Thursday night at Dell Diamond. Sugar Land took an early 1-0 lead as SS Alex De Goti hit a first-inning leadoff single before scoring on a double from CF Jake Meyers in the next at-bat. The Skeeters put another run across in the third as De Goti hit a triple and Meyers drove De Goti in with a base hit to put Sugar Land ahead 2-0. Round Rock plated its sole run in the fourth inning as LF Leody Taveras, 3B Ryan Dorow and DH Jason Martin drew consecutive walks to load the bases. A wild pitch from Skeeters RHP Colin McKee allowed Taveras to score, bringing the Express within 2-1. McKee threw for two strikeouts and a pop out to strand both E-Train runners in scoring position. With not much going in the final five frames, Round Rock put a runner on third base in both the seventh and eighth innings but couldn't bring them home for the tie. Skeeters RHP Ronel Blanco earned the save with a perfect 1-2-3 ninth inning, closing out the 2-1 final.

THIRD TIME'S THE CHARM

Express LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang is scheduled to make his third start of the season with Round Rock in Friday night's contest. Yang has allowed just three runs, all solo home runs, in 8.1 innings across two appearances for a 3.24 ERA.

BEST IN THE WEST

The Sugar Land and Round Rock pitching staffs hold the top two ERAs in the Triple-A West League. Coming on the heels of Thursday's contest that saw just 11 total hits and 22 strikeouts, the Express maintain a 4.83 ERA (227 ER/423.1 IP) while the Skeeters sit atop the league with a 4.30 ERA (197 ER/412.1 IP).

ACTION IN THE OUTFIELD

Round Rock LF Leody Taveras recorded two outfield assists in Thursday night's loss, marking the first time this season that an Express outfielder tallied multiple outfield assists in a game. One of the assists came on a double play as Taveras caught a fly ball before connecting with C Yohel Pozo to tag Skeeters CF Jake Meyers out at home.

SLUGGING SLUMP

Round Rock has tallied only 17 hits over the last three contests, with just four extra-base hits in that span. After recording just three singles last night, the Express are also facing the season's longest home run drought, with the last shot out of the park coming back on June 28 at El Paso. It is the second time this season that Round Rock has gone three consecutive games without a home run.

WALK THE PLANK

For the fifth time this season, E-Train pitching allowed just one walk during last night's game. After issuing the lone free pass with one out in the second inning, starter RHP Drew Anderson put the next two batters away with a fly out and strikeout. Round Rock's offense drew a total of five, including three in a row, leading to the team's lone run.

REPPING TEAM USA!

Round Rock RHP Ryder Ryan is heading to Tokyo as a member of the 2021 USA Olympic Baseball Team. The righty holds a 1-2 record with a 3.72 ERA (8 ER/19.1 IP) over 17 relief appearances this season. He has struck out 22 while holding opponents to a .240 batting average. Ryan will be joined on Team USA by three other Round Rock alumni, RHP Anthony Carter (2016), INF Patrick Kivlehan (2016) and RHP Nick Martinez (2015-2017).

ONE STEP CLOSER TO THE SHOW

Twenty members of the Round Rock Express have made their Triple-A debuts so far in 2021: RHP Jason Bahr, INF Jax Biggers, OF Carl Chester, INF Ryan Dorow, RHP Scott Engler, RHP Demarcus Evans, RHP Joe Gatto, C Blake Grant-Parks, INF Yonny Hernandez, INF Jake Hoover, C Jack Kruger, INF Charles Leblanc, LHP Sal Mendez, RHP Tyler Phillips, RHP Ryder Ryan, OF Leody Taveras, INF Anderson Tejeda, INF Curtis Terry, RHP Collin Wiles and LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang. Interestingly enough, Evans, Taveras and Tejeda all saw action with the Texas Rangers during the shortened 2020 season despite no experience at the Triple-A level. C Jack Kruger also suited up for the Los Angeles Angels and LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang pitched for the Rangers in 2021 before making their Triple-A debuts.

STATING THE FACTS

American-born players on Round Rock's roster hail from 14 different states: California, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Kansas, Maryland, Michigan, Mississippi, Nevada, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Texas and Virginia. RHP Jake Lemoine (Bridge City) and INF Jax Biggers (Missouri City) are the lone Texans on the roster. Lemoine was a standout pitcher at the University of Houston before being drafted by the Texas Rangers in 2012.

AROUND THE WORLD

Six different nations are represented on the Express roster. In addition to the 23 players from the United States, INF Charles Leblanc is Canadian, OF Elier Hernandez, RHP Dennis Santana and OF Leody Taveras hail from the Dominican Republic, LHP Hyeon-Jong Yang is from South Korea, RHP Jharel Cotton is a native of the U.S. Virgin Islands and C Yohel Pozo and INF Yonny Hernandez are Venezuelan.

EXPRESS MANAGER KENNY HOLMBERG

The 2021 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kenny Holmberg's 13th year in the Texas Rangers organization. In 2020, he worked with Rangers prospects at the Alternate Training Site in Arlington, as well as the Fall Developmental League in Arizona. Round Rock will be the fourth different club for which Holmberg has managed in the Rangers farm system after serving at the helm of Short-Season Spokane in 2018, the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers from 2013-2015 and the Rookie-level Dominican Summer League Rangers from 2010-2011. He has compiled a 207-172 (.546) record while leading his clubs to the postseason in four of his six managerial campaigns, including a Northwest League championship series appearance in 2018. He originally joined the Texas organization as a coach for the DSL Rangers in 2009 and also served as a coach for the club's High-A affiliate in Myrtle Beach in 2012. In addition to his managerial post for the Express, Holmberg also serves as the Rangers' Major League Infield Coordinator.



An infielder in his playing days, Holmberg was selected by Milwaukee in the 22nd round of the 2005 MLB draft and played four seasons in the Brewers organization. He compiled a .272 average with 34 home runs and 187 RBI over 338 career minor league games. Holmberg was also selected by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 49th round of the 2001 MLB draft out of Dunedin High School in Florida but opted to play collegiately at St. Petersburg College from 2002-2003. He then spent two seasons at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, earning first-team NAIA All-America honors in 2005.
