LATE OFFENSE LIFTS TRAVS OVER RIDERS:

The Frisco RoughRiders were defeated by the Arkansas Travelers 4-1 on Tuesday evening from Dickey-Stephens Park. Frisco (5-3, 49-28) started the scoring against Arkansas (5-3, 41-35) starter Danny Wirchansky when **Cooper Johnson** singled home **Aaron Zavala** in the top of the second inning, giving the Riders a 1-0 advantage. **Ryan Garcia** followed up Monday's 10 inning shutout for the RoughRiders pitching staff with 6.0 scoreless, two-hit frames, including seven strikeouts, to earn his third-consecutive quality start. After a 1.58 ERA (17 ER in 97.0 IP) in June, Frisco's bullpen delivered 5.0 scoreless on Monday night, but the Travelers got to **Reid Birlingmair** (2-3) in the bottom of the seventh, using three hits and three hit-by-pitches to manufacture four runs to take a 4-1 lead. **Ricky DeVito** worked 1.1 hitless frames with a pair of walks and three strikeouts. The Riders brought the tying run to the plate in the top of the ninth after a single by Zavala and a walk by Johnson, but were unable to score. Offensively, the Riders managed just five hits and were paced by Zavala's two-hit night. The Riders went just 1-for-7 with runners in scoring position, stranding nine runners on the basepaths. Johnson logged the lone RBI and reached three times on two walks and a single.

I WANT TO BREAK FREE(MAN):

Cody Freeman blasted a go-ahead home run in the seventh on Friday, giving him the team lead with nine this year. While he slowed down slightly at the plate in June (batting .253/.298/.437/.735), he has clubbed three home runs in his last eight games with two of them being game-winners. This season, he has a career highs in average (.273), slugging percentage (.455) and OPS (.784) while being on pace to set new career bests in RBIs (63) and home runs (16).

WE'RE GOING DANCING:

Tuesday marked the first day of the second half. After a Midland loss on two Sundays ago, the RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The Riders have the second-fewest errors in all of Minor League Baseball (45) while also ranking third in fielding percentage (.983) in the minors. Frisco's 72 double plays are second in the Texas League. Frisco have allowed the fourth-fewest stolen bases in MiLB (55), throwing out 29 percent of total base runners against them.

THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen has been the best in the Texas League this season, owning a 2.90 ERA, which is also the third-best in all of Minor League Baseball. In their last seven games, the bullpen has a 2.45 ERA (8ER/29.1IP). In their last five series, spanning 33 games, Frisco's bullpen has a 1.88 ERA (25ER/120.0IP). In June, **Steven Jennings** was fantastic, only surrendering two runs over his nine outings, throwing 18.1 innings (0.98 ERA).

FIRING BLANKS:

In their last 23 games, the Riders have allowed just 59 earned runs over 211.0 IP (2.52 ERA). On Saturday, the Riders allowed seven runs (six earned) for the first time in 11 games (8 allowed on 6/5 at CC). Frisco has not allowed double-digit runs in 33 games (5/23 vs. MID). Frisco had the second-best ERA in all of Minor League Baseball during the month of June, at 2.89. Having won 24 of their last 35 games since May 25th, the Riders have the best ERA in Minor League Baseball (2.63) during that stretch while also being tied for second in saves (12) and first in wins (24) since May 25th. The team with the second-best ERA in that stretch (Vancouver) has a 3.01 ERA. In those last 35 games, the Riders have allowed more than three runs in a game just 12 times and nine times in the last 23 games. Their Tuesday and Thursday 2-1 losses in Midland marked their first two losses when allowing three runs or fewer, dropping them to 38-2 in those games.

HICKS IS THE PICK:

Liam Hicks has been on fire at the plate for the Riders over his last 38 games, batting .318 (41-for-129)/.428/.442/.870 with seven doubles, three home runs, 18 RBIs, 19 walks, 19 strikeouts and 24 runs. In June (21 games), he hit .333 (25-for-75)/.440/.520/.960 with five doubles, three home runs and 11 RBIs, reaching in all but three games in the month. He paced the Texas League in BA (.333) and OPS (.960) in June. Two Fridays ago in Corpus Christi, Hicks collected two home runs for his first multi-home run game of his Minor League career.

ABOUT BEN

-Played high school baseball at Shenendehowa (N.Y.) High School and was drafted by Toronto in the 26th round of the 2016 June draft following his senior yr, but did not sign. He was a catcher and a pitcher in high school. He was a 1st Team All-State Catcher, but was drafted as a pitcher.

-Went to the University of Binghamton for three seasons (same field he won a NYS Class AA Championship at in HS). At BU, he went 13-7 with a 2.62 ERA over three years. In final year, went 9-4 with a 2.76 ERA over 15 starts while striking out 108 in 88.0 innings to 27 walks.

-Twin brother, Ian, was selected by Atlanta in the 1st round (3rd overall) of the 2016 June draft and played a key role on the Braves' 2021 World Series championship team. Ben attended the Braves' 2020 postseason games played at Globe Life Field.

-Father, Bob, played baseball at Siena.

2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation, though he made his Double-A debut in relief on Opening Day (4/5) with a scoreless inning, striking out three side.

-Made best start of the season against Amarillo on April 24th, throwing six innings, allowing just two earned (two-run home run in the first inning by Tim Tawa).

-Struck out career-best eight at Amarillo in game two of the doubleheader on May 16th.

2023 SEASON

-Opened the season on the Injured List while recovering from "Tommy John" surgery.

2022 SEASON

-Returned to Hickory (A+) and went 5-3, 3.51 ERA (16 ER/41.0 IP) over 9 starts before experiencing discomfort in his right elbow during outing on 6/9 at Bowling Green. He underwent season-ending "Tommy John" ligament replacement surgery on 6/15/22

2021 SEASON

-Pitching mainly in an extended relief role, he combined to go 3-1, 3.70 (23 ER/56.0 IP) in 20 G/4 GS for Down East (A) and Hickory (A+), averaging 10.0 strikeouts per 9 innings.

-Began season with Down East and was promoted to Hickory on 7/7.

-Saw minimal pro action after being drafted. Posted a 9.9 SO/9 figure over 7 G for Spokane (A) and AZL Rangers (Rk.).
