SPEED? I AM SPEED

With 7 stolen bases on Saturday night, the Shuckers enter Sunday with 26 this season, tied for the most in the Southern League and tied for 2nd in Double-A... The Shuckers have recorded 21 stolen bases in 5 games during this week's series, tied for the most in Minor League Baseball.

- The Shuckers have recorded 3 games with at least 6 stolen bases in this week's series against Pensacola, marking the 12th, 13th and 14th games in franchise history (since 2015) with 6+ stolen bases.
- Prior to this week, the Shuckers had never recorded at least 6 stolen bases 3 times in a single season.

GONE FISHING

Over the first 5 games of the series, the Shuckers have outscored the Blue Wahoos 40-18, a +22 run differential.

- The Shuckers need 10 runs today to reach 50 in a series for the 3rd time in franchise history... The Shuckers scored at least 43 runs in 3 series last season... The Shuckers have not scored 45 runs in a series since July 18-23, 2023, against the Montgomery Biscuits, when they set the franchise record with 55.
- Since the start of 2025, the Shuckers are 15-5 against the Blue Wahoos at Keesler Federal Park, the best record against any Southern League opponent over that span.

HOMER HAPPY SHUCKERS

With a home run on Wednesday, the Shuckers tied the Double-A record with 10 home runs through their first 5 games... The Shuckers are the 9th team in the Digital Stats Era (since 2005) to reach the mark and the 3rd since 2018.

- The Shuckers 8 home runs during the Opening Series are tied for the 5th-most in a Double-A Opening Series since 2005.

I'M JUST A KID AND I MAKE PITCHER'S LIVES A NIGHTMARE

Over the last 6 games **SS/2B JESUS MADE** is 12-for-25 with a home run, a double, 2 triples, 5 walks and 7 balls in play at 100+ MPH.

- Made enters today among the Southern League leaders in hits (1st, 13), triples (T-1st, 2), extra-base hits (T-3rd, 4), average (7th, .361) and OPS (7th, 1.022).

A RUTHIAN START

1B BLAKE BURKE enters today as the Double-A home run leader, with 6 across his first 8 games of the season... 10 of 30 Double-A teams have recorded fewer than 6 home runs this season.

- Since his Southern League debut on August 2, 2025, Burke leads Minor League Baseball with 17 home runs and is 1 of 2 players with at least 15 over that span.
- On Thursday, Burke became the 1st Double-A player in the Digital Stats Era to record 6 home runs in a team's first 6 games.

RUNS? WHAT ARE THOSE?

RHP TANNER GILLIS tied his career-high with 5.0 shutout innings in relief on Friday... Gillis retired 14 consecutive batters to begin the outing and 15 of 16 batters faced.

- Gillis has recorded 7.1 consecutive scoreless innings dating back to April 4, 2026, the longest streak by a Shucker pitcher this season.
- Gillis tied the longest shutout relief outing in franchise history (since 2015)... He became the first to reach the mark since **RHP CHRISTIAN MEJIAS** in 2023.

MR. CONSISTENCY

2B/OF DYLAN O'RAE (9-for-26) enters today as 1 of 4 Southern League players who have recorded a hit in at least 7 consecutive games to begin the season.

- The 7-game streak ties O' Rae's longest hit streak at the Double-A level and the 2nd-longest of his career... His career-long streak is 9 consecutive games between July 3-18, 2023, with the ACL Brewers.

MADE FOR THE BIG STAGE

SS/2B JESUS MADE enters the 2026 season as the top-ranked Brewers prospect and the 4th-ranked overall prospect by *Baseball America*.

- Made will become baseball's top prospect once Konnor Griffin (26 AB), Kevin McGonigle (55 AB) and JJ Wetherholt (52 AB) all reach 130 AB.

BACK IN THE SADDLE

MANAGER MIKE GUERRERO returns to the Shuckers dugout for 2026 after 2 seasons as a Roving Infield Instructor with the Brewers organization.

- After reaching 1,400 career wins during the 2023 season, Guerrero needs 50 wins to reach 1,500... His 1,450 wins are the sixth-most among active managers in Minor League Baseball.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

RHP JARON DEBERRY (1-0, 0.00) makes his 2nd start of the series and 2nd start of this week's series... In the home opener on Tuesday, DeBerry struck out 7 and allowed 1 hit over 5.0 shutout innings... DeBerry limited right-handed batters to 1 hit (1-for-10) with 4 strikeouts.
