TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels face the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, in Game 1 of the Southwest Division Series at The Diamond, a best-of-three series. Game 2 will be played on Thursday night at UPMC Park in Erie and Game 3 will follow on Friday if necessary.

RUN IT BACK: After facing off in last year's Southwest Division Series, the Flying Squirrels and SeaWolves meet again to open this year's Eastern League postseason. Last year, Erie took Game 1, 9-3, in Erie and won Game 2, 6-2, at The Diamond before falling in the Eastern League Championship Series against the Somerset Patriots. The two teams also met for the final series of the regular season last week at UPMC Park, with Richmond winning four-of-six. Erie won the Southwest Division's first-half title to clinch their playoff spot. Richmond won the division's second half, clinching with a victory on Thursday in Erie. This year marks the Flying Squirrels' fourth postseason appearance (2011, 2014, 2022 and 2023).

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS went 46-29 in their final 76 games, the best record in the league during that span. They started their season turnaround on June 18, heading into the final week of the season's first half, going 14-2 over a 16-game stretch through July 6, and never fell below second place in the second half. After briefly falling into a tie for second place in late-August during their trip to Portland, the Flying Squirrels moved into a tie for first with a 5-4, extra-innings win on August 6 against the RubberDucks and were in sole possession of first beginning with a 13-7 win over Akron on September 8. They clinched a postseason berth and the second-half division title with a 7-3 win on Thursday at Erie. The Flying Squirrels spent 57 percent (79 games) of the season in first place in the division. Richmond's 74 wins this year were the third-most in franchise history and their .536 winning percentage was the second-best, trailing only 2014 (79-63, .556). In their final 17 regular-season games dating back to August 30, the Flying Squirrels posted a league-best 13-4 record. Offensively, the Flying Squirrels set franchise records this year for runs scored (658), RBIs (604), walks (552), games scoring 10+ runs (16) and stolen base percentage (81%).

THE SEAWOLVES won the Southwest Division's first half to reach the postseason for the second straight year. The Erie offense led the Eastern League in hits (1,129) and ranked second in the league in batting average (.247), total bases (1,897), homers (171), RBIs (669), OBP (.337), SLG (.415) and OPS (.752). Erie starting pitchers posted the lowest ERA (3.64) in the league. The SeaWolves dropped five-of-their-last-seven games to close the regular season. Erie's roster includes six of Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Jackson Jobe (No. 3, No. 53 overall), 2B Jace Jung (No. 4, No. 98 overall), RHP Ty Madden (No. 5), RHP Wilmer Flores (No. 8), SS Danny Serretti (No. 16) and LHP Brant Hurter (No. 18). MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects list includes six Erie players, including Jobe (No. 3, No. 54 overall), Jung (No. 4, No. 67 overall), Madden (No. 6), Flores (No. 7), Hurter (No. 12), Serretti (No. 25) and RHP Tyler Mattison (No. 28).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Carson Seymour** takes the mound in Game 1. This season, he ranked eighth in the Eastern League in ERA (3.99), fourth in BAA (.231) and fourth in WHIP (1.23). He also posted the second-lowest HR/9 (0.64) and the second-highest groundball percentage (49.5) in the league. After posting 5.4 K/9 in his 14 first-half appearances, he posted 12.5 K/9 in his 14 second-half outings. Seymour last pitched last Tuesday in Erie and allowed one run over five innings to pick up a win. Seymour was Richmond's Opening Day starter in April and was named the team's Pitcher of the Year. Tonight marks the second postseason start of his professional career. Last year, he took the ball for Game 1 of the Northwest League Championship Series and picked up a win, allowing two runs over 5.2 innings, as the Emeralds went on to win the league title. A native of Poway, Calif., Seymour was selected by the New York Mets in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Kansas State University. He was traded to the Giants on August 2, 2022 as part of the deal that sent Darin Ruf to the Mets. Seymour is rated by Baseball America as the No. 16 Giants prospect and No. 23 by MLB.com. *For more on Seymour, see page two.*

FOR ERIE: Left-hander Brant Hurter makes the second postseason appearance of his professional career. He pitched out of the bullpen in Game 1 of the 2022 Eastern League Championship Series for the SeaWolves and allowed three runs over 1.2 innings. Hurter last pitched last Tuesday against the Flying Squirrels at UPMC Park and threw perfect innings. He did not allow an earned run in his final four starts of the regular season, spanning 18.0 innings since August 25. In his final six starts of the regular season, Hurter went 1-0 with a 0.67 ERA (2 ER/27.0 IP). This year, Hurter led the Eastern League in ERA (3.28) and had the fifth-most strikeouts (133). Hurter played at Georgia Tech, where he was teammates with former Flying Squirrels catcher **Joey Bart** for one season in 2018. He was selected by the Detroit Tigers in the seventh round of the 2021 MLB Draft. He first reached Double-A at the end of his professional debut season in 2022, making four appearances for the SeaWolves. Dating back to last season, Hurter has a 1.90 ERA (5 ER/23.2 IP) in five starts against Richmond. Hurter is ranked by Baseball America as the No. 18 Tigers prospect and No. 12 by MLB.com.

STRONG ARMS: The Flying Squirrels' 3.99 ERA was third-best in the league this season. Richmond relievers led Double-A with 679.0 innings pitched and ranked fourth at the level with a 3.82 ERA. The Richmond pitching staff recorded 1,336 strikeouts this year, fourth-most in the league and second-most in a season in franchise history. Opposing batters hit .236, which was a new franchise record.

POWER SURGE: The Flying Squirrels hit 140 homers this season, which is the second-most in a season in team history. The team hit 39 homers in their last 23 regular-season games dating back to August 22, which was tied for the second-most in the minors during that time frame, trailing only Triple-A Sacramento (41). **Victor Bericoto** had eight homers in that stretch, which was tied for the most in the league. On August 31 in Hartford, Richmond hitters combined for eight home runs, which set a new single-game franchise record. It was also tied for the most homers by a team in a single game in the minors this year (Sugar Land at Albuquerque - May 7) and the most homers in an Eastern League game since 2006. In last week's series against the RubberDucks at The Diamond, they homered nine times. Richmond has six homers in the first five games of this week's series.

COMING UP CLUTCH: Of the Flying Squirrels' last 18 wins, they scored the winning run in the seventh inning or later in 12 of them. That span includes a walk-off single by **Victor Bericoto** on August 17 to beat Harrisburg in the largest ninth-inning comeback win in franchise history. On August 27 in the second game of a doubleheader at Hadlock Field, the Flying Squirrels rallied after trailing, 8-6, down to their final out in the seventh before **Brady Whalen** and Bericoto hit back-to-back homers to tie the game and **Logan Wyatt** hit a two-run, pinch-hit homer for a 10-8 win. Last Wednesday at Erie, Bericoto hit a two-run, go-ahead double in the eighth in a 6-3 win. The Flying Squirrels had 32 come-from-behind wins this season.

BIG HITS BY BERICOTO: **Victor Bericoto** continued his recent surge with a go-ahead homer on Thursday night at Erie. It was his 11th home run with Richmond. He led the Giants organization with 27 homers and 86 RBIs this season. In his last 20 games dating back to August 24, Bericoto hit .289 (22-for-76) with eight homers, six doubles and 19 RBIs. He hit a walk-off single on August 17 to beat the Senators and belted a game-tying homer in Portland in a comeback win on August 27. In last week's series at Erie, he hit .333 (6-for-18) with two homers, two doubles and four RBIs. He also landed on ESPN's SportsCenter Top-10 Plays with a diving catch in right field last Wednesday.

WHALEN'S WARMING UP: In his last 17 games dating back to August 27, **Brady Whalen** hit .328 (22-for-67) with three homers, five doubles and 13 RBIs, raising his season batting average from .203 to .259. He had an 11-game hit streak from Sept. 1-14, one game shy of matching the longest by a Richmond hitter in 2023.

LONGBALL LOGAN: **Logan Wyatt** hit .343 (23-for-67) over his final 20 regular-season games dating back to August 19 with five homers, four doubles and 15 RBIs, including late, go-ahead homers on August 27 at Portland and August 30. He hit 17 homers this season between Eugene and Richmond, a new career high and tied for fourth in the Giants organization.

GLow SHOW: **Jimmy Glowne** hit .324 (23-for-71) with three homers, three doubles, 10 walks and eight RBIs in his last 23 games dating back to August 23. He started the hot stretch on August 23 at Portland, when he hit a two-run homer and picked up two RBI singles, matching his season high with four RBIs for the game. On the year, Glowne hit .323 (42-for-130) in road games, including all seven of his Double-A homers, compared to .171 (20-for-117) at The Diamond.

ALL ABOARD THE SHANE TRAIN: During his time with Richmond dating back to June 13, **Shane Matheny** led the team in RBIs (43), OPS (.793), hits (63), doubles (16), walks (51), extra-base hits (29), total bases (116) and runs scored (44), was tied for first in homers (11) and triples (2), ranked second in OBP (.359) and second in SLG (.434). He also led the league in walks (51) dating back to his assignment to Richmond. His 89 walks this year between Richmond and Sacramento were the most by a Giants minor leaguer since **Brandon Belt** had 93 in 2010. Matheny is now second in Richmond franchise history with 142 career walks and tied for fourth with 27 career home runs.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have seven players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP **Carson Whisenhant** (No. 5 - on IL), OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 7 - on IL), RHP **Hayden Birdsong** (No. 12), RHP **Carson Seymour** (No. 16), RHP **Landen Roupp** (No. 17 - on IL), RHP **Ryan Murphy** (No. 28) and RHP **William Kempner** (No. 30). Baseball America rates Brown as the organization's best hitter for average and best athlete, rates Roupp as having the best curveball and **Jose Cruz** as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes five Richmond players, including Whisenhant (No. 3), Birdsong (No. 10), Brown (No. 13), Roupp (No. 15) and Seymour (No. 23).

POSTSEASON EXPERIENCE: Of the 28 players on Richmond's roster, 24 have previous professional playoff experience. Seven players who saw action in last year's Division Series against the SeaWolves are back for this year's rematch, including **Brandon Martorano**, **Carter Aldrete**, **Shane Matheny**, **Will Wilson**, **Evan Gates**, **Wil Jensen** and **Blake Rivera**. Thirteen players have won a championship in past spots. Martorano, **Ryan Murphy**, **Sean Roby** and **Ismael Munguia** were part of Eugene's Northwest League title in 2021 and **Tyler Myrick**, **Carson Seymour**, **Nick Zwack**, **Andy Thomas**, **Hayden Cantrelle** and **Jimmy Glowne** won a championship with the Emeralds in 2022. Glowne was also on the 2021 San Jose team that won the California League. **John Michael Bertrand**, **Hayden Birdsong** and **William Kempner** were part of the 2022 ACL Giants Black's title run. Murphy, Kempner, **Jose Cruz**, **Ben Madison**, **Logan Wyatt** and **Victor Bericoto** played in the California League playoff with San Jose last year. Madison, Martorano, Aldrete and Matheny played in the 2019 Northwest League postseason with Salem-Keizer and Rivera, Roby and Wyatt saw action in the South Atlantic League playoff with Augusta that year. Munguia (2017) and Bericoto (2019) also played in the Arizona League postseason. **Sam Delaplaine**, who pitched in the 2019 Texas League playoffs with Double-A Arkansas, is the only player with postseason experience outside of the Giants organization. **Spencer Bivens**, **Hunter Dula**, **Mat Olsan** and **Brady Whalen** are making the first postseason appearances of their careers.
