WALKING IT OFF: OF Tristen Lutz smashed a 111 MPH line drive to center that completed Biloxi's 8-7 comeback win over the Chattanooga Lookouts on Tuesday night... The walk-off was Biloxi's first since May 26, 2023 against the Montgomery Biscuits, when OF Jackson Chourio launched a three-run walk-off home run in the 10th inning... In 2023, the Shuckers have had four walk-off wins.

ROCKETING UP THE CHARTS: INF Tyler Black tallied his 38th stolen base on Tuesday night in the series opener against Chattanooga... He enters today with the second-most stolen bases by a Shuckers player in a single season, 15 away from breaking OF Johnny Davis' franchise record of 52, set during the 2017 season.

ONE OF A KIND: INF Tyler Black also smashed his ninth home run of the year, tying OF Jackson Chourio and C Jeferson Quero for the team lead... Entering today, Black is one of two players in Minor League Baseball with at least nine home runs and 30 stolen bases... Mariners' OF Jonatan Clase is the only other player to accomplish the feat, doing so between High-A Everett and Double-A Arkansas... Black is the only players in MiLB to accomplish the feat while playing the entire year at Double-A or Triple-A.

PLAYOFFS? WE'RE TALKING ABOUT PLAYOFFS: Entering today, the Shuckers sit 5.5 games behind the Pensacola Blue Wahoos for first place in the Southern League South Division with five games remaining in the first half... Due to Pensacola's rain out on Tuesday, the Shuckers are still alive in the first half race... After the 69th game of the year, the division leaders in the North and South Division will both clinch playoff spots, securing half of the spots in the 2023 Southern League Playoffs... For Biloxi to win the South Division first half title, they would need to win their five remaining games, and Pensacola would need to lose their six remaining games.

GRAND THEFT BASES: After a stolen base on Tuesday, the Shuckers now have 121 stolen bases this season, the most in the Southern League and the second-most in Double-A... The Shuckers are one of four teams, along with the Portland Sea Dogs (129, BOS), Somerset Patriots (118, NYY) and the Arkansas Travelers (115, SEA) to swipe at least 100 in 2023... Biloxi is currently on pace for 261 stolen bases, three shy of the Birmingham Barons' Southern League record of 264, set in 1989.
