Walking in a Winter Wonderland

Andrew Thurman mowed down the Frisco RoughRiders (15-11) order to total a career-high 10 strikeouts, and Jake Cunningham blasted a two-run homer and added on an RBI double to help lead the San Antonio Missions (12-14) past the RoughRiders in a 4-3 win.

Turning Back Time

Andrew Thurman retired 13 in a row to end his outing last night and set a career-high with 10 strikeouts. His previous career-high was 9 strikeouts on May 14, 2016 against Pensacola while with the Mississippi Braves. He's the first Missions pitcher to strike out 10 in a game this year.

Sealed the Deal

Josh Mallitz matched a season-high by completing the final 3 innings of last night's game and securing his 4th save of the year. Through June and July, Mallitz is 3-0 with a 2.42 ERA in 15 games across 26 innings with 6 walks and 32 strikeouts.

Much Needed Jolt

Jake Cunningham delivered a two-run homer and a game-tying double last night. His homer ended a 20 inning scoreless streak for the Missions. Since joining the Missions, Cunningham is hitting .289 with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 3 homers and 17 RBIs in 25 games.

Add Another

Ethan Salas recorded his team-best 23rd multi-hit game last night. The 20-year-old is 5-13 this week with a double, 3 walks and an RBI.

Shimmering Defense

San Antonio leads the Texas League in fielding percentage (.983) and they have the fewest errors (58). In Double-A, they are 4th in fielding percentage with the 5th fewest errors.

Velo Has Returned

After two more shutout innings Thursday, Francis Peña has allowed just two runs in his last 172 IP (1.02 ERA) with 18 strikeouts in his last 11 games. He hit 99mph for the first time all year on Thursday.

That'll Play

Igor Gil dazzled in his Double-A debut on Wednesday, striking out 5 in 2 shutout innings while walking just 1. Gil got called up to San Antonio on Tuesday.

Getting it Done

Tucker Musgrove tossed two perfect innings with 5 strikeouts on Wednesday. The No. 8 prospect in the San Diego Padres' system now has 13 strikeouts in his last 5.2 innings.

The Turning Point

After starting 6-20, the Missions are 37-32 since May 3.

A Definite Improvement

San Antonio's 397 runs are the 2nd-fewest in Double-A, and their 74 home runs are the 2nd-fewest as well. However, over the last 69 games (May 3), they have scored 310 runs (4.5 R/G) and hit 58 home runs. They are 37-32 in that stretch.

700 Left

The Missions have stranded 700 runners on base, the 3rd-most in Double-A, and their .207 AVG with RISP is the worst at the level. Last night, the Missions went 2-7 with RISP and left 5.

Back For More

23-year-old Eric Yost starts for San Antonio. Yost is 4-2 with a 3.94 ERA in 16 games (11 starts) with 43 walks and 63 strikeouts in 64 innings. Yost pitched on Tuesday, allowing 2 runs on 4 hits while walking 1 and striking out 5. Yost made 1 start at Triple-A El Paso on July 4, allowing 5 runs on 7 hits with 3 walks and 3 strikeouts in 3.1 innings. Last year, Yost went 4-7 with a 2.89 ERA in 17 starts at High-A Fort Wayne before getting called up to San Antonio after the trade deadline. He went 1-4 with a 5.79 in 8 starts with 27 walks and 26 strikeouts in 37.1 innings once with the Missions. The San Diego Padres drafted Yost in the 17th round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Northeastern. Yost made his Double-A debut in Frisco last year on August 2 and allowed 1 run on 2 hits with 2 walks and 5 strikeouts in 6.1 innings. He is 1-1 with a 5.19 ERA in 3 starts against them, walking 9 and striking out 15 in 17.1 innings.

Waltzing Matilda

The 25-year-old Australian, Blake Townsend, is on the mound for Frisco. He is 3-4 with a 5.35 ERA in 15 games (13 starts) with 30 walks and 60 strikeouts in 67.1 innings. Last Sunday, Townsend allowed 3 runs on 3 hits with 2 walks and 4 strikeouts in 4 innings. Last season, Townsend was terrific in the Pittsburgh Pirates organization, going 8-4 with a 1.76 ERA in 34 games (12 starts) with 23 walks and 81 strikeouts in 92.0 innings across 3 levels, primarily Double-A Altoona. Townsend originally signed with the Seattle Mariners in 2019 out of Australia. The lefty pitched 2 scoreless innings for Team Australia in the 2026 World Baseball Classic. On May 20, Townsend allowed 1 run on 4 hits with 0 walks and 4 strikeouts in 6 innings against San Antonio and on June 10 in San Antonio, he tossed 6 shutout innings with 3 hits, 0 walks and 6 strikeouts.

San Antonio Missions Coaches

Manager - Chris Tremie

Chris Tremie begins his first season in the San Diego Padres organization and as manager of the San Antonio Missions. He spent 13 seasons as a manager in the Cleveland Guardians organization and the last seven seasons as the minor league field coordinator for the Cincinnati Reds.

“Fans should expect to come out and see a team that’s going to compete on a daily basis,” Tremie said. “It will be a good brand of baseball. We’re going to play the game the right way.”

Tremie debuted as a catcher for the Chicago White Sox in 1995. He later played for the Texas Rangers, Pittsburgh Pirates and Houston Astros across a total of 22 Major League Baseball games. Tremie retired in 2005 as a member of the Round Rock Express, the Astros’ Triple-A affiliate at the time, and began his managing career in 2006 with the Cleveland organization. His time with Cleveland included two years of managing Double-A Akron and six years leading Triple-A Columbus.

The Houston native attended the University of Houston, where he helped lead the Cougars to two 40-win seasons before being drafted by the White Sox in the 39th round of the 1992 MLB Draft. As a minor leaguer in the White Sox organization, Tremie played with NBA legend Michael Jordan on the Double-A Birmingham Barons as Jordan attempted to play professional baseball.

Hitting Coach Eric Del Prado

Eric Del Prado returns for his second season as hitting coach in San Antonio. He previously worked as a hitting coach at the Arizona Complex League (ACL) in 2023 before taking on the hitting coach role with Single-A Lake Elsinore during the 2024 season.

A native of El Segundo, California, Del Prado attended Willamette University and coached for four years at Lewis & Clark College in Oregon.

Pitching Coach Erick Abreu

Erick Abreu, a native of Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic, pitched for nine years in the minor leagues with the New York Yankees and Houston Astros, even making a stop with the Texas League’s Corpus Christi Hooks. Abreu then became a pitching coach in the Astros’ system for nine seasons, spending time in six different levels.

Over the last two seasons, Abreu served as the major league bullpen coach for the Atlanta Braves.

Bench Coach Brian Burres

Brian Burres brings recent leadership acumen from within the Padres organization, working as the manager for Single-A Lake Elsinore in 2025, as a pitching coach at the Arizona Complex League in 2024 and as an assistant coach with High-A Fort Wayne in 2023.

Burres also boasts the most extensive major league playing career on the staff, pitching in over 100 games for the Baltimore Orioles, Toronto Blue Jays and Pittsburgh Pirates across six big-league seasons.

Strength Coach Chandler Craig

Chandler Craig continues for a second season with the Missions after two seasons as strength and conditioning coach with High-A Fort Wayne. This will be his fourth season in the Padres organization.

Craig previously spent two seasons with the Red Sox organization, including time with Single-A Salem. Craig is a native of Lubbock, Texas and graduated from Texas Tech University.

Athletic Trainer Juan Peña

Juan Peña embarks on his second season with the Missions and second with the Padres organization. In 2024, Peña won one of only 14 Minor League Baseball Athletic Trainer of the Year awards for his work with Single-A Lake Elsinore.

Peña worked in the Detroit Tigers organization from 2018-2023, with most of his time spent at the Florida Complex League. He is from Lakeland, Florida, and graduated from East Central University.
