The Loons hit six home runs, including two each by Ryan Ward and Andy Pages. Zac Ching and Ryan January also went deep for Great Lakes. All of the Loons' homers came against lefty reliever Zach Draper. Bobby Bradley and Harold Ramírez each went 0-for-2 in Major League Rehab appearances.

PRESSURE PACKED: The Captains have held at least a share of first place in the High-A Central League East Division since their win over West Michigan on August 15. Since then, every game the Captains have played has been against a team within 1.0 game of them for the division lead. Lake County was either tied for first place with Dayton or 1.0 game ahead of the Dragons throughout their series last week. The Captains are now tied with Great Lakes for first.

TOP OF THE HEAP: When the Captains reached first place in the High-A Central League East Division on August 15, it was their first time atop the division since May 26. That date is also the last time the Captains held a share of a playoff position, but that was before Major League Baseball's July 1 announcement that there would be postseason baseball in the minors this season.

PLAYOFF PICTURE: The Captains enter today 1.5 game behind the Cedar Rapids Kemels for the second playoff spot in the High-A Central League (HAC). Lake County, Cedar Rapids, the Dayton Dragons and the Great Lakes Loons are all separated by just 3.5 games. The Quad Cities River Bandits currently hold the top playoff spot and are 10.5 games ahead of second place. The top two teams in the HAC earn playoff bids (regardless of division).

ARCH NEMESIS: The Great Lakes Loons are the only team against whom the Captains have a losing record this season (7-12). Lake County also has its worst run differential (-61), ERA (6.94) and opponent's OPS (.941) against Great Lakes.

NO TRAFFIC: In the month of August, the Captains' pitching staff owns the league's second-lowest WHIP (1.16), has allowed the second-fewest hits (135) and has the second-lowest batting average against (.215). Their hit total and WHIP are both the third-lowest in all of High-A, while their batting average against is fourth-lowest.

SIT 'EM DOWN: The Captains' starting staff is enjoying its best strikeout month of the season. Lake County starters are averaging a season-high 11.3 K/9 in August (117 K, 93.0 IP). Their 3.65 K/BB rate is also a season-best (32 BB). Four of the Captains' six 10-strikeout games have come in August. The other two were on July 24 and 30.

WALK THIS WAY: The Captains' offense enters today tied with Great Lakes for the most walks in August (84). Lake County has not finished a month above fourth in the league in that category this year.

HOME COOKIN' TASTES BETTER: The Captains have a better record at home (26-17) compared to on the road (25-28). ake County's run differential, however, is better on the road (even) compared to at home (-20).

NEW BLOOD: 3B Jhonkensy Noel joined the Captains on August 17. The 20-year old led all of Low-A (minimum 160 PA) with a .393 batting average and a 190 wRC+, while hitting 11 homers. INF Christian Cairo and OF Jonathan Rodríguez joined the Captains on August 24. Cairo led Low-A Lynchburg with 37 walks and held a .364 on-base percentage, which led all Hillcats (minimum 200 PA). Rodríguez slashed .314/.363/.450 with the Hillcats, good for an .812 OPS

BIG LEAGUE REHAB: 1B Bobby Bradley will make a Major League Rehab appearance with the Captains tonight for the second night in a row. Bradley spent 2015 with the Captains when he hit 27 home runs and collected a .875 OPS. He is in his second season at the major league level. Across 46 MLB games this season he has 11 home runs and a .796 OPS.

HIGH-A: The 2021 season marks the Captains' first as the High-A Affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. Lake County had been Cleveland's Low-A Affiliate for 17 seasons (2003-2019) and 18 years (2003-2020).

LAST TIME OUT: In Burns' third start back from the Injured List, the right-hander worked 4.0 innings (64 pitches) and allowed two runs on six hits. Burns stranded a runner on third base in the first, but gave up a leadoff homer in the second to Victor Ruiz and allowed another homer on a sacrifice fly later in the inning. Burns did not allow another run and escaped a bases-loaded, one-out jam in the fourth to end his night. Burns exited with the Captains down, 2-1. Lake County later tied the score on a seventy-inning single by Julian Escobedo, but lost on a walk-off single by James Free in the ninth

COLLEGE ACCOLADES: After a solid freshman campaign, Burns broke through in 2019 and was named a third team All-American by *Perfect Game*. Prior to the 2020 season Burns was Named Preseason All-SEC, Preseason All-America by *Baseball America*, *Collegiate Baseball*, *D1 Baseball* and *Perfect Game*. In just four games in 2020 Burns was off to a hot start striking out 12.9 per nine innings and had a 3-1 record with a 2.42 ERA.

TEAM USA: In 2018, Burns was selected to the USA Collegiate National Team. Burns appeared in four games allowing five runs over 7.2 innings. He allowed nine hits, struck out six and walked one. Also on the team were back to back first overall draft picks Adley Rutschman (2019) and Spencer Torkelson (2020).

2020 DRAFT: Cleveland selected Burns in the CBA round (36th overall) of the 2020 draft, which was shortened to five rounds. Burns was Cleveland's second selection in the draft, following SS Carson Tucker (1st Round – 23rd overall).

PREVIOUSLY DRAFTED: Originally drafted by the New York Yankees in the 37th round of the 2017 draft out of Decatur High School (Decatur, AL).

MR. ALABAMA: Burns was named Mr. Alabama his senior season of high school. Along with being one of the top pitchers in the state he hit .467 with 16 homers, 10 doubles, four triples and 46 RBI as a senior in High School.

RECRUITING BATTLE: A highly sought after recruit in Alabama, Burns originally committed to the University of Alabama but decided to weigh other options when Crimson Tide Head Coach Mitch Gaspard resigned in 2016, eventually committing to Auburn. Burns grew up an Alabama fan and only committed to the Tide's arch-rival Auburn due to Head Coach Butch Thompson's experience developing pitchers. He says he took a lot of heat for committing to Auburn from friends he grew up with.

STAR MENTORS: While at Auburn, Burns had a variety of people with great track records to learn from. Auburn Head Coach Butch Thompson has had 16 of his former pitchers make the big leagues including 10 since 2014. He previously worked as the Associate Head Coach and Pitching Coach at Mississippi State. Among the stars coached by Thompson is 2018 number one overall pick Casey Mize. Burns worked closely with Mize at Auburn, and was throwing partners with Mize during his freshman year of 2018. He took over the premier role in the rotation from Mize, operating as the teams Friday night starter in 2019 and 2020. Tim Hudson joined Thompson's staff in 2020 as a volunteer assistant and pitching coach, also getting the chance to mold Burns' game. The former Auburn great and 17 year MLB veteran worked with Burns for a short time in 2020 before the season was shortened but Burns says the two will have a relationship for the rest of his life.

FUTURE DEVELOPMENT: Kevin Goldstein of *FanGraphs* says Burns brings "big stuff out of a small package" with good secondary pitches to go with solid velocity (sits 93-94) on his fastball. Eric Longenhagen, also of *FanGraphs*, describes Burns as "an org based bet." Longenhagen sees Burns as someone who's future value mostly revolves around Cleveland's recent ability to develop pitchers. "I've always been a little lower on him due to his middling velocity and projectionless frame, but he executes his secondary stuff very consistently" Longenhagen said. *Baseball America* sites Burns offspeed pitches as potential plus pitches, especially his curveball and slider. Burns earns praise for his dedication, makeup and desire to learn.

CAPTAINS BATTING NOTES
