LAST NIGHT: The Amarillo Sod Poodles (26-23, 62-55) defeated the Tulsa Drillers (29-20, 75-43), 5-0, on Friday night at ONEOK Field. In the top of the first, **Cristofer Torin** singled and scored on **Jansel Luis'** two-run home run to center field. In Amarillo's next turn to bat, a **Drew Jones** leadoff single and stolen base set him up to score easily as **Angel Ortiz** doubled with one away. In the top of the fifth, The top four batters in the Amarillo lineup each rattled off hits to score one and load the bases, where the Drillers traded a run for two outs on an **Alberto Barriga** grounder to put the Sodpodes up 5-0. That was plenty of run support for **Junior Sanchez**, **Dawson Brown**, and **Antonio Menendez**, who combined to complete Amarillo's fifth shutout victory of the season and held the Drillers hitless over the final 22 outs of the game.

AOA-OK: In yet another multi-hit effort, **Avery Owusu-Asiedu** extended his hit streak to 10 games tonight...since joining the Sod Poodles on August 11, he is batting .475 (19x40) with 11 runs scored, three doubles, one triple, six home runs, 16 RBI and a 1.601 OPS...since August 11, he leads Double-A baseball in hits (19) and is tied for first in RBI (16)...between Amarillo and High-A Hillsboro, he has now hit safely 17 straight contests between the two levels (8/1-c)...over his most recent 26 games (7/22-c) between Amarillo and High-A Hillsboro, he is batting .398 (39x98) with 11 home runs, 28 RBI, and a 1.257 OPS...in that same timeframe, he ranks tied for 2nd across MiLB in home runs (11), tied for 2nd in total bases (77), tied for 4th in hits, and 6th in OPS (min. 70 PA).

THE SANCHIZE: **Junior Sanchez** matched a career high at the Double-A level by striking out nine Drillers over 5.2 shutout innings on Friday, the most strikeouts by a Sodpodes starter in a scoreless outing this year...the Sodpodes had not seen a start of 5.2+ innings pitched, 0 runs, and 9+ strikeouts since Roman Angelo on May 25, 2025 at Corpus Christi...Sanchez lowered his ERA in seven road starts to 1.69, which now ranks second in the Texas League (min. 7 GS).

DRILL SERGEANTS: **Junior Sanchez**, **Dawson Brown**, and **Antonio Menendez** combined to hold Tulsa hitless from the third inning on last night...it was the first time a Sodpodes opponent went hitless over the final 7.0 innings of a game in 2026.

LUIS YOURSELF: Continuing to put together a strong month at the plate for the Sodpodes on Friday was **Jansel Luis**...the infielder is batting .299 (23x77) with 14 runs, nine XBH, 14 RBI, and a .835 OPS in 17 August games...he has hit safely in nine of his most recent 11 games (8/8-c) and is tied for third in the Texas League in runs for the month...Arizona's 10th-ranked prospect has collected the 4th-most hits (116) in the Texas League this season and is pacing for 135 knocks by season's end, which would rank tied for the fourth-most in a season in Sodpodes history alongside Ivan Castillo's 2019 campaign.

FOREVER YOUNGBLOOD: After leading off the top of the fifth with a double and scoring a run in the Sodpodes three-run frame, **Trent Youngblood** is batting .292 (14x48) with an .891 OPS over his most recent 12 games (8/8-c)...in August, he is tied for third in the Texas League in runs (14).

ROAD TRIPPIN': In 2026, Amarillo pitching ranks first in the Texas League in road ERA (3.92) and second in strikeouts (587) on the year...the starting rotation is posting a 3.38 ERA in away games this season, which currently stands as the best mark by any rotation on the road in Sodpodes history.

DOWN IN THE DESERT: D-backs 2025 5th round draft pick Nathan Hall has homered in two of his first three professional games after launching a solo shot in the eighth inning of Single-A Visalia's 9-2 loss on Friday.

SUMMARY

- Currently ranks No. 20 in Arizona's top-30 prospects list (MLB Pipeline).
- Made his professional debut with High-A Hillsboro as the Hops starting pitcher on April 3 of this year.
- Selected in the D-backs in the 3rd round (92nd overall) of the 2025 MLB Draft out of the University of Georgia...agreed to a \$700,000 signing bonus.
- Was taken in the 16th round (474th overall) of the 2024 MLB Draft by the Pittsburgh Pirates, but did not sign.

LAST TIME OUT

- Amarillo immediately found themselves facing a deficit as Casey Yamauchi belted the first pitch of the game from Curley over the left field fence for a solo homer in the opening frame...after a pair of RockHounds reached base via walks in the second, Yamauchi struck again with a three-run blast to extend the visitor's advantage to four.
- Midland added insult to injury in the third...a pair of two-run home runs from Clark Elliott and Justin Riemer put four more runs on the board...the four home runs allowed was the most in one game this season.
- A walk issued to Devin Taylor chased Curley from the game...reliever Roman Angelo could not prevent him from scoring as a pair of walks led to a two-run single off the bat of Nate Nankil, resulting in Curley being charged with nine earned runs on the afternoon in his worst start with the Sod Poodles.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- Earned his first Double-A win on July 30 vs. San Antonio after allowing three runs across 5.0 innings pitched in Amarillo's 6-4 victory.
- Tossed a gem in his professional debut on April 3, blanking the Eugene Emeralds over four full frames while striking out eight...Curley would punch eight tickets in three more games to match his career-high before he struck out nine batters on July 8.
- Did not walk a batter until his fifth appearance of the season...had racked up 24 strikeouts in his first four games.
- Earned his first win after blanking Everett across 5.0 innings pitched on May 26.
- Logged his first quality start on June 7 at Spokane after finishing six full frames for the first time as a professional...held the Indians scoreless on six hits and a walk as part of his second of three wins in a row...did not allow an earned run from May 26-June 14 as part of the personal three-game win streak.
- Left the Northwest League ranking third in strikeouts (90), sixth in ERA (4.52) and WHIP (1.42), and 10th in BAA (.289).

SIC 'EM

- Transferred to Georgia for his junior season after spending his first two collegiate seasons at VCU.
- Began 2025 as a late-inning option for the Bulldogs before quickly becoming the No. 1 starter in the rotation in mid-March...posted a 4-4 record, two saves, 3.55 ERA (26 ER/66.0 IP) with 27 walks and a team-high 85 strikeouts.
- Limited opponents to a .179 batting average overall...SEC foes batted just .181 against him...led the NCAA in opponents' average against (.158) through conference tournament play.

SCOUTING REPORT

- Sits at 94-97 mph and reaches 100 with his fastball with maintained velocity through longer outings, producing high spin rates and difficult carry.
- Throws three breaking balls: a high-80s cutter, a mid-80s slider with impressive depth, and low-80s curveball with more vertical snap.
- Will only throw from the stretch regardless if there are runners on base or not, citing his belief in consistency and repeatability in his delivery will provide him success at the professional level.

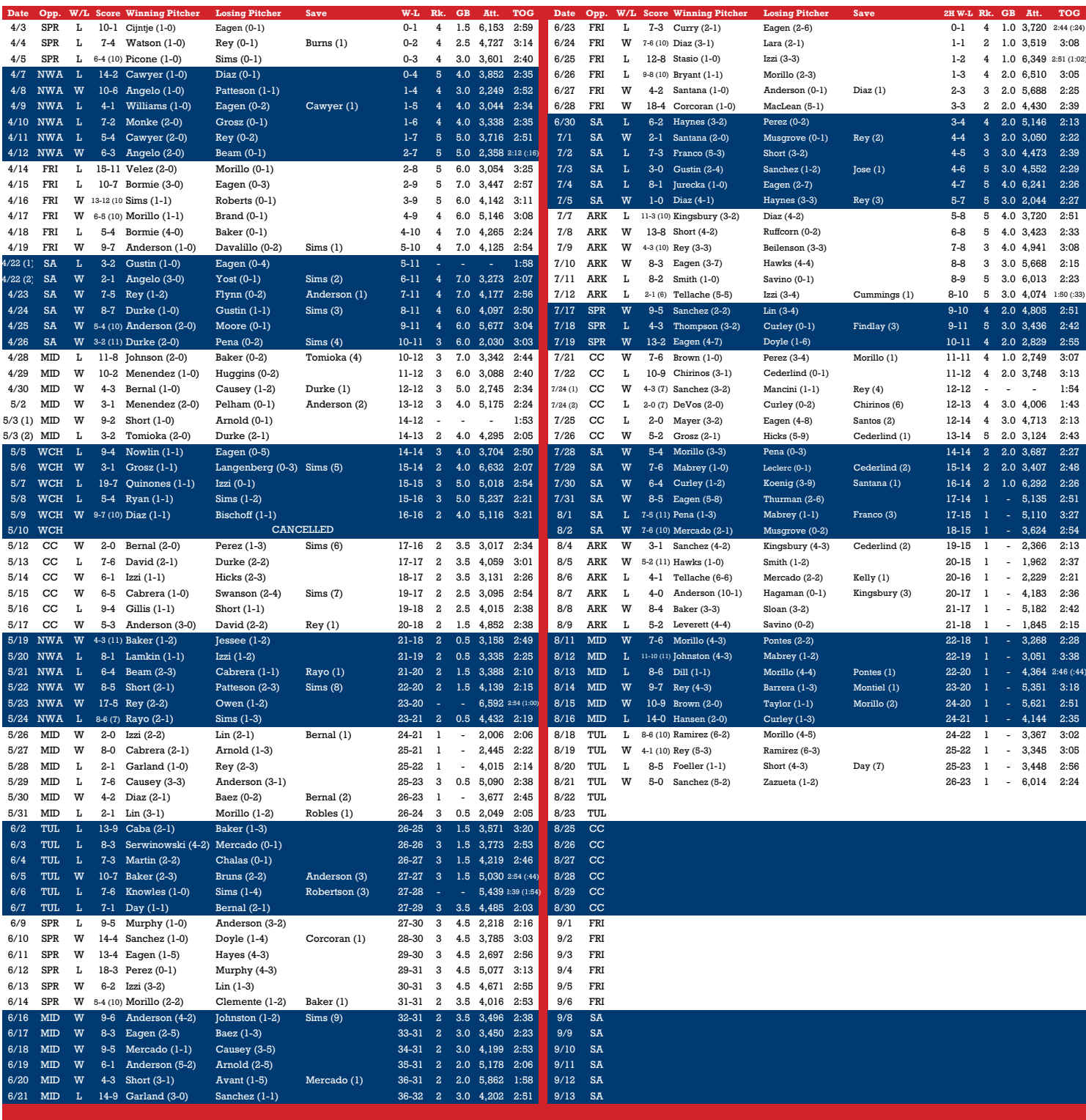
