LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox were held scoreless on Friday night in a 4-0 shutout loss to the Akron RubberDucks. The Baysox went 1-for-11 with runners in scoring position and struck out 11 times as Akron evened the series two games apiece. Starting RHP Brandon Young threw 3.1 innings and struck out three but was charged with the loss after giving up a run on three hits in the fourth. Kyle Brnovich struck out seven across four innings but gave up a three-run homer to Petey Halpin in the seventh.

REVIEWING THE RUBBERDUCKS

Entering this week, the Akron RubberDucks own the best record in the Eastern League at 18-9. The Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians has won 12 of their last 13, including at one point winning 10 in a row. A league-low 2.38 ERA has helped the RubberDucks win their last two series against Altoona and Richmond. Four of the Guardians' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, are on the active roster- IF Kahlil Watson (No. 14), OF Petey Halpin (No. 15), RHP Andrew Walters (No. 25) and IF Dayan Fries (No. 29).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Tommy Mace makes his sixth start of the season and the 15th of his Double-A career. The 25-year-old threw a season-high seven innings in his most recent start against Richmond on May 5. He struck out four batters and allowed just one hit on two runs in a no decision. Mace is fifth in the Eastern League in innings pitched (32.2) and fourth in WHIP (0.95). The second year RubberDuck has gone five or more innings in five of his six appearances this season. Mace debuted in Akron last year and recorded a 5.49 ERA over 60.2 innings pitched. Drafted by the Guardians in the 2nd round of the 2021 Draft, he and Jud Fabian were college teammates at the University of Florida for three seasons.

RELIEVERS STAY READY

After 5.2 innings and eight more strikeouts from Baysox relievers last night, Bowie's bullpen continues to lead the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings thrown (143.2) and strikeouts (184). 15 of the 16 wins accumulated by Baysox pitchers have been credited to the relievers. Opposing hitters are batting just .206 against the Baysox bullpen, which is good for the sixth-lowest average in all of Double-A.

ON-BASE BOWENS

After going 2-for-4 with two doubles last night, 1B **TT Bowens** raised his batting average up to .337, good for second in the Eastern League behind Hartford's Zac Veen (.342). After playing just 47 games last year due to injuries, Bowens is amongst the league leaders in several offensive categories. The 25-year-old is tied for second in RBI (22), is third in slugging percentage (.590), fourth in OPS (.994), and fourth in XBH (13).

THE FABULOUS FABIAN

After a slow start to the season, OF **Jud Fabian** has picked it up since the calendar turned to the month of May. The Orioles No. 12 prospect leads all Eastern League hitters in May with four homers and is tied for second in RBI with nine. Fabian's six homers on the season lead the team and he has now swatted 21 career home runs in 89 Double-A games.

SERVIN' IT UP

IF **Anthony Servideo** has been one of the best hitters in the Eastern League in the month of May. Servideo is first in the league in slugging percentage (.842), third in the league in batting average (.421) and fourth in on-base percentage (.500) in May. After batting .194 in April, the 25-year-old infielder has collected an RBI in four of six games in the month of May.

JOHNSON AND JOHNSON

RHP **Seth Johnson** makes his sixth start of the season and the seventh of his Double-A career. The Orioles No. 10 prospect lasted just 3.1 innings in his most recent start against Erie on May 4. He gave up three runs (two earned) on four hits, walked two and struck out four and received the loss. Johnson is looking to reach the fifth inning for the first time this season. In two home starts, the 25-year-old owns a 2.45 ERA in 7.1 innings. This is Johnson's first career start against Akron.

HOME SWEET HOME

The Baysox are the first team in the Eastern League to have won 12 games at home. They are one of just four teams across all of Double-A to have won at least 12 games at home and have won eight of their last 12 here at Prince George's Stadium. At home this season, the Baysox are first in runs scored (111), first in home runs (25), and second in OPS (.817).

Looking to reach fifth inning for first time this season and at Double-A. Also looking for first Double-A win.** Struck out season-high six batters over four innings of two-run ball on 4/28 @ RIC. Did not allow a run through first three innings before giving up two runs in fourth. First time reaching the fourth inning in three road starts.

2023: Placed on 60-day injured list to begin season by Triple-A Norfolk. Sent on rehab assignment to FCL Orioles on August 19. Made one start before being sent to Single-A Delmarva on August 22. Made one start with Shorebirds, then assigned to High-A Aberdeen on August 29. Made two starts with IronBirds. Struck out five in three shutout innings on Sept. 6 vs Greenville. Assigned to Double-A Bowie on Sept. 13. Struck out four in three innings, allowing two runs (one earned) on three hits and two walks in lone start of season against Harrisburg.

2022: Started season in High-A Bowling Green. Made seven starts and struck out 41 batters over 27 innings to an ERA of 3.00. Placed on injured list in late May with right forearm inflammation before discovering that he suffered a torn UCL and needed Tommy John surgery. Traded from TB to BAL in a three team deal on August 1 that sent Trey Mancini to Houston.

2021: Entered first full season in minors with Single-A Charleston. Made 23 appearances (16 starts), pitched 93.2 innings and struck out 115 batters, good for fourth in the TB system. Posted an ERA of just 2.88 and allowed 33 walks.

2019: Debuted professionally with TB rookie ball affiliates in Princeton and GCL Rays.

College/Personal: Drafted by the Rays out of Campbell with the 40th overall selection in the 2019 Draft. At the time, was the highest-drafted player in Campbell history. A former two-way player at Louisburg (N.C) junior college as a shortstop before committing to pitching full time at Campbell.

The “Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake” are an alternate identity of the Baysox, as a part of MiLB’s “Copa de la Diversión™” or “Fun Cup™”. During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach
