ABOUT LAST NIGHT... An eighth inning home run doomed the Vancouver Canadians Saturday night in a 4-3 loss to the Hillsboro Hops (Diamondbacks) at Ron Tonkin Field.

Spencer Brickhouse delivered the knockout blow. After Jorge Barrosa jumpstarted the Hops with an infield single to beat a shifted infield, Brickhouse sent a fly ball to left field that carried... and carried... and carried before it landed in the bullpen to give Hillsboro their first lead of the game, a 4-3 advantage that proved to be the difference.

The Canadians hadn't trailed all night. They started the scoring with a run in the first after Luis De Los Santos and Ryan Gold singled with two outs and were followed by a Phil Clarke RBI double that made it 1-0.

Hillsboro answered with a run in the bottom half thanks to a lead-off home run from Jorge Barrosa, but the C's retook the lead in the third. Rafael Lantigua worked a walk and went to second on a Tanner Morris single. He proceeded to steal third before coming home on a passed ball to put Vancouver ahead 2-1.

Clarke led off the sixth with a single and made it to third on a pair of wild pitches. That set the table for an Eric Rivera RBI groundout to make it 3-1.

After giving up a run in the first, starter Adam Kloffenstein turned in his third consecutive start where he went five innings or longer. The right-hander made it through five and two-thirds and scattered two hits, walked three and struck out six; he was in line for his third consecutive win when he left the game in the sixth. Brandon Eisert came on with a runner on second after an error and a stolen base and surrendered a hang with 'em RBI double that should have been caught but was lost in the lights before finishing the frame with the score 3-2.

Vancouver missed a chance to add on in the seventh when Lantigua - who had walked, went to second on a passed ball and to third on a fly out - tried to score on a ground ball against a drawn in infield and was cut down at the plate to keep it a one-run lead. The last nine C's hitters of the game made an out before and after the decisive home run.

With their fourth consecutive loss, the Canadians are now a season-low three games under .500 and have dropped a series for the third time in four tries. Clark led the way on offense with two hits, his second consecutive game with multiple knocks. Morris also finished with two hits.

BATTLE FOR THE 'BORO: Vancouver and Hillsboro go head-to-head this week in their second of five week-long meetings this season. The C's took four of six May 18-23 when they outscored the Hops 32-22, including a 13-4 romp in the series opener on May 18 that featured a season-high 18 hits and the first of two instances where the Canadians plated 13 runs.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

ON THIS DATE IN CANADIANS HISTORY: July 18, 2013 - A six-run third put the game away as Vancouver beat Eugene 10-2 at The Nat. Eight of nine starters had a hit, led by Jordan Leyland's two hits - including a homer - two runs and two RBI. 2013 Northwest League All-Star Jeremy Gabryszewski earned the win with 5.2 innings and gave up two runs on seven hits, walked one and K'd 4.

FEELING LOWER: Yesterday's heartbreaker puts the C's at a season-worst three games under .500. If they lose tonight, they'll match their longest losing streak of the year.

CLARKE SPARK: Phil Clarke has five hits in his last two games played. His three knocks on Thursday established a new season high for the former Vanderbilt Commodore.

ON THE HILL: Luis Quinones gets the nod today in hopes of stopping the bleeding for Vancouver and salvaging the series. He last worked on Tuesday, when he held the Hops to one run on four hits with five walks and five strikeouts across four innings. Quinones, 24, is 0-1 with a 4.38 ERA in three July starts that have spanned 12.1 innings. He's had issues with command this month; he's walked 12 and K'd 17 while allowing a .271 batting average to opposing hitters.

Top Diamondbacks pitching prospect and their #5 overall farmhand Blake Walston goes for Hillsboro. From MLB.com: "Walston's velocity fluctuated between the upper-80s and low-90s during his senior year, but he was bumping 96-97 mph in his first taste of pro ball and should add even more velocity as he grows into his ultra-athletic and projectable frame. His plus curveball may already be the best in the system, thrown in the mid- to upper-70s with tight spin and depth that makes it a weapon against hitters on both sides of the plate. He rounds out his four-pitch mix with a lateral-breaking slider and a promising changeup that will be focal points in his early-career development."
